## Voter's Guide for PwDs and Senior Citizen Electors launched

### Para Archer and Arjuna Awardee, Ms. Sheetal Devi, will be ECI National PwD Icon



New Delhi, Mar. 17

In a first of its kind initiative, the Election Commission of India (ECI) in association with the Board of Control for Cricket in India (BCCI) organised an Exhibition Cricket Match between the Indian Deaf Cricket Association (IDCA) Team and the Delhi & District Cricket Association (DDCA) team to foster voter education and inclusivity. The match was held on March 16, 2024 at Karnail Singh Stadium in New Delhi. On the occasion, Ms. Sheetal Devi, a distinguished Para-archer, and Arjuna Awardee, was announced as the National Icon in the PwD category.

The event was graced by Chief Election Commissioner, Shri Rajiv Kumar and Election Commissioners, Shri Gyanesh Kumar and Shri Sukhbir Singh Sandhu who felicitated the winning team. Renowned former Indian Cricketer, Nikhil Chopra, was also invited as the special guest alongside officials from DDCA and IDCA.

This cricket match exemplified the commitment made by CEC, Shri Rajiv Kumar to the Indian Deaf Cricket team when he felicitated them for bringing laurels to the nation by winning the T20 Champions Trophy held in UAE, on the eve of International Day of PwDs in 2022. 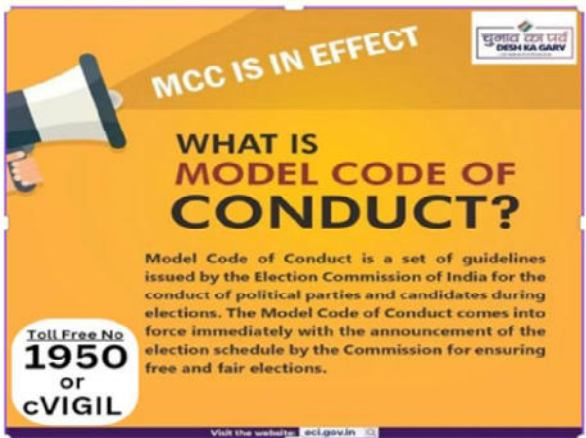
### Model Code of Conduct comes into force; citizens urged to report MCC violations through Toll Free Number 1950 or cVIGIL App

Port Blair, Mar. 17

The Election Commission of India has announced the schedule of General Election to Lok Sabha - 2024 and therefore Model Code of Conduct has become operational. The District Election Officer/Returning Officer is enforcing the Model Code of Conduct.

It is informed that as per section 171 B of Indian Penal Code, any person giving or accepting any gratification in cash or kind during election process, with a view to inducing any person to exercise his/her electoral right is punishable with imprisonment upto one year or with fine or with both.

Further, as per section 171C of



Indian Penal Code, any person who threatens any candidate or elector, or any other person, with injury of any kind, is punishable with imprisonment upto one year or with fine or both.

Flying Squads have been formed to register cases against both the giver and the taker of bribe and for taking action against those who are engaged in threat and intimidation of electors.

All the citizens have been requested to refrain from any illegal activities as above and in case anybody offers any bribe or is having knowledge about the bribe or case of threat / intimidation of electors, then he/she should inform on the toll free number of the 24X7 complaint Monitoring Cell of the Returning Officer / DEO set up for

**ORDER U/s 144 of Cr.PC, 1973.**

Sub:- General Elections-2024- Restrictions on Use of Loudspeakers for election campaigns-reg.

WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 schedules on 16/03/2024 which will be held on 19/04/2024. Thus, with the announcement of the Election schedule, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has issued specific instructions vide letter No. 3/8/2000 J.S.II Dt. 26/12/2000, underscoring the emergent need to regulate the unfettered use of loudspeakers during election campaigning by the Political parties/ Candidates/Supporters which is not only creating noise pollution in the locality but also causing annoyance to the General Public, discomfort to the sick and elderly persons and in particular interrupts the student community;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India in pursuance to the Hon'ble Supreme Court's Order Dt. 18/07/2005 has restricted the timing for use of loudspeakers or any sound amplifier, by substituting the earlier specific provisions promulgated vide letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-II Dt. 26/12/2000 with letter No. 3/8/2005/JS-II Dt. 26/09/2005, relevant portion of substitution is reproduced as under:-

"3(1) A public address system or loudspeaker or any sound amplifier, whether fitted on vehicles or any kind whatsoever, or in static position used for public meetings for electioneering purposes, shall not be used at night between 10.00 pm and 6.00 am."

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India has laid down specific guidelines inter-alia to regulate the procedures for seeking permission for use of Loudspeakers from the Authorities during electioneering to be adopted by the Political parties/Candidates for strict compliance;

AND WHEREAS, there is sufficient ground to invoke the provisions provided under Section 144 of Cr. PC, 1973 for stricter adherence of the Instructions issued by the Commission for use of Loudspeakers for electioneering;

NOW THEREFORE, I, Arjun Sharma, IAS, District Magistrate, South Andaman District in exercise of the powers conferred upon me u/s 144 of Cr.PCdo hereby prohibit the use of Loudspeakers from 2200 Hrs to 0600 Hrs with the enforcement of Model Code of Conduct during campaigning of General Elections-2024;

Any violation of this Order shall attract penal provisions provided u/s 188 of IPC and other relevant provisions of law;

The present situation warrants immediate attention which involves larger public interest owing to emergent nature of case where the circumstances do not permit of the serving in due time a Notice upon the concerned, hence this Order is passed ex-parte under section 144 (2) of the Cr.PC, 1973 calling upon all the Stakeholders for strict adherence.

Sub:- General Elections-2024- Restrictions on possession of arms during General Elections-reg.

WHEAREAS, the Election Commission of India has announced the General Elections-2024 schedules on 16/03/2024 which will be held on 19/04/2024. Thus, with the announcement of the Election schedule, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India, issued instructions vide Order No.464/96-L&O/PLN-1 dated 13.03.1996 that connotes the District Magistrate, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed arms holders, so that licensed arms in those cases, where they consider it essential to impounded in order to ensure maintenance of Law and Order, so essential for ensuing free and fair elections;

AND WHEREAS, the Election Commission of India, also instructed that prohibitory order under Section 144 of Cr.PC, 1973 shall be issued banning the carrying of licensed arms as soon as an election is announced and should be effective till the declaration of results;

AND WHEREAS, it appears to me that carrying of fire arms, spears, swords, sticks, brickbats, lathis and other weapons by the public during the election period is likely to lead to breach of peace and threat to peaceful conduct of elections in the District of North & Middle Andaman;

AND WHEREAS, in my opinion there is sufficient ground for proceeding under Section 144 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 to prohibit the action mentioned in para (4) above which may be detrimental to public peace and tranquillity and may pose threat to peaceful conduct of free and fair elections.

AND WHEREAS, all the Station House Officers, shall make a detailed and individual review and assessment of all licensed holders and all the arms licensed holders shall deposit their weapons with the nearest police station immediately and in any case before 22/03/2024.
