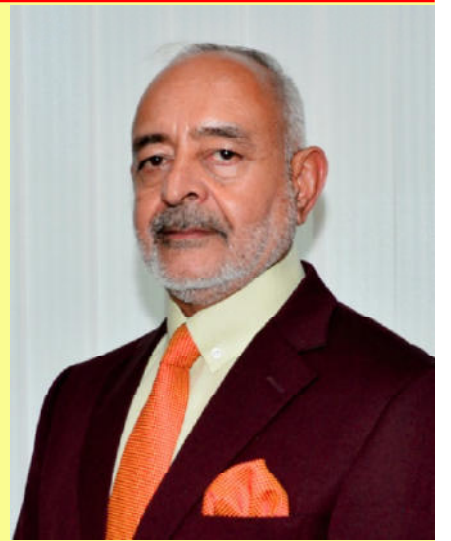
MESSAGE

Anti-Narcotics Police Station conducts raid; seizes 2 cannabis plants

In a proactive effort to combat drug trafficking and to ensure the safety of the community, the Anti-Narcotics Police Station conducted raid on the basis of a specific and credible information on March 19,2024. A Police team headed by Insp. S. Kannan, SHO Anti-Narcotics PS comprising of SI Mohd Rahil Islam, HC Sharfudeen, PC Raja Rao and LPC Nandita Mistry of Anti-Narcotics Police Station conducted raid at Telugu Basti, near Sri Ram Temple, Old Pahargaon and seized 2 Nos of cannabis plants weighing 1.750 Kgs from the backyard of the house of one V. Chinnari, W/o late V. Shankar Rao, 45 yrs, R/o Telugu Basti, near



Sri Ram Temple, Old Pahargaon and she was later arrested following due procedure.

This raid was conducted under the command of Shri Vishesh Dhatterwal, Dy.SP (Narcotics) and under overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID). A case under relevant sections of NDPS Act-1985 has been registered at Anti-Narcotics PS and

investigation is in progress.

tankers until water meters are installed.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has directed all the bulk water suppliers to adhere by the rules and regulations for extraction of ground water and further stated that permission to extract ground water through any energized means will not be accorded for any purpose other than drinking water. The permission would be granted by the Authorised Officer in consultation with the Advisory Committee constituted for this purpose.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has further emphasized that the water crisis witnessed in the Islands are due to the illegal ground water extractions and further to follow the procedure for registrations and the legal provisions of the Central Ground Water Agency. Further, it has been directed that all the bulk water suppliers should mandatorily register themselves with the CGWA. The link for registration with Central Ground Water Authority for obtaining No-Objection Certificate for ground water extraction is <http://cgwa-noc.gov.in>.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman further reiterated that general public and all ground water users may also be made aware that the purchase of water from registered bulk water suppliers should be strictly ensured, a press release from DC (SA) said.

ICG conducts Marine Oil Spill Pollution Response Exercise & Mock Drill at Diglipur

Port Blair, Mar. 20

Indian Coast Guard, North & Middle Andaman District based at Diglipur, in coordination with various stakeholder agencies conducted two days Area Level Marine Oil Spill Pollution Response Exercise & Mock Drill at Diglipur on March 18 & 19, 2024. The exercise was aimed to evaluate the capabilities and response mechanism to combat marine oil spill incident in the region. Preservation and protection of marine ecology and environment including combating oil spill at sea is one of the chartered duties of Indian Coast Guard. The exercise enhance pollution response expertise of various stakeholders and witnessed enthusiastic participation of 23 officials from Indian Navy, Indian Air



Force, District Administration, Port Maritime Board, Deptt. of Fisheries, Deptt. of Forest, Marine Police Force, etc.

The exercise provided an avenue to demonstrate capabilities of ICG in the domain of marine environment protection, combating oil spill disaster and structure of crisis management group on oil spill incidents to protect vulnerable marine flora & fauna of A & N Islands.

On second day of the exercise, a dedicated mock drill was undertaken wherein various oil

spill response equipment for containment, recovery and disposal of spilled oil were showcased. One Offshore Patrol Vessel (OPV), ICGS Vishwast and two Interceptor Boats C-417 & C-416 of Indian Coast Guard participated in the exercise.

The two-day Area Level Pollution Exercise facilitate stakeholders to gain valuable insight and knowledge for planning and undertaking an effective response against marine oil spill incidents in A&N Islands, a press release from ANC HQ said.

Joint Mock Exercise conducted at ISTRAC, Dollygunj

Port Blair, Mar. 20

A joint mock exercise on earthquake and fire incident was conducted in at ISTRAC, Dollygunj, Port Blair today coordination with the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Police, A&N Fire & Emergency Services, Directorate of Health Services and District Administration by creating real time earthquake and fire simulation scenarios and tested the preparedness level and response system of CISF Team of ISTRAC and also observed safe evacuation, search & rescue and fire extinguish operations, first aid along with medical support to manage the fire incident scenario in the ISTRAC.

Immediately, on the receipt of information of earthquake and fire incident, the Asst. Commandant, CISF, ISTRAC triggered their response mechanism to tackle the emergency situation at ISTRAC and informed the same to ERSS, SEOC, Fire &



Health Control Rooms etc. Meanwhile, the officials and CISF were activated to manage the earthquake disaster and douse the fire. All officials and staff of ISTRAC were evacuated to the identified safer location. The Fire Service and Medical team reached the incident spot with fire tender and ambulances along with teams to control the emergency situation. The search & rescue team search all rooms and found 3 staff members trapped in collapsed building and were safely rescued by the CISF and Fire team. The victims were handed over to medical team for further treatment and hospitalization. The mock drill was called off at 1200 hrs, followed by a debriefing session wherein the observers of the mock drill had explained the findings and gaps of the mock drill. The In-charge, ISTRAC and Asst. Commandant, CISF has appreciated the efforts of the staff and other teams of various Departments for their active participation in this mock drill. The Police, Fire, Health and Disaster Management Officers were urged to check their preparedness regularly and provide trainings to their teams with basic skill on safety measures to cope up any crisis in near future, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

inspecting the security aspects of every locality. Any deficiencies observed are promptly taken up with the appropriate authorities to resolve immediately. Besides, transportation and communication arrangements for all Polling Stations have been confirmed for necessary preparations.

To ensure sufficient arrangement of security personnel, CAPF personnel have been deployed with all Police Stations of N&MA District. Flag March and Area Domination are being conducted along with CAPF personnel to make them familiar with the locality and understand the local culture as well. In addition, CAPF have been deployed in patrolling and picketing duties.

All police personnel have been briefed to maintain a strict vigil over mischief mongers, history sheeters, bootleggers and anti-social elements, as well as to educate the public to keep them away from individuals who spread rumours, particularly on social media. Additionally, intelligence agencies have been put on high alert to share any information that may impact the fairness of the election. Also, all Private licensed arms were deposited at armoury of the respective Police Stations.

As a result of these proactive measures, and strict adherence of Model Code of Conduct, a total of 110 bottles of IMFL & 12 Kgs of Handia have been seized by Police and 12 persons were booked under preventive action so far. In addition, Flying Squads, Static Surveillance Teams and Naakas have been made functional in order to uphold law and order in the district.

The North and Middle Andaman District Police remains committed to ensure a free, fair, transparent electoral process, and urges cooperation of all stakeholders in maintaining peace and order during this critical time, a press release from SP (N&M) said.
