Shri Om Birla elected as Speaker of Lok Sabha for 2nd time

New Delhi, June 26

Senior BJP MP, Shri Om Birla was today re-elected as the Speaker of the 18th Lok Sabha. He was elected with a voice vote as the opposition, which fielded Congress MP, Shri K. Suresh for the post, did not press for voting in the House. After his election, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra Modi, Leader of Opposition, Shri Rahul Gandhi, and Parliamentary Affairs Minister, Shri Kiren Rijiju escorted Shri Birla to the Speaker's chair. Shri Birla had previously served as the Speaker in the last Lok Sabha.



In his address, Shri Om Birla thanked all the members of the House for giving him the opportunity to serve as Speaker again and for their trust in him. He emphasized that enriching parliamentary values and democratic traditions will be his priorities. Shri Birla highlighted that the 18th Lok Sabha represents the world's largest celebration of democracy, with over 64 crore voters participating in the elections with great enthusiasm. He stressed that MPs have a responsibility to collectively fulfill the expectations, hopes, and aspirations of the people effectively. The Speaker underscored the importance of debate and discussion in the House instead of stalemate, emphasizing that protest methods should uphold the dignity of the House. > Maruti Agency House Junction to Opposite Chennai Store. 2. Two-wheelers and emergency vehicles such as fire tenders, ambulances and Police vehicles will be allowed from both sides. 3. Parking will be allowed on the left side of the road on the aforementioned link roads and from Shiv Temple (Deen Street to Old CCS, Junglighat) The trial will commence from 01.07.2024. Port Blair, June 26


