



Sub:- General Elections-2024- Restrictions on Use of Loudspeakers for election campaigns-reg.

WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 schedules on 16/03/2024 which will be held on 19/04/2024. Thus, with the announcement of the Election schedule, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions vide letter No. 3/8/2000 J.S.II Dt. 26/12/2000, underscoring the emergent need to regulate the unfettered use of loudspeakers during election campaigning by the Political parties/ Candidates/Supporters which is not only creating noise pollution in the locality but also causing annoyance to the General Public, discomfort to the sick and elderly persons and in particular interrupts the student community;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India in pursuance to the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order Dt. 18/07/2005 has restricted the timing for use of loudspeakers or any sound amplifier, by substituting the earlier specific provisions promulgated vide letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-II Dt. 26/12/2000 with letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-II Dt. 26/09/2005, relevant portion of substitution is reproduced as under:-

"3(1) A public address system or loudspeaker or any sound amplifier, whether fitted on vehicles or any kind whatsoever, or in static position used for public meetings for electioneering purposes, shall not be used at night between 10.00 pm and 6.00 am."

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has laid down specific guidelines inter-alia to regulate the procedures for seeking permission for use of Loudspeakers from the Authorities during electioneering to be adopted by the Political parties/Candidates for strict compliance;

AND WHEREAS, there is sufficient ground to invoke the provisions provided under Section 144 of Cr. PC, 1973 for stricter adherence of the Instructions issued by the Commission for use of Loudspeakers for electioneering;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District in exercise of the powers conferred upon me u/s 144 of Cr.PCdo hereby prohibit the use of Loudspeakers from 2200 Hrs to 0600 Hrs with the enforcement of Model Code of Conduct during campaigning of General Elections-2024;

Any violation of this Order shall attract penal provisions provided u/s 188 of IPC and other relevant provisions of law;

The present situation warrants immediate attention which involves larger public interest owing to emergent nature of case where the circumstances do not permit of the serving in due time a Notice upon the concerned, hence this Order is passed ex-parte under section 144 (2) of the Cr.PC, 1973 calling upon all the Stakeholders for strict adherence.

AND WHEREAS the Election Commission of India in instructions vide Order No.464/96-L&O/PLN-1 dated 13.03.1996 that connotes the District Magistrate, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed arms holders, so that licensed arms in those cases, where they consider it essential to impounded in order to ensure maintenance of Law and Order, so essential for ensuing free and fair elections;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India, also instructed that prohibitory order under Section 144 of Cr.PC, 1973 shall be issued banning the carrying of licensed arms as soon as an election is announced and should be effective till the declaration of results;

AND WHEREAS, it appears to me that carrying of fire arms, spears swords, sticks, brickbats, lathis and other weapons by the public during the election period is likely to lead to breach of peace and threat to peaceful conduct of elections in the District of North & Middle Andaman;

AND WHEREAS, in my opinion there is sufficient ground for proceeding under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to prohibit the action mentioned in para (4) above which may be detrimental to public peace and tranquillity and may pose threat to peaceful conduct of free and fair elections.

AND WHEREAS, all the Station House Officers, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed holders and all the arms licensed holders shall deposit their weapons with the nearest police station immediately and in any case before 22/03/2024. If the individual license holder failed to deposit their arms, the Station House Officer shall impound it and shall furnish a detailed report on such deposit and seizure;

AND WHEREAS, this ban shall not be applicable to those communities who are entitled to display weapons by long standing law, custom and usage &also to those Nationalized / Private Banks, where arms is necessary to safeguard cash chest. However, individual exemption order shall have to be obtained immediately;







The siren will be tested on 3rd and 18th of every month at 1000 Hrs. during the test, the siren will be blown for two successive blast for 30 seconds. Siren of Electronic Display Board installed at Police Control Room, State Control Room, Junglighat (Fisheries Dept.), Met Office, MRCC, JOC, INS Jarawa at Port Blair, Fisheries Dept. at Rangat, EOC at Mayabunder, MRCC at Diglipur, Fisheries Dept. at Hut Bay, EOC at Kamorta, EOC at Car Nicobar, and MRCC & EOC at Campbell Bay will also be blown in a similar manner


