

The drill commenced with a simulated earthquake and fire scenario, following which the Department teams carried out safe evacuation, head counted, communicate with State Emergency Operation Center (SEOC-1070), District Emergency Operation Center (DEOC-S/A-1077), and Emergency Response Support System (ERSS-112) for emergency supports, search and rescued missing persons and provided first aid to the injured. Fire tenders and ambulances arrived swiftly to manage the incident situation.

After the drill concluded, a debriefing session was conducted to discuss observations and identify areas for improvement. Officials from the Disaster Chess Summer Camp for Management and Fire Departments highlighted the importance of providing basic disaster management training to Departmental staff. 


