Centre approves revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission to boost growth in livestock sector

New Delhi, Mar. 20

The Government has approved the revised Rashtriya Gokul Mission to boost growth in the livestock sector. The implementation of the revised mission is being carried out with an additional outlay of one thousand crore rupees. Briefing the media in New Delhi on the Union Cabinet's decisions, Information and Broadcasting Minister, Shri Ashwini Vaishnaw stated that the scheme is set to significantly enhance milk production and productivity, thereby increasing farmers' incomes.

The Cabinet also approved the revised National Program for Dairy Development. Shri Vaishnaw said this initiative



focuses on modernizing and expanding dairy infrastructure, ensuring the sector's sustained growth and productivity.

The Union Cabinet has also approved an incentive scheme for the promotion of low-value BHIM-UPI transactions. Shri Vaishnaw said, the scheme will

enable small merchants to avail of UPI services at no additional cost. He said an incentive at the rate of 0.15 per cent per transaction value will be provided for transactions up to two thousand rupees to small merchants. (Source: newsonair.gov.in)

Surveillance of pest & disease infestation in coconut palms conducted by Zonal Agriculture Office, Rangat

Climate change is indeed having a significant impact on coconut crops particularly when it comes to pests. Rising temperature and change in humidity patterns are altering the distribution and prevalence of pest that effect coconut trees. Warmer temperatures can alter the lifecycle of the pest leading to increased infestation and damage to coconut crops which can be challenging to coconut farmers.

In view of this, the Department of Agriculture, Rangat is taking several initiatives by creating this period and propagate awareness programmes, conducting regular field visits, giving instructions to the extension staff to regularly monitor the pest population and make the farmers aware of pest prevalent in coconut



and other crops during its control measures. Some effective strategies like cultural

control, biological control and IPM techniques are also being disseminated to the farmers. Control measures like spraying of Neem Insecticides to the targeted pests, use of installing yellow sticky traps 15 nos. per ha., maintaining proper sanitation in fields, regular pruning of diseased and infested leaves and use of natural bio control agents have been encouraged.

During the field visit at Parnasala and Shivapuram Gram Panchayat, coconut palms were found to be infested by Rugose Spiralling White fly (RSW), a significant pest particularly during summer months. Taking note of the situation, the Zonal Office, Rangat promptly conducted first spray on 13th March & the second spray on 20th March to curb the spread of Rugose Spiralling White fly mainly affecting its host plant i.e. coconut palms.

As per the information/instructions given by the Expert from Kerala during the training programme conducted on 28th February, 2025, the Integrated Pest Management strategies were followed i.e. Spraying of Azadiractin 0.3% EC by use of Rocker Sprayer were undertaken in the fields of Shri Sunny Varghese & Shri Madhab Roy, R/o Parnashala and Shri R. Madhanan, R/o Shivapuram in the presence of Assistant Director (Agri.), Pradhan & Extension functionaries along with nearby farmers.

This programme is a part of coordinated effort involving Agriculture Extension staff, PRI members and farmers to manage the pest before its outbreak. Time to time farmers have been advised to inform their nearest Sub-Depot incharges/ Office / KCC @03192-243434 or Toll Free No. 1800-345-1145, if any signs of infestations or any new emergence of pest is found in their crops, a press release received here said.

A CIFNET team of 4 members comprising of Shri K. Manimaran, Sr. Instructor (ME), Shri G. Gopikrishnan, Skipper, Shri S. Viswanathan, Instructor (ME) and Shri V. Naresh Kumar were the Resource Persons for the sessions. As part of the training programme, an exposure visit to the Fishery Survey of India vessel MFV Blue Marlin was also conducted where participants gained insights and practical exposure into advanced fishing techniques, introduction to life saving appliances, navigational equipments and hygienic handling of Tuna on-board.

Broadly, the training covered basics of marine engines and its types, various systems in marine engines, repair and maintenance of boat engines, trouble shooting of defects of boats engines, code of conduct for responsible fishing, safety of fishermen at sea fishing practices and fishing vessel signals etc.

The Director of Fisheries in her address thanked CIFNET, Chennai for their visit to A&N Islands and for dedicated efforts to approach the sessions in more practical oriented way for better understanding of fishermen community. She also added that this training will positively impact the initiative of Govt. of India under Tuna Cluster development in A&N Islands for utilization of potential resources in sustainable way. She urged the fishermen trainees to utilize the existing programmes under PMMSY to upgrade their fishing boats, so that they can target fishes which have more commercial value especially Tuna and Tuna like resources.

The Joint Director (Fisheries) motivated the trainees to enroll into the advanced training programmes of CIFNET, so that they can start self-employment in the field of repair of fishing boats and engines. Shri S U Maheshwar Rao, Non-official member, NFDB, Hyderabad requested the Department to sponsor/ depute atleast 10 educated youth of fishermen community to CIFNET for long term advanced training, which can resolve the issue of non-availability of technicians in the Islands.

The Director of Fisheries distributed certificates to all the participants during the valedictory session. The participants on completion of the programme showed their confidence in trouble shooting of their boat engines and usage of various equipments while at sea. The fishermen trainees expressed their gratitude to the Department of Fisheries for organizing such specialized training. 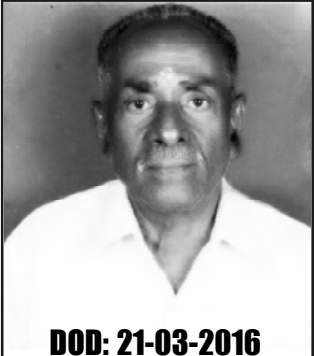
