Tourism on the rise: A&N Islands records unprecedented growth in tourist footfall

Islands witness 120% increase in domestic & 27% rise in foreign tourist arrival in Isles in 2024

Andaman and Nicobar Islands remain one of the most pristine and breathtaking archipelagos in the world. The Islands have witnessed an unprecedented surge in tourist footfall, owing to the proactive and strategic initiatives undertaken by the A&N Administration to boost tourism in the region. With the upgradation of the international terminal at VSI Airport and

tourism infrastructure in the Islands, there has been an unparalleled growth in tourism activities in Isles. The launch of the first ever scheduled International flight to Sri Vijaya Puram, Blue Flag Certified Beach and historically significant landmarks, further adds to Islands' tourism growth, drawing visitors from across the globe, making it one of the most attractive places in the world.

In 2024, the Islands' tourism sector achieved a significant milestone, recording a 120% increase in domestic arrivals and a 27% rise in foreign tourist arrivals compared to 2023.

Major tourist attractions, such as the National Memorial Cellular Jail and the Baratang Limestone Caves, experienced higher footfall in 2024. The number of visitors attending the Sound & Light Show at the

National Memorial Cellular Jail saw a substantial rise, with 417,944 people witnessing the show in 2024, compared to 267,327 in 2023.

Similarly, day visits to the National Memorial Cellular Jail also increased, with a total of 363,494 visitors in 2024, up from 310,127 in 2023.

The remarkable growth has been driven by enhanced infrastructure, improved connectivity,

and innovative promotional campaigns. The Administration's concerted efforts to revamp tourism facilities, ensure environmental sustainability, and showcase the region's rich cultural and natural heritage have played a pivotal role in attracting visitors.

Ten Indian States which collected the most GST in Feb. 2025

Maharashtra takes top spot in most GST collected in February, but Andaman and Nicobar Islands wins big with growth, according to the latest Good and Services Tax data released by the Government of India.

Andaman and Nicobar Islands saw gross domestic GST collections soar a staggering 32 per cent to Rs. 52 crore, while Northeastern State Tripura recorded a 21 per cent year-on-year

jump to hit Rs. 103 crore. Haryana collected Rs. 9,925 crore, up 20 per cent-making it the fifth best earner in the country for the month. Himachal Pradesh, too, saw major gains of 16 per cent, with total monthly GST collection of Rs. 869 crore.

However, the share of collections under the Centre Jurisdiction saw the most significant growth, with Rs. 336

crore collected in February 2025-a staggering 45 per cent jump from February 2024.

Total gross domestic GST collected by States, Union Territories and Centre rose by 10.2 per cent year-on-year to around Rs. 1.42 lakh crore for the month. Adding imports GST, the total gross GST collected in February amounted to about Rs. 1.84 lakh crore.

Final deadline for mandatory e-KYC for Ration Card beneficiaries announced

Beneficiaries advised to complete their e-KYC to avoid permanent removal from Ration Card

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 2

In compliance with the directives of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India, the Government of India has instructed all States and Union Territories to ensure 100% completion and updating of e-KYC for all ration card beneficiaries within the stipulated timeframe.

To achieve this, the Department has undertaken extensive

outreach efforts, including notifications through Fair Price Shop (FPS) dealers, print and electronic media, telephonic campaigns, door-to-door surveys, and special camps. Beneficiaries have been urged to complete the e-KYC process for all members listed on their ration cards at the earliest.

To facilitate this, e-KYC services have

been made available at all Fair Price Shops and Civil Supplies Offices across the Union Territory. Furthermore, as per the special provisions granted by the Government of India, NFSA beneficiaries who have migrated to other States/UTs can complete their e-KYC at their current place of residence.

Beneficiaries can also complete their e-

ANC Triathlon challenge successfully concludes in Sri Vijaya Puram

ICC Champions Trophy 2025: India beat New Zealand by 44 runs

India will face Australia in 1st Semi Final on Mar. 4

In the ICC Men's Champions Trophy, India beat New Zealand by 44 runs in the final Group A ODI encounter at Dubai International Cricket Stadium tonight. Chasing the target of 250 runs, Kiwis were all out for 205 runs in 45.3 overs. For New Zealand, Kane Williamson with 81 was the top scorer. For India,

Varun Chakravarthy scalped five wickets, Kuldeep Yadav took two wickets, and Hardik Pandya, Axar Patel, and Ravindra Jadeja claimed a wicket each. Varun Chakravarthy was declared Player of the Match.

Earlier, after winning the toss, New Zealand opted to bowl, and the Men in Blue scored 249 runs for the loss of 9

wickets in the stipulated 50 overs. Shreyas Iyer, with 79 runs, was the highest scorer, while Hardik Pandya hit 45 runs. For the Kiwis, Matt Henry clinched five wickets.

With this win, India will face Australia in first semi final on Mar. 4 while New Zealand will take on South Africa in second semi final on Mar. 5.

With immediate effect, the names of Ration Card members who have not yet completed their e-KYC stand suspended. As a result, their ration cards and entitlement to ration supplies will remain suspended.

Suspended members have been provided a final opportunity to complete their e-KYC on or before 31st May, 2025. Failure to do so, will lead to the permanent deletion of their names from the

Ration Card without any further notice.

This action is being implemented under Clause 4(18) and (19) of the Public Distribution System (Control) Order, 2015, treating such cases as bogus or ineligible entries. Therefore, all concerned beneficiaries have been advised to complete their e-KYC at the earliest to avoid permanent removal from the Ration Card and the loss of entitlement to subsidized food grains.

Sadan. It focused on enhancing the pedagogical skills of identified mentors to effectively impart FLN training at the foundational and preparatory stage teachers across Islands.

Shri Gyan Sheel Dubey, Principal, DIET, was the chief guest on the occasion. In his address, he emphasized the importance of adopting child-centric pedagogy to address existing learning gaps in FLN skills. He reiterated the commitment of the Education Department to ensure that every child achieves foundational literacy and numeracy.

The training program adopted a blended learning approach to cater to mentors from diverse geographical locations. 64 mentors from Wimberlygunj and South Andaman Zone participated in face-to-face sessions at the DIET Auditorium. Simultaneously, 88 Mentors from remote areas, including Little Andaman, Rangat, Mayabunder, Diglipur, Car Nicobar, Nancowrie, and Campbell Bay, participated through virtual sessions facilitated by the DIET's e-learning studio.

♦ **Upcoming Blue Flag Certifications:** Five additional beaches are set to receive Blue Flag certification by October 2025. These include Lalaji Bay in Long Island, Raman Bhagicha in Rangat, Karmatang in Mayabunder, Ramnagar in Diglipur and Butler Bay in Little Andaman.

♦ **VSI Airport Expansion:** The inauguration of the new terminal building at Veer Savarkar International Airport in July 2023 increased its handling capacity to 1,200 passengers per peak hour, facilitating more flights and connectivity to additional destinations.

♦ **International Air Connectivity:** AirAsia Malaysia launched direct flights between Sri Vijaya Puram and Kuala Lumpur in November 2024, boosting international travel.

➤ Bharat Parv 2025 (New Delhi, January 2025) - Hosted 800 visitors daily.


