Government servants including those working with PSUs, except Doctors and Scientists, are not eligible for Padma Awards.

The Government is committed to transform Padma Awards into "People's Padma". All citizens are, therefore, requested to make nominations/recommendations, including self-nomination. Concerted efforts may be made to identify talented persons whose excellence and achievements really deserve to be recognized from amongst women, weaker sections of the society, SCs & STs, divyang persons and who are doing selfless service to the society.

The nominations/recommendations should contain all relevant details specified in the format available on the above said Portal, including a citation in narrative form (maximum 800 words), clearly bringing out the distinguished and exceptional achievements/service of the person recommended in her/his respective field/discipline.

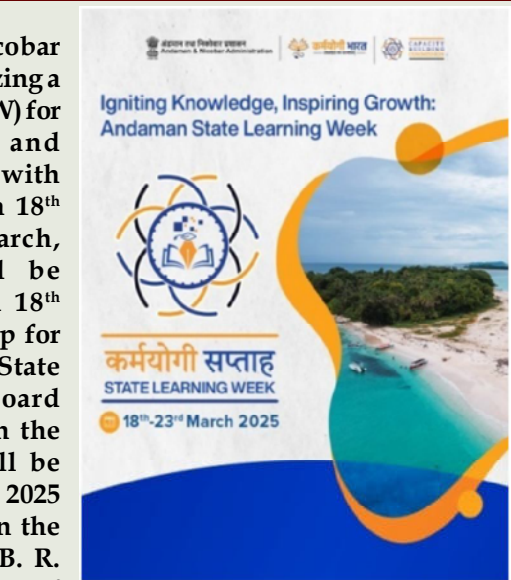

Real-Time Air Quality Monitoring now available in Sri Vijaya Puram

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 16 The Andaman and Nicobar Pollution Control Committee (ANPCC), Department of Science and Technology, has installed a Continuous Ambient Air Quality Monitoring Station (CAAQMS) behind ITF Ground, Junglighthat for monitoring of air quality parameters. The CAAQMS facility enables the real-time monitoring of air quality parameters like CO, SO₂, NO_x, NH₃, O₃, PM₁₀ and PM_{2.5}, as well as Meteorological data. To enhance public awareness, digital display boards have been installed, providing real-time updates on air quality levels. Furthermore, ANPCC has successfully linked the CAAQMS station to the Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) server in New Delhi, ensuring seamless data transmission. The general public can access real-time air quality data through the CPCBs National Air quality index portal ([h t t p s : / / airquality.cpcb.gov.in/AQI_India/](https://airquality.cpcb.gov.in/AQI_India/)). Additionally, air quality information, including the Air Quality Index (AQI) and specific air quality parameters, can be easily viewed by downloading the Sameer App from the Google Play Store. Users can select Sri Vijaya Puram from the City list equipped with CAAQMS to track live air quality updates. This initiative marks a significant step towards enhancing air quality monitoring and public health awareness in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from Department of Science & Technology said.
