Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency participated in the 4th National Sagarmala Apex Committee (NSAC) meeting today at New Delhi as a special invitee with the aim to strengthen the goals of Maritime India Vision 2030 and Maritime Amrit Kaal Vision 2047.

Hon'ble Lt. Governor in his address apprised about a slew of Maritime projects of Andaman & Nicobar Administration aimed at converting A&N Islands into World Class Maritime Cluster after the upcoming mega projects of

Further, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor also recommended expedition of Repair/Reconstruction of Jetties of A&N Islands in the first phase and taking up the projects under Sagarmala schemes for early completion, a press release from Raj Niwas said.

Meeting to discuss Agricultural Export Opportunities and Infrastructure Development in A&N Islands held

A meeting was held under the chairmanship of Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary (Agriculture), yesterday in the Mini Conference Hall of the Secretariat, Sri Vijaya Puram. The meeting was attended by the Regional Head of APEDA, Kolkata, the Director of Agriculture, Director of Civil Aviation, Chief Port Administrator, PMB, Director of Industries, DGM, NABARD, Chairman of the Tribal Development Cooperative Society, senior officers from the Departments of Tribal Welfare, Rural Development,

Environment & Forest, and entrepreneurship. The main focus of the discussion was on the export potential of agricultural products and processed items from the Union Territory of Andaman & Nicobar Islands. The primary strategies discussed were to enhance exports through the Agricultural and Processed Food Products Export Development Authority (APEDA). Such discussions were critical for identifying opportunities for growth in the agricultural export sector and improving the reach of products from

the A&N Islands to international markets. She highlighted the need to preserve the agricultural heritage of the Islands and called for focused efforts to identify strategies for leveraging these schemes to boost the export potential of agriculture in the region. 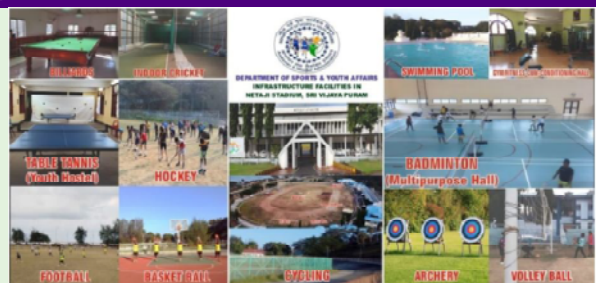

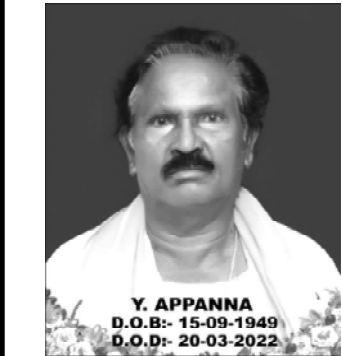

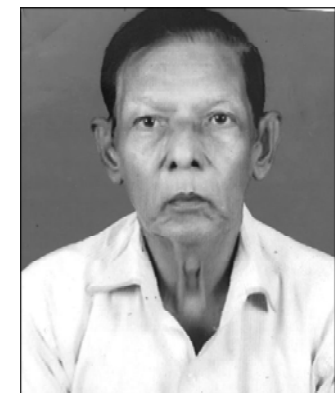
