## ISRO successfully conducts third and final 'Pushpak' reusable launch vehicle landing experiment

New Delhi, June 23

The Indian Space Research Organisation, ISRO has said that the third and final landing experiment of its Reusable Launch Vehicle 'Pushpak' was successful today. The landing experiment was conducted at the Aeronautical Test Range in Chitradurga, Karnataka this morning. The ISRO tweet on social media site X says RLV LEX-



03 which stands for Reusable Launch Vehicle Landing Experiment 3, re-demonstrated the autonomous landing capability under more

severe wind conditions. The Chinook helicopter released the Reusable Launch Vehicle Pushpak at an altitude of 4.5 kms

from the runway. After the aerial release, Pushpak autonomously executed cross-range correction manoeuvres and approached the runway and accomplished a precise horizontal landing at the runway centre line. Pushpak approached the runway with a speed of 320 kmph as against 280 kmph of a typical fighter aircraft

## Fisheries Deptt. providing subsidy for motorization of traditional craft Applications invited from eligible beneficiaries

Port Blair, June 23

The Department of Fisheries, A&N Administration is implementing a component 'Motorization of Traditional Craft' under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme- 'Blue Revolution' wherein subsidy is provided for purchase of Outboard/Inboard Marine Engine / Fishing Gear & Propeller. The pattern of subsidy

and eligibility criteria for the programme of the scheme are as under:-

Pattern of Subsidy for General Category	Pattern of Subsidy for ST/SC Women Category
40% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.48,000/- per inboard/outboard engine, fishing gear and propeller for unit cost of Rs.1.20 lakh.	60% of the unit cost with a ceiling of Rs.72,000/-per inboard/outboard engine, fishing gear and propeller for unit cost of Rs.1.20 lakh.
<b>Eligibility Criteria:</b>	
1. Applicant should be a bonafied fisherman of A&N Islands possessing registered non-motorized or motorized fishing craft, holding valid fishing license continuously for 02 years including the current year. The Pandemic COVID relaxation is applicable.	
2. The engine to be purchased should not be of more than 30 Horse Power (HP).	
3. The eligible subsidy for procurement of engine shall be up-to 10 HP.	
4. The fishermen possessing motorized fishing crafts, whose engines are of more than 05 years old and are unserviceable, are also eligible to replace the engines.	
5. The fishermen seeking replacement of 05 years old and unserviceable engine should produce a certificate issued by an Authorized Marine Engineer stating that the engine is beyond economical repair.	
6. The type / size of gear allowed to purchase are Gill net not below 25 mm mesh (knot to knot diagonally), Hook & Line. Shore seine/drag net of mesh size not below 25 mm, Fish traps.	
7. The Applicant should not have availed the assistance for purchase of engine, fishing gear and propeller from the Department of Fisheries or any other Government Department during the last 5 years.	

Applications have been invited from eligible beneficiaries interested in the procurement of Outboard/Inboard Marine Engine /Fishing Gear & Propeller to extend subsidy by the Department during 2023-24. Application form and detailed terms & conditions of the scheme can be

obtained from the Directorate of Fisheries/ Fisheries Zonal Offices/Fisheries Sub Stations. The applications complete in all respect should reach the nearest Fisheries Zonal Office/Sub-Stations by 31st July, 2024, a press release from Directorate of Fisheries said.

Accordingly, the Andaman & Nicobar Administration vide Notification No. 05/

2022 dated 05th January, 2022 has designated Assistant Registrar of Cooperative Societies as Value Added Tax Officer (VATO), Inspector of Cooperative Societies as Assistant Value Added Tax Officer (AVATO) and Sub-Inspector of Cooperative Societies as Inspector of VAT respectively to carry

## IGNOU offering dual degree alongside existing degree progs.

Port Blair, June 23

Indira Gandhi National Open University (IGNOU) has invited students to attain dual degree alongside their existing degree programmes in various higher educational institutions. As per UGC regulations, a student can pursue two academic programmes, one in full time physical mode and another in the Open and Distance Learning (ODL)/Online mode

simultaneously.

Any UG degree student or PG student can opt for a second UG/ PG degree in IGNOU based on their qualifications. Those who are doing ODL course can also take another course in the next admission cycle. The admission for undergraduate, post graduate programmes, diploma and certificate for July session is already in full swing. Dual degrees allow a

student to focus on two areas of expertise, either from similar disciplines in the same faculty or two contrasting but complementary fields. The learners can apply for programmes in science, humanities, arts, commerce, language, health science, environment etc. through online mode for ODL. Transfer Certificate (TC) is not required for applying for the programmes.

out the assessment of VAT, computation and imposition of penalties, computation of interest due or owed, anti-tax evasion etc. under Value Added Tax Regulation, 2017 and the Value Added Tax Rules, 2020 in A & N Islands.  
All the Bar owners, CSD canteens, POL outlets and all stakeholders are required to comply with VAT regulations, including accurate reporting of sales, timely filing of VAT returns, and payment of taxes as applicable to VAT Department (DC office, South Andaman).  
Failure to adhere with VAT regulations may result in penalties and legal consequences as stipulated under the VAT Regulation and Rules of A & N Islands.  
All stakeholders have been requested to familiarize themselves with the VAT requirements and cooperate with the designated officials to facilitate smooth implementation of VAT in A & N Islands, a press release from VAT Officer (HQ), RCS Office said.

Anganwadi Worker for onward submission to CDPO Office through the Mukhya Sevikas of the concerned areas. The beneficiaries need not visit any of the Offices other than the nearby Anganwadi Centre for submission of self-signed Life Certificate alongwith the format.  
The Care-givers/guardians of those who are bed-ridden or unable to visit the Anganwadi Centre due to locomotor disabilities may inform the same to Anganwadi Worker, so that the representative of the Department can visit the home of such persons to collect Life Certificate. The last date for submission of Life Certificate to Anganwadi Worker by the beneficiary is July 15, 2024. Thereafter, the pension benefit will be stopped, if the Life Certificate is not received, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.

due to the low lift-to-drag ratio aerodynamic configuration. After the touchdown, Pushpak's velocity was reduced to nearly 100 kmph using its brake parachute. After which the landing gear brakes were employed for deceleration and stop on the runway. Pushpak utilised its rudder and nose wheel steering system to autonomously maintain a stable and precise ground roll along the runway. ISRO release says that the experiment has reaffirmed its expertise in acquiring the most critical technologies required for the development of a reusable launch vehicle. This will cut launch costs and help advance space exploration in the coming years. Pushpak used multi-sensory fusion including an inertial sensor, radar altimeter, flush air data system, Pseudolite system and NavIC navigation system. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

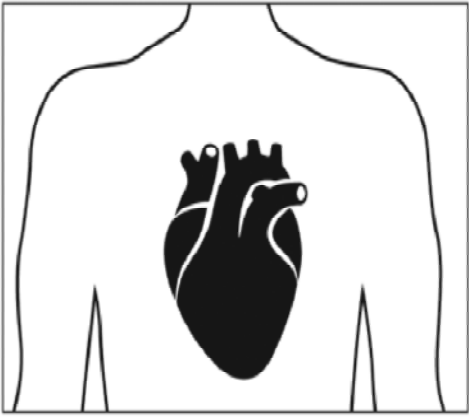
