Surya Kiran Aerobatic Team paints Sri Vijaya Puram skies with flawless manoeuvres and stunning formations Hon'ble Lt. Governor and others witness spectacular aerial display along with general public

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar.13

The renowned Surya Kiran Aerobatic Team (SKAT) of Indian Air Force took to the skies in a breathtaking aerial display over Marina Park here this afternoon, leaving the audience in awe with their flawless manoeuvres and stunning formations. SKAT showcased their precision flying skills, performing loops, barrel rolls, inverted flying, and their signature DNA manoeuvre in their distinctive red-and-white Hawk Mk-132 jets. Their seamless coordination and close formations left the audience in awe, reaffirming their status among the world's elite aerobatic teams. The air show not only showcased India's aviation capabilities but also inspired a deep sense of national pride.

The event was honoured by the presence of Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands and Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency and Air Marshal Saju Balakrishnan, PVSM, AVSM, VM, Commander-in-Chief Andaman and Nicobar Command (CINCAN), Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, along with senior military officials and dignitaries from Civil Administration and Police.

Thousands of eager onlookers lined the streets of Marina, their eyes glued to the sky, while phones and cameras clicked away, capturing the mesmerizing performance. As the aircraft roared past at supersonic speeds, the crowd erupted in loud cheers, their excitement echoing across the city. The pilots, known for their skill, discipline and mastery of aerial aerobatics, showcased an extraordinary level of coordination, maintaining a perfect distance from each other while executing complex formations with absolute ease.

The highlight of the display was a stunning tri-color formation, as the nine aircraft moved in perfect synchronization, releasing trails of vibrant smoke in the national tri colour, a fitting tribute to the country's aviation prowess. The sky above Sri Vijaya Puram

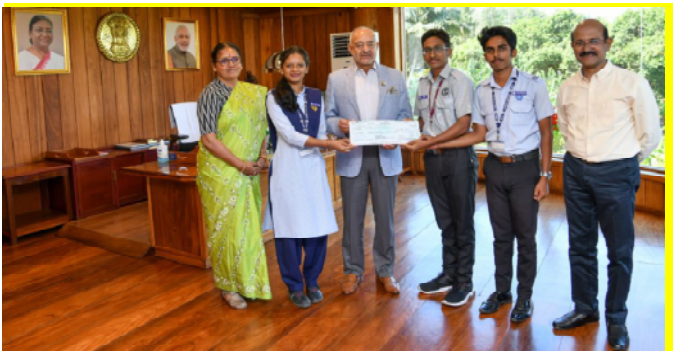


was transformed into a canvas of colour and motion, as the SKAT team painted a masterpiece of aerial artistry. Every manoeuvre was a testament to the team's dedication, rigorous training, and unwavering commitment to excellence.

From daring vertical climbs to gravity-defying rolls, the SKAT team left an indelible mark on the hearts of those watching. Their performance was not just an air show but a spectacle of bravery, precision, and sheer aviation brilliance, a

As the SKAT team soared through the skies, the performance reached a breathtaking crescendo when the nine aircraft, flying in perfect unison, suddenly split into smaller groups in a precisely choreographed manoeuvre. The seamless synchronization of this split demonstrated the pilots' exceptional coordination and control, as each subgroup executed intricate aerial

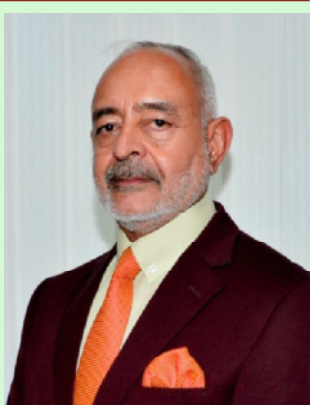

They were imparted hands on training in essential lifesaving techniques, water rescue operations, and first aid procedures.

enhance their employability and ensure the safety of beachgoers. He highlighted that the initiative aligns with the Department's commitment to promoting responsible tourism while creating job opportunities in the Islands. By equipping them with advanced rescue techniques and professional skills, we not only improve their career prospects but also enhance the overall tourism experience", he said. Electricity Deptt. appeals to Consumers of Sri Vijaya Puram & adjoining areas of South Andaman for judicious usage of power

It is to bring to the kind notice of general public that in view of ensuing summer and due to increase in ambient temperature, there has been a significant increase in the power demand particularly during evening peak hours from 5.30 pm to 10.30 pm in Sri Vijaya Puram and adjoining areas of South Andaman. As a result, there is a temporary shortfall in the power

supply during these hours. All the consumers of Electricity Department have been advised to use energy judiciously in view of shortage of power particularly during evening peak hours.

Further, usage of major power guzzlers like ACs, Motors, OTGs, Greaser, Garden lighting etc. may be avoided during evening peak hours from 05.30 PM to 10.30 PM and general public have been requested to switch off un-necessary

electrical appliances when not in use. This would help the Department to maintain power supply in Sri Vijaya Puram and adjoining areas of South Andaman without curtailment.

The Electricity Department is committed to monitor the situation for effective compliance and may conduct checks to ensure effective Demand Side Management measures are being followed, a press release from Electricity Department said.
