Infestation of Rugose Spiraling Whitefly in coconut palms **Spraying of Azadirachtin 0.3% EC in** farmer's field of South Andaman Zone to commence from today

The Department of Agriculture, South Andaman has reported the infestation of Rugose Spiraling Whitefly, mainly in coconut palms. This pest has also been observed in arecanut, banana, guava, and solanaceous vegetables. Additionally, the incidence of mealy bugs, though currently in traces, has been noticed in papaya and ornamental crops.

The Rugose Spiraling Whitefly feeds on the underside of leaves, producing excessive honeydew on the upper leaf surface which leads to the development of sooty mould. A prolonged dry spell and decreased relative humidity could encourage further

A survey conducted by the Department's extension functionaries indicates that the incidence of the pest is currently below the Economic Threshold Level (ETL), though (Contd. on last page) some patches show slightly higher

infestation levels. As the present weather condition could favour wider infestation of this pest, immediate action is being planned to prevent
