The Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for General Elections for the Lok Sabha and the notification for the first phase of Lok Sabha elections will be issued on 20/03/2024. As per

this, the filing of nomination for A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency will commence from 20/03/2024 and the last date for filing nominations is 27/03/2024. The nomination papers can be filed in the Office of

the Returning Officer, A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency (District Office, South Andaman), Port Blair between 11 am and 3 pm on any day (other than public holiday) not later than 2 7 / 0 3 / 2 0 2 4

(Wednesday).

The nominations papers will be taken up for scrutiny on 28/03/2024 (Thursday) at 11 am in Room No. 1, Chamber of Returning Officer (Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman), Port Blair.

The last date for withdrawal of candidature is 30/03/2024 (Saturday) before 3 pm and the polling, if necessary, will be held on 19/04/2024 from 7 am to 6 pm. (Notice of Election is published on Page 2).

Model Conduct of Conduct: ECI issues instructions to regulate road shows to avoid any inconvenience to general public/commuters

Port Blair, Mar. 19

With the announcement of the General Elections-2024 by the Election Commission of India on 16/03/2024, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect.

In this regard, the Election Commission of India has issued the following instructions to regulate road shows to avoid any inconvenience to the general public/commuters during road shows which is detailed as under :-

- ♦ Prior permission for road shows shall be taken from the Competent Authority.
- ♦ In order to avoid inconvenience to general public, as far as possible, road shows, subject to court orders and local laws, should be permitted only on holidays and during no-peak hours on routes other than that having big hospitals, trauma centers, blood banks and heavily crowded markets.
- ♦ Number of vehicles and persons joining for road show shall be

intimated in advance.
♦ The road show shall not cover more than half the road width to ensure safety of the general public.
♦ The convoy of vehicles being used in road show shall be broken after every 10 vehicles and a gap of 100 meters would be maintained.
♦ Safety of public and persons in the road show shall be ensured. Bursting of fire crackers and carrying of fire arms shall not be permitted at all.

belonging to the Senior Citizen (85+ years), Persons with Disabilities (Benchmark Disability 40% and above) and COVID affected categories, who cannot vote in person at their respective Polling Stations.

CEO, A&N Islands visits Election Duty Certificate Centre in South Andaman Interacts with staff and explained the procedure for EDC

Port Blair, Mar. 19

The Chief Electoral Officer, Shri B S Jaglan, IAS, visited the Election Duty Certificate (EDC) Centre set up in the Office premises of the District Election Officer, South Andaman today and interacted with the staff and explained the procedure of EDC forms. The CEO was informed that as per Rule 17 of Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, "Voter on Election Duty" means any polling agent, any Polling Officer, Presiding Officer or other public servant, who is an elector in the constituency and is by reason of his being on election duty unable to vote at the Polling Station where he is entitled to vote.



In view of the above provisions, all public servants who are deployed on election duty are entitled to the facility of voting by postal ballot. To further clarify, all Polling Officials, all Police Personnel in the State (who are covered under the notification issued by the UT Administration in terms of Section 28A of the RP Act 1951), deployed on election duty and all the



Commission's Observers and the staff members accompanying them are Voters on Election Duty for this purpose. Further, the Commission has also extended this facility of postal ballot to all private persons and non-government staff engaged in election

work, such as drivers, conductors, cleaners of vehicles, videographers, staff of expenditure monitoring teams, staff working in control room, helpline staff, those appointed for dispatch and receiving of poll material, EVM

maintenance, etc., who are specifically assigned any official work in connection with election on the day of poll and because of that they are not able to vote at the polling station. However, those persons who may have been assigned

A&N Police issues advisory against fraudulent emails allegedly from investigative agencies

Port Blair, Mar. 19 There has been a recent surge in fraudulent emails, purportedly from Indian Cyber Crime & Indian Cyber Squad or in the name of Government fictitious agencies, such as BPR&D, IB & CBI. These malicious emails are accompanied by fake and fabricated letters, falsely bearing the letterheads of investigative bodies such as the Intelligence Bureau (IB), Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI), or Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D). They threaten severe legal consequences if recipients do not cooperate and falsely accuse individuals of involvement in p o r n o g r a p h i c images and materials or narcotics smuggling. These deceitful emails are intended to i n t i m i d a t e individuals and coerce them into complying with the fraudulent demands of the perpetrators. They aim to exploit fear and manipulate recipients into responding. It's imperative to recognize that these emails are scams, and recipients should not engage or respond to them. The scammers are trying to induce panic and deceive unsuspecting citizens of their hard earned money. It is important to note that legitimate law enforcement agencies such as IB, CBI, or BPR&D do not engage in such u n s o l i c i t e d communication. Citizens should remain vigilant and report any suspicious emails to the a p p r o p r i a t e authorities. In this regard, the Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens: ♦ Refrain from responding to or engaging with any emails claiming to be from Cyber Cell India, Intelligence Bureau (IB), Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) or Bureau of Police Research & Development (BPR&D), if received unexpectedly. ♦ Before taking any action/replying, verify the legitimacy of the email by contacting your local Police Station/Cyber Crime Police Station. ♦ Avoid clicking on links from suspicious emails or posts, as they could lead to compromised pages, and lead to financial loss. ♦ Spread awareness among friends, family, and colleagues to prevent further victims falling prey to these scams. ♦ Report any such incidents on Cybercrime.gov.in portal and follow @CyberDost on Twitter, Youtube, Facebook, Instagram, Koo and LinkedIn to know more about safety tips. 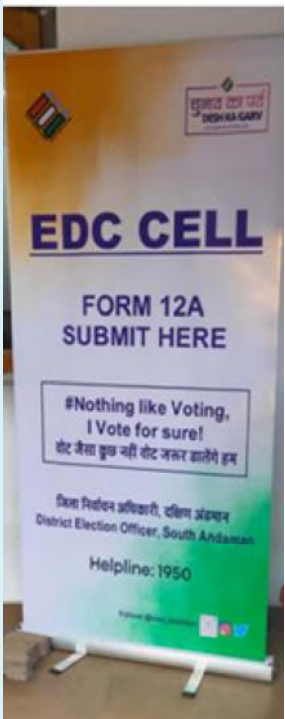
MV Kalighat to sail in place of MV Bharat Seema for Southern group of Islands

- ♦ The maximum size of banner to be carried with hand would be 6x4 feet.
- ♦ Loudspeakers can be used as per existing ECI's instruction and subject to local Laws and Court orders on this subject.
- ♦ Display of animals in road shows is totally banned, children, particularly school children in uniform, should not take part in road shows.
- ♦ Only one flag of the size 1 ft x ½ft with permission of the RO concerned would be allowed on campaign vehicles in a road show. The above mentioned instructions have to be adhered to by the respective Political parties/Candidates to avoid any inconvenience to the general public, a press release from District Election Officer (SA) said.

Large haul of wildlife protected species meat seized by PS Humfrygunj

Port Blair, Mar. 19 On receiving tip off on poaching of wildlife protected species, yesterday, a raiding team was constituted led by SI G Mohan Rao, SHO PS Humfrygunj. The raiding team conducted raid at Fish Landing Center, Guptapara and apprehend one person namely Mohan Kumar, S/o Ram Lakhan (30) yrs, R/o Memyo, Wandoor and recovered 36 kgs venison meat, 9.3 kgs wild boar meat and 8.7 kgs of turtle meat from an wooden engine dinghy plying by him and the recovered wild life species meat and dinghy were seized at the spot. 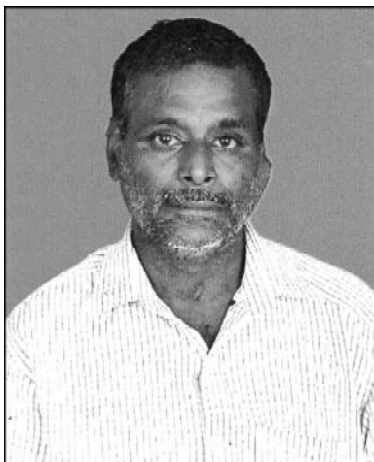

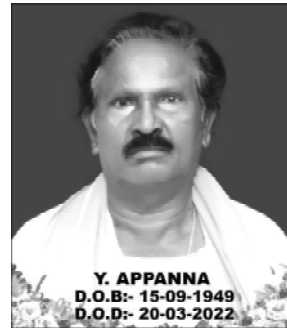
