CEC announces schedule for General Elections to Lok Sabha-2024

Polls to be held in 7 phases from April 19 & counting will take place on June 4; Model Code of Conduct comes into force ECI team is fully prepared for the biggest festival of Indian democracy: CEC

New Delhi, Mar. 16

The Lok Sabha polls will be conducted in seven phases beginning the 19th of next month. The counting will take place on 4th June. The Election Commission today announced the poll schedule for the General Election 2024 as well as for the Assembly Polls in four States.

In the first phase, the polling will be conducted in 102 Lok Sabha seats on 19th April while in the second phase, 89 seats will go to poll on 26th April. The poll for the third phase will be held on 7th May for 94 seats while 96 seats will go to the poll in the fourth phase on 13th May. In the fifth phase, 49 Parliamentary constituencies will have polling on 20th May and in the sixth phase, 57 seats will have voting on 25th May. The last and seventh phase of polling will be held on 1st June for 57 Lok Sabha seats.

Announcing the Poll Schedule in New Delhi, Chief Election Commissioner, Shri Rajiv Kumar said, 22 States and UTs including Gujarat, Tamil Nadu, Punjab, Telangana, Kerala,



Haryana, Himachal Pradesh, Delhi, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Andaman & Nicobar Islands etc. will go to poll in a single phase on April 19. Karnataka, Rajasthan, Manipur and Tripura will have voting in two phases while Chhattisgarh and Assam will go to poll in three phases for Lok Sabha. Madhya Pradesh and Jharkhand will have polling in four phases and in Maharashtra and Jammu and Kashmir, the polling will be held in five phases. In Uttar Pradesh, Bihar and West

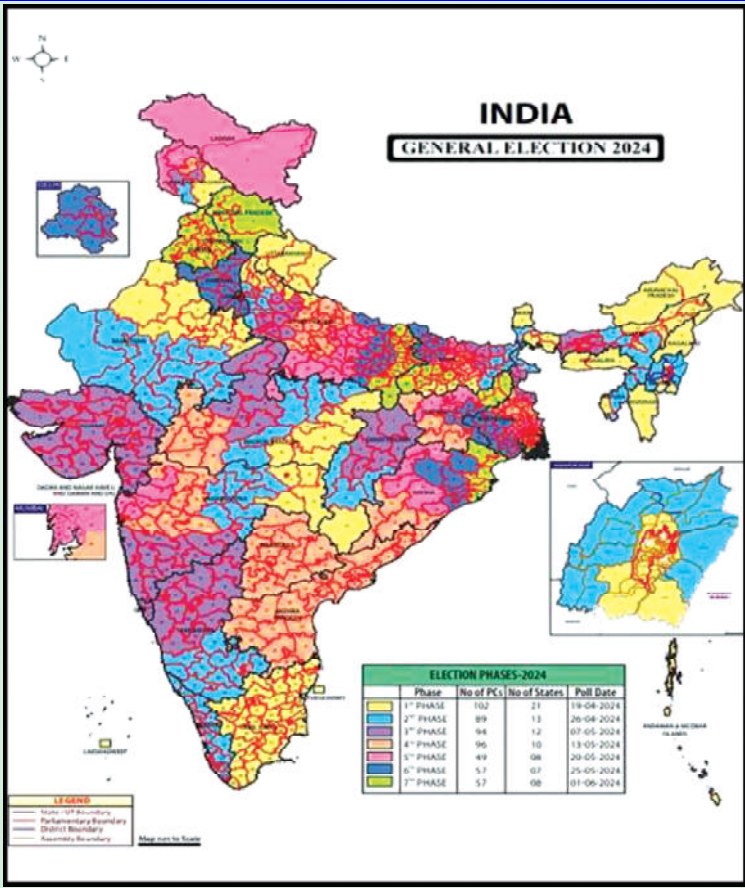
Bengal, the voting will be conducted in seven phases.

The Election Commission also announced the Poll Schedule for the Assembly polls in Sikkim, Odisha, Andhra Pradesh and Arunachal Pradesh.

With the announcement of the poll schedule, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force. The Chief Election Commissioner said, the

ECI team is fully prepared for the biggest festival of Indian democracy. He said, the country has 97 crore registered voters and over 10.5 lakh polling stations manned by 1.5 crore personnel. He added there will be 1.82 crore first-time voters in this election. CEC highlighted that the Commission is ready to facilitate vote from home for electors over 85 years of age and for persons with disabilities. He said adequate number of EVMs and VVPATs have been made available and all steps have been taken to ensure that the poll is conducted smoothly.

CEC further said that the daunting challenges in conducting free and fair elections are 4Ms - Muscle, Money, Misinformation and MCC violations. He asserted that ECI has put in place measures to deal with these disruptive challenges. He also said drone-based checking will be done on polling day to check the use of muscle power. He underlined that there is no place for bloodbath and violence in the



elections and the Commission will be ruthless if violence takes place anywhere during polls. CEC said, the

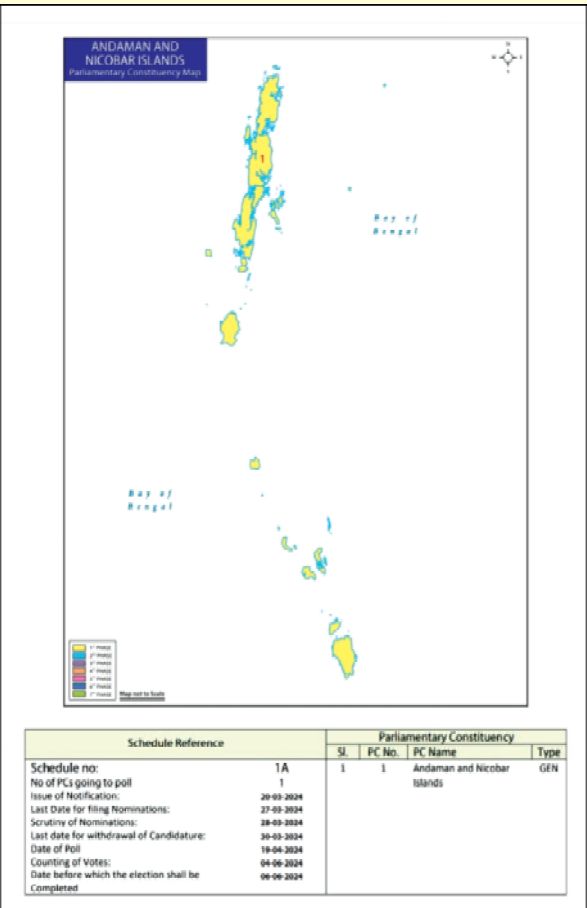
Polling in A&N Islands to be held in the first phase on April 19

The following directives are to be complied:-

> The Superintendent of Police, South Andaman District may be requested to place barricades adjacent to the IP&T Office to restrict the entry of vehicles without permission of the Competent Authority.

> The maximum number of vehicles allowed within the periphery of 100 meters of Returning Officers'/Assistant Returning Officers' office on behalf of a candidate visiting the

said office to file his nomination paper in a procession/ convoy of vehicles, shall be three only.

> Periphery of 100 metres should clearly be demarcated.

> Only one door of the office shall be kept open for entry of candidate +4 other authorized persons and all other doors should be closed. The Executive Magistrates and the Police Authorities shall ensure that not more than 4 persons are allowed to enter the chamber of RO/ specified ARO other

than the candidate during filing on the day of nomination.

> During the period of election no private vehicles shall be allowed to enter into the campus of Returning Officer without valid permit. > Vehicles coming in procession for filing nominations or any other purpose of electioneering shall, under no circumstances, be allowed to move in convoys of more than ten vehicles, excluding the security vehicles. The convoys, including those

carrying a minister of Central or State Government, exceeding ten vehicles shall be broken up and a gap of 100 mtrs should be maintained.

> As per definition given in Section 160(4) (b) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951, a cycle rickshaw is also a vehicle. If a candidate is using a cycle rickshaw in election campaign, he has to account for its expenditure in his account of election expense, giving details of all such rickshaws being used by him, an order to this effect issued by DM (SA) said.

General Elections-2024: Restrictions on printing of pamphlets, posters, etc

Port Blair, Mar. 16

Consequent upon announcement of General Election-2024, attention of all concerned have been invited towards the envisaged provisions provided under Section 127-A of the Representation of the People Act, 1951. Section 127-A states that:

"1. No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlet or poster which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof.

2. No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or poster

> Unless a declaration

as to the identity of publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate,...."

As such the aforesaid provisions needs to be adhered to scrupulously while printing of pamphlets, posters and other election related materials used in electioneering. Accordingly, the below instructions are required to be followed:-

1. Clearly indicate in the print line the names and addresses of publisher of any election pamphlets or posters, such other

materials printed.

2. Send the copies of the printed materials (alongwith three extra copies of each such printed material) within three days of printing to Nodal officer.

Election Expenditure Monitoring, South Andaman.

Any contravention of the provision of Section 127-A of the Representation of People Act, 1951 shall be viewed seriously, which may attract penal provisions including revocation of the license of the printing press under the relevant provisions provided under the Statute, a press release received here said.

Training prog. for Model Code of Conduct & Election Expenditure Monitoring teams held at TGCE

As part of the final preparations for the ensuing Lok Sabha General Elections-2024, a final round of sensitization cum training workshop was held today at TGCE auditorium for the Model Code of Conduct & Election Expenditure Monitoring teams comprising of Flying Squad, Static Surveillance, Video Surveillance and Video Viewing teams.

Initiating the training, the SDM/Nodal Officer (MCC), Shri Vinayak Chamadia, IAS underlined the various points to be borne in mind by the Teams for ensuring free and fair elections. He stated that



since elections have been declared, the MCC has come into force and thus Teams particularly Flying Squad and Static Surveillance Teams should start functioning from today itself. These teams should get themselves active in cVigil App to monitor receipt of any MCC or EEM related complaints forwarded to them for immediate action. The Teams should also start sending their daily activity report in the prescribed performa. He further stated that

these ground teams play a key role to prevent/ restrict the inducement that influences the voters thus paving the way for the conduct of elections in free, fair and transparent manner. He urged the teams to work in close co-ordination for the effective implementation of MCC, which has become effective with the announcement of Lok Sabha General Election-2024.

Shri M. Mohammed Ashraf, (Nodal Officer Training) on Election

Expenditure Monitoring briefed the participants about their roles in the election expenditure machinery deployed by the Commission. He also distributed the various reporting formats and explained in detail about them. The SoP pertaining to Seizure of any Cash, Liquor or any freebies used for inducement of voters were also explained. The Teams were sensitized about the important responsibility they carry to ensure a free and fair election.

Shri Amar Kumar Singh gave a brief overview of the Election Seizure Management System (ESMS) through video files and about C-vigil app through Power Point Presentation.

PROHIBITORY ORDER UNDER SECTION 144 of Cr.PC, 1973

Sub:- General Elections-2024- Restrictions on possession of arms during General Elections-reg.

WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 schedules on 16/03/2024 which will be held on 19/04/2024. Thus, with the announcement of the Election schedule, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India, issued instructions vide Order No.464/96-L&O/PLN-1 dated 13.03.1996 that connotes the District Magistrate, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed arms holders, so that licensed arms in those cases, where they consider it essential to impounded in order to ensure maintenance of Law and Order, so essential for ensuing free and fair elections;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India, also instructed that prohibitory order under Section 144 of Cr.PC, 1973 shall be issued banning the carrying of licensed arms as soon as an election is announced and should be effective till the declaration of results;

AND WHEREAS, it appears to me that carrying of fire arms, spears, swords, sticks, brickbats, lathis and other weapons by the public during the election period is likely to lead to breach of peace and threat to peaceful conduct of elections in the District of South Andaman;

AND WHEREAS, in my opinion there is sufficient ground for proceeding under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to prohibit the action mentioned in para (4) above which may be detrimental to public peace and tranquillity and may pose threat to peaceful conduct of free and fair elections.

AND WHEREAS, all the Station House Officers, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed holders and all the arms licensed holders shall deposit their weapons with the nearest police station immediately and in any case before 22/03/2024. If the individual license holder failed to deposit their arms, the Station House Officer shall impound it and shall furnish a detailed report on such deposit and seizure;

AND WHEREAS, this ban shall not be applicable to those communities who are entitled to display weapons by long standing law, custom and usage & also to those Nationalized / Private Banks, where arms is necessary to safeguard cash chest. However, individual exemption order shall have to be obtained immediately;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Arjun Sharma, District Magistrate, South Andaman District in exercise of the power conferred upon me u/s 144 of Cr.PC do hereby:-

1. Order that all the arms license holders shall deposit their weapons with the nearest police station immediately, latest by 22/03/2024.
2. Prohibit possession and carrying of any kind of spears, swords, sticks, brickbats, lathis and other weapons by the general public in the district of South Andaman with immediate effect.

The term of the current Lok Sabha is ending on 16th June this year. The country has 543 Lok Sabha seats, out of which, 84 Parliamentary constituencies are reserved for Scheduled Caste and 47 for Schedule Tribes.

Seven more foreign poachers apprehended by N&M Andaman District Police

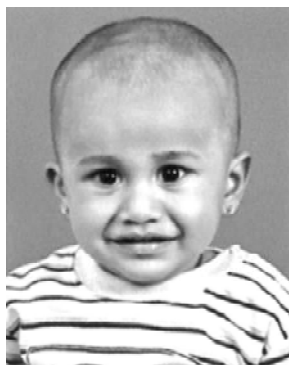
