SVPMC gears up for Swachh Survekshan 2024

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council is gearing up for Swachh Survekshan 2024, the annual cleanliness assessment that evaluates cities on various sanitation and waste management parameters. As part of this initiative, all citizens have been urged to actively participate in maintaining cleanliness and contributing towards making our city clean, green and sustainable. It has come to the notice of the authorities that individuals engaged in house construction, demolition, and reconstruction are irresponsibly dumping construction debris (C&D waste), quarry materials, and other

waste on roads and public spaces. This practice is highly objectionable, violates urban road safety norms, and is non-compliant with municipal regulations. All citizens have been informed that illegal disposal of C&D waste, municipal solid waste (dry and wet), or any other refuse in unauthorized locations will be viewed seriously. Strict action, including penalties and applicable charges, will be imposed as per the Solid Waste Management Rules, 2016 & SVPMC-SWH & M Byelaws, 2017. Individuals responsible for such unauthorized dumping must ensure immediate removal of the waste. Dumping construction materials in public

Towards modernizing power distribution network in A&N Islands

Two agreements and an MoU costing more than Rs. 500 Crores signed under the project of Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 17

In a significant move towards modernizing the power distribution network in A&N Islands, two agreements and one MoU costing more than Rs. 500 Crores have been signed today at Sri Vijaya Puram under the project of Revamped Distribution Sector Scheme (RDSS) in the august presence of the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS. The MoU for Smart Metering project costing Rs. 53.26 Crores, the agreement for Loss Reduction costing Rs. 247.12 Crores and agreement for Interconnection of Islands costing Rs. 208.04 Crores was signed by the Secretary (Power) on behalf of A & N Administration and senior officials of Power Grid. The Power Grid was nominated by Ministry of Power as Project Implementing Agency (PIA) for execution of these components under RDSS.

RDSS is a comprehensive initiative by Govt. of India aimed at strengthening and modernizing the power distribution sector. These Agreements/MoU shall improve the power quality and reliability ensuring sustainability of electricity distribution system in entire A&N Islands. The scheme focuses on three key components viz. Loss Reduction, Smart Metering and Interconnection of Islands.

The Loss Reduction component focuses on upgrading the age old existing



electricity distribution infrastructure to reduce losses and improve efficiency. The work will include the replacement of old and inefficient transformers, construction of new sub-stations, augmentation of existing substations, replacement of old/frayed conductors by covered conductors, segregation / bifurcation of feeders, construction of additional HT lines and strengthening of transmission lines. These interventions and improvements in the T & D system will minimize outages and voltage fluctuations.

The implementation of prepaid smart metering for consumers and system metering

at feeder and distribution transformer level with communication feature along with Advanced Metering Infrastructure (AMI) will revolutionize power consumption monitoring. Consumers will benefit from accurate billing, real-time energy usage tracking and enhanced transparency in electricity consumption. The Department will be able to detect power theft, reduce losses and improve revenue collection ensuring better service delivery.

The interconnection of Islands from South Andaman to North Andaman is a preparatory work for the HVDC link with

'Explore tourism in uninhabited islands of A&N'

Parliament's Home Affairs Committee urges exploring tourism on uninhabited Andaman and Nicobar Islands, noting a surge in visitors and potential eco-tourism

New Delhi, Mar. 17

A Department related Parliament Standing Committee on Home Affairs has asked the Ministry to explore the tourism potential of "uninhabited islands" in Andaman and Nicobar Islands buoyed by the rise in tourist footfall in the Union territory.

The committee, in its report on demand of grants tabled in Parliament last week, said that the number of tourists visiting the UT nearly doubled in 2024 to 721,000 from 332,000 in 2023.

Representatives from the region informed the committee on February 21 that after the opening of the New Integrated Terminal Building (NITB) at Veer Savarkar International Airport, Sri Vijaya Puram, in August 2023, the annual passenger handling capacity of the airport increased from 0.75 million Passengers Per Annum (MPPA) to 5 million MPPA, the report said.

"The Committee feels that there are a number of islands in the UT of Andaman and Nicobar Islands which are not inhabited but have beautiful beaches and potential for eco-tourism. The Committee recommends that UT administration may explore the opportunity of development of the tourism related activities in these islands and develop them as tourist

destination for the growing number of tourists in the UT," the report said.

The Committee has asked for a report on the impact of development in the tourism sector on revenue generation in the UT and on socio economic growth of the local people.

"The benefits of economic growth in the UT must also percolate to the local population as they equally deserve to reap those benefits," the report said.

According to the committee, historically the UT was believed to have 572 islands but subsequent surveys revised the number to 836.

Some islands, such as the North Sentinel Island, are out of bounds

for tourists and also government agencies because it is home to the world's one of the last uncontacted tribes - Sentinelese - who have an estimated population between 50 and 250.

"The Committee appreciates the action of the Government agencies which were involved in the geographical survey of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands which revealed the existence of 836 islands in place of the hitherto 572 islands in the UT of A&N and recommends that full potential of these islands may be explored for various economic and tourism related activities," the report said.
