Chief Secretary urges for proper branding and packaging of Agri-products cultivated in Isles

Sri Vijaya Puram, Mar. 18

The Dweep Agro-Eco Walk, an agro-eco-tourism initiative of ICAR-CIARI and its KVKs was inaugurated by the Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, today in the presence of Ms. Pallavi Sarkar, IAS, Secretary (Agriculture & Animal Husbandry) at Horticulture Farm in Sippighat and also the two-day Kisan Mela-cum-Exhibition at Garacharma Farm being held at the Mela ground within

Garacharma Research Complex. The Chief Secretary and Secretary (Agriculture) also planted coffee saplings at the Horticulture Farm in Sippighat.

In his inaugural address, the Chief Secretary lauded the contributions of ICAR-CIARI in advancing technology development and transfer in the fields of Agriculture, Horticulture, Livestock and Fisheries. The event, held at the Andaman Sunset View Resort in Mouwa Dera, Kurmadera yesterday, brought together 35 students from classes VI to IX of Government schools, who had the rare opportunity to engage with foreign experts from DX Adventure, Belgium.

Amateur Radio, widely known as HAM Radio, is a global communication system that allows licensed operators to transmit and receive radio signals for non-commercial purposes. This hands-on expedition aimed to ignite students' curiosity in STEM (Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics) fields by introducing them to the fundamentals of radio wave propagation, communication techniques, and emergency communication applications.

The experts also highlighted the critical role HAM Radio plays in disaster response, scientific experiments, and fostering international connections.

been advised to conduct continuous monitoring of their field on pest and also natural enemies.

Though on a very small level, Rugose Spiralling Whitefly (RSW) infestation is observed in few pockets at Khudirampur village and Kalighat village, taking note of the situation and the favorable climatic condition, the Department of Agriculture, Diglipur, has promptly fast tracked its field-level visits and initiated the control measures to curb the spread of Rugose Spiralling Whitefly (RSW), a pest known to affect Coconut palms, Arecanut and Banana crops.

As part of an Integrated Pest Management strategy, Azadirachtin 0.3% EC was sprayed on coconut and arecanut yesterday in the fields of Shri Ram Uraon, S/o Shri Nishu Uraon and Shri Purna Kerketta, S/o Shri Mangra Uraon of Kalighat village, Ward No. 4 in the presence of the Assistant Director (Agriculture), Agriculture Extension Staff, Shri Anusudan Mistry, Farmers' Friend. Awareness among the 10 local nearby farmers was also created.

Similar spraying was also carried on 12<sup>th</sup> March in the field of Shri Mukesh Kumar Roy, S/o Manoranjan Roy of Khudirampur village, Ward No. 2, in the presence of Shri Madhusudan Dutta, Farmers' Friend, Smt. Kalyani Bairagi, PRI Member and 15 local nearby farmers.

The Department of Agriculture remains dedicated for supporting farmers through awareness campaigns and training programs, ensuring effective pest management, minimizing crop losses and enhancing agricultural productivity and sustainability.

This initiative is a part of a coordinated effort involving Agricultural Extension staff and PRI members to manage the pest before its spread intensifies. (SIE) aimed at strengthening Foundational Literacy and Numeracy (FLN) skills in students from Class 1 to Class 8.

The Principal, SIE, inaugurated the workshop, stressing the need for dedicated efforts, continuous professional development and innovative teaching approaches to bridge early learning gaps. She emphasized that no child should be left unattended and that learning gaps must be identified and addressed before they accumulate. This initiative underscores the commitment to ensuring that all children develop essential skills in reading with comprehension and basic numeracy.

Bringing together 76 mentors from Cluster Resource Centres (CRCs) across all educational zones, the workshop fosters collaboration and shared learning. Held after three months of implementation, this refresher workshop provides mentors an opportunity to review progress, address challenges, and refine their approaches.

Sessions focus on mentorship techniques, resource development, reading fluency, numeracy interventions, and interactive teaching strategies. Discussions on school leadership, parental involvement, and leveraging digital platforms for FLN were held.

Through active engagement and the exchange of best practices, the workshop is expected to develop a concrete action plan, ensuring that no child is left unattended, and no learning gap is developed or accumulated. This initiative reinforces the commitment to equitable and effective foundational learning across the Union Territory, with a focus on reading with comprehension and performing basic numeracy skills, a press release from SIE said.

from research institutions to avoid substantial losses that could impact both the farmers and the broader community, he said.

The Chief Secretary also lauded the agro-eco walk initiative at the Sippighat Farm and emphasized that more focus should be given to branding the quality of organic produce for better market acceptance and tourism potential. He further added that with good coordination between ICAR-CIARI and the development Department, more technological benefits would reach the Island farmers, contributing to the Island's economic growth.

The Chief Secretary observed that many farmers in the Islands tend to focus solely on cultivating arecanut, which is less susceptible to climate variations and requires minimal effort, as opposed to more labor-intensive crops like paddy, spices, and vegetables. He also underscored the critical role of food processing, branding, and packaging in increasing farmers' profits in the Islands. He urged ICAR-CIARI and local Administration to collaborate for the benefit of Island farmers and advocated for more events like Kisan Mela to enhance farmers' knowledge and skills.

The Chief Secretary visited all the stalls and interacted with scientists, expressing his satisfaction with the technologies showcased that have the potential to enhance farmers' incomes.

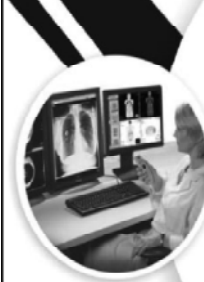

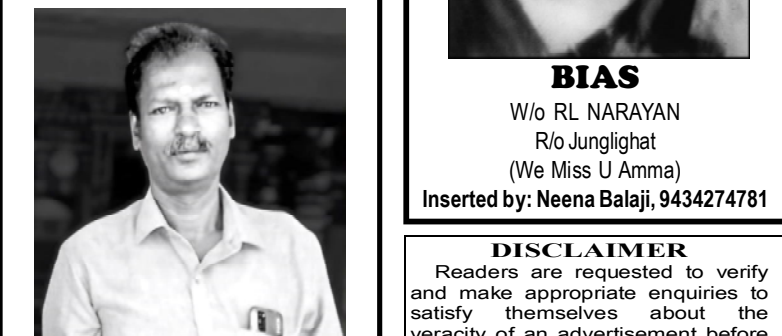

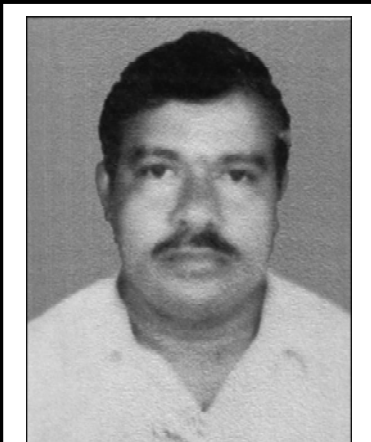
