



General Election- 2024: RO's Office receives filled-in nomination papers

Last date for filing of nomination is March 27

Port Blair, Mar. 22

The Office of the Returning Officer, A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency (District Office, South Andaman) has started receiving the nomination papers from the contesting candidates. The notification for election to the lone Parliamentary Constituency for UT was issued on March 20, 2024. Shri Bishnu Pada Ray of Bharatiya Janata Party (BJP) today handed over four sets of nomination papers to the Returning Officer, A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency, Shri



Arjun Sharma, IAS, at the Office of the Returning Officer (Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman) in person. The Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for General Elections to the 18th Lok Sabha and the notification for the First Phase of Lok Sabha Election to this

effect has been issued on Mar.20, 2024. As per this, the filing of nomination for A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency has commenced from 20/03/2024 and the last date for filing of nomination is 27/03/2024. The nomination papers can be filed in the Office of the Returning Officer, A&N Islands

Parliamentary Constituency (District Office, South Andaman), Port Blair between 11 am and 3 pm on any day (other than Public Holiday) not later than 27/03/2024. The nomination papers will be taken up for scrutiny on 28/03/2024 at 11 am in Room No. 1, Chamber of Returning Officer (Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman), Port Blair. The last date of withdrawal of candidature is 30/03/2024 and the polling, if necessary, will be held on 19/04/2024 from 7 am to 6 pm.

General Elections-2024 :Model Conduct of Conduct ECI issues instructions to regulate road shows to avoid any inconvenience to general public/commuters

Port Blair, Mar. 22

With the announcement of General Elections-2024 by the Election Commission of India on 16/03/2024, the Model Code of Conduct has come into force with immediate effect.

In this regard, the Election Commission of India has issued the following instructions to regulate road shows to avoid any inconvenience to the general public/commuters during road shows which is detailed as under :-

Authority.

➤ In order to avoid inconvenience to general public, as far as possible, road shows, subject to court orders and local laws, should be permitted only on holidays and during no-peak hours on routes other than that having big hospitals, trauma centers, blood banks and heavily crowded markets.

➤ Number of vehicles and persons joining for road show shall be intimated in advance.

➤ The road show shall not cover more than half the road width to ensure safety of the general

public.

➤ The convoy of vehicles being used in road show shall be broken after every 10 vehicles and a gap of 100 meters would be maintained.

➤ Safety of public and persons in the road show shall be ensured. Bursting of fire crackers and carrying of fire arms shall not be permitted at all.

➤ The maximum size of banner to be carried with hand would be 6x4 feet.

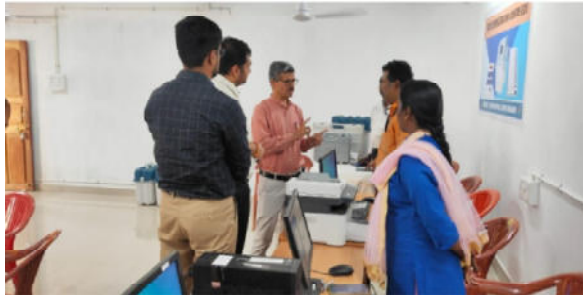
➤ Loudspeakers can be used as per existing ECI's instruction and subject to local Laws and Court orders on this subject.

➤ Display of animals in road shows is totally banned. Children, particularly school children in uniform, should not take part in road shows.

➤ Only one flag of the size 1 ft x ½ft with permission of the RO concerned would be allowed on campaign vehicles in a road show.

The above mentioned instructions have to be adhered to by the respective Political Parties/Candidates to avoid any inconvenience to the general public, a press release from District Election Officer (SA) said.

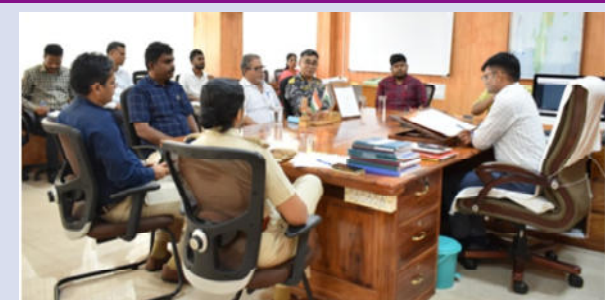

DC, N&M Andaman conducts meeting on coastal security

PS Mayabunder apprehends one woman with illegal venison

Mayabunder, Mar. 22

The proactive team of PS Mayabunder took a swift action based on the credible information regarding illegal sale of venison meat at a residence in Webi village, Mayabunder today. A raiding team, led by SI Dinesh Meena, SI (IRBn) Neethi J Vetriarsan, PCs B. Dilleshwar Rao, K Balraju and S.Tamil Selvi was formed immediately. The team conducted a raid at the premises of Ms. Sumanti Toppo confessed to possessing the venison meat during interrogation. From the prima facie, it is a clear violation of Section 50 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972, and subsequently all items were seized by Insp. P.K Abdul Uraon, in Webi, Arif, SHO PS Mayabunder. During the search,

illegal wildlife products were discovered in the back yards, including 3 kgs of dry meat (likely venison), 1 deer head, 12 packets of venison meat weighing approximately 11.5 kgs and 1 Air Gun. Ms. Sumanti Toppo confessed to possessing the venison meat during interrogation. From the prima facie, it is a clear violation of Section 50 of the Wildlife (Protection) Act 1972, and subsequently all items were seized by Insp. P.K Abdul Uraon, in Webi, Arif, SHO PS Mayabunder. The accused was

apprehended, and the seizure was promptly reported to the Range Officer, Mayabunder. Subsequently, both the confiscated items and the apprehended individual were handed over to Forest Officials for further action. The entire operation was conducted under the supervision of Shri Brij Mohan Meena, SDPO Diglipur and overall direction and supervision of Ms. Geetanjali Khandelwal, IPS, Superintendent of Police, North & Middle Andaman District, a press release from SP (N&M) said.

Raid by Kalighat Police uncovers illicit liquor production operation in jungle near Parangara village

In a swift and efficient operation carried out on March 21, 2024, the Kalighat Police successfully confiscated a significant quantity of illicit lehan at jungle near Parangara village. Acting promptly on a tip off, SI Ashok Kumar Baghel, SHO, PS Kalighat formed a specialized team consisting of ASI Mukesh Charan, I/c OP Kishorinagar, PCs Jaspal Singh, Ripon Mistry and Subrato Biswas. The proactive team successfully seized a significant quantity of 500 liters of Lehan, stored in various utensils, and timber materials used in the production



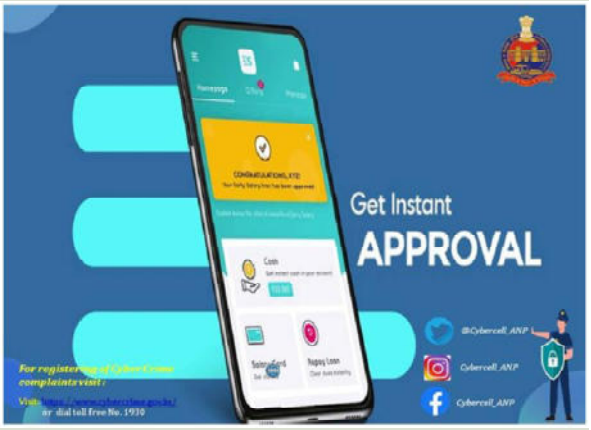

A&N Police issues advisory on illegal digital lending apps

A large number of complaints are being reported nationwide pertaining to illegal digital lending apps, which provide short term loans/ micro credits at exorbitant interest rates along with processing/hidden charges. These apps, which may not be Regulated Entities (RE) by RBI, target members of vulnerable and low income groups, and the borrowers are asked to provide mandatory access to confidential personal data like contacts, location, photos/videos, in order to avail the loans. This personal data is then misused for blackmail



and harassment. The illegal apps make use of bulk SMSs. Digital advertisements, chat messengers and mobile app stores, etc. on a mass scale. All citizens have been advised against the usage of these illegal lending apps, for availing loans. If anyone has been cheated, blackmailed
