

tankers until water meters are installed.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has directed all the bulk water suppliers to adhere by the rules and regulations for extraction of ground water and further stated that permission to extract ground water through any energized means will not be accorded for any purpose other than drinking water. The permission would be granted by the Authorised Officer in consultation with the Advisory Committee constituted for this purpose.

The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman has further Port Blair, Mar. 20 emphasized that the water crisis witnessed in the Islands are due to the illegal ground water extractions and further to follow the exercise on earthquake procedure for registrations and the legal provisions of the Central Ground Water Agency. inspecting the security aspects of every locality. Any deficiencies observed are promptly taken up with the appropriate authorities to resolve immediately. Besides, transportation and communication arrangements for all Polling Stations have been confirmed for necessary preparations.

To ensure sufficient arrangement of security personnel, CAPF personnel have been deployed with all Police Stations of N&MA District. Flag March and Area Domination are being conducted along with CAPF personnel to make them familiar with the locality and understand the local culture as well. In marine ecology and the domain of marine participated in the addition, CAPF have been deployed in patrolling and picketing duties.

> All police personnel have been briefed to maintain a strict vigil over mischief mongers, history sheeters, bootleggers and anti-social elements, as well as to educate the public to keep them away from individuals who spread rumours, particularly on social media. Additionally, intelligence agencies have been put on high alert to share any information that may impact the fairness of the election. Also, all Private licensed arms were deposited at armoury of the respective Police Stations.

As a result of these proactive measures, and strict adherence of Model Code of Conduct, a total of 110 bottles of IMFL & 12 Kgs of Handia have been seized by Police and 12 persons were booked under preventive action so far. In addition, Flying Squads, Static Surveillance Teams and Naakas have been made functional in order to uphold law and order in the district.

AND WHEREAS the infrastructure support to the election machinery is to be drawn from Central Government, UT Administration, Public Undertakings of Central and UT Administration, Local Bodies, Municipalities, Marketing Board by whatever name known, Cooperative Societies, Autonomous District Councils or any other body in which public fund and Private Owners and they may be required to provide the vehicles, vessels, boat, premises etc. possessed by them to the Returning Officer, District Election Officers or the officers subordinate to them. In view of this, provision under Section 160 of the Representation of People Act, 1951 to requisite vehicles, vessels, boat, premises etc. of the Central Govt., UT Administration, Public Undertaking of Central and UT Administration, Local Bodies, Municipalities, Marketing Board by whatever name known, Cooperative Societies, Autonomous District Councils or any other body in which public fund and Private Owners will have to be invoked for the smooth conduct of the elections;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred under Section 160 of, Representation of Peoples Act, 1951, I, Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.) Lieutenant Governor (Administrator) Andaman and Nicobar Islands do hereby delegate the powers conferred on me under Section 160 of Representation of Peoples Act, 1951 read with Rule 98 of Conduct of Election Rules, 1961 to the officers shown in the schedule below.

The Officers mentioned at Column (2) of the schedule below shall exercise the powers under the said law mentioned above for the conduct of General Election to Lok Sabha, 2024 in the jurisdiction mentioned in Column (3) of the said schedule with immediate effect subject to conditions as specified in the Act/Rules.
