Filing of nomination for General Election-2024

No vehicles shall be allowed within the periphery of 100 meters from the Office of Returning Officer

Vehicles can be parked at PBMC parking area in front of IP&T Department

Port Blair, Mar. 26

The Election Commission of India has notified the General Election 2024 to the Parliamentary Constituency of A & N Islands, which shall be going to poll in the first phase on 19.04.2024. As per the schedule of Elections, the filing of nomination has started from 20.3.2024 and the last date is 27.03.2024 in the Office of the

Returning Officer, A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency (Dy. Commissioner Office South Andaman).

As per the directions of the Election Commission, during filing of nomination by the candidate, no vehicles should be allowed within the periphery of 100 meters from the Office of Returning

Officer.

In view of the above, barricades will be put in place by the authority to restrict the vehicles approaching the Office of the Returning Officer till the last date of nomination. It is brought to the notice of the general public that the vehicles approaching the Office of the Returning Officer will not be allowed

within the periphery of 100 meters from the Office of the Returning Officer from 20.03.2024 to 27.03.2024 and hence, it is suggested that the vehicles approaching the Office of Returning Officer (DC Office) shall park their vehicles at the PBMC parking area in front of the IP&T Department, a press release from DC (SA) said.

General Elections-2024: Restrictions on printing of pamphlets, posters, etc.

Port Blair, Mar. 26

Consequent upon announcement of General Election-2024, attention of all concerned have been invited towards the envisaged provisions provided under Section 127-A of Representation of the People Act, 1951. Section 127-A states that:

“1. No person shall print or publish, or cause to be printed or published, any election pamphlet or poster which does not bear on its face the names and addresses of the printer and the publisher thereof.

2. No person shall print or cause to be printed any election pamphlet or poster

➤ Unless a declaration as to the identity of publisher thereof, signed by him and attested by two persons to whom he is personally known, is delivered by him to the printer in duplicate,....”

As such the aforesaid provisions needs to be adhered to scrupulously while printing of pamphlets,

posters and other materials used in electioneering. Accordingly, the below instructions are required to be followed:-

1. Clearly indicate in the print line the names and addresses of publisher of any election pamphlets or posters, such other

materials printed.

2. Send the copies of the printed materials (alongwith three extra copies of each such printed material) within three days of printing to Nodal Officer, Election Expenditure Monitoring, South Andaman. Any contravention of the provision of Section 127-A

of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 shall be viewed seriously, which may attract penal provisions including revocation of the license of the printing press under the relevant provisions provided under the Statute, a press release received here said.

Staff of PS Ograbraj seizes illegally obtained hand sawn padauk timber

Port Blair, Mar. 26

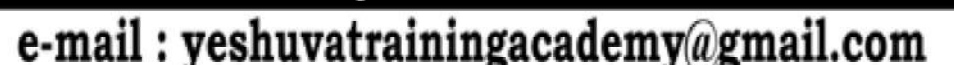
A dedicated team comprising of SI K V Abdul Salam, HCs Ashok Roy and Nelson embarked on a mission to dismantle the manufacturing of premature illicit liquor (Lehan) and apprehended the perpetrators in Port Mout revenue forest area yesterday. During the search in the revenue forest area behind Port Mout Basti, the team stumbled upon evidence of illegal activity in the form of hand sawn padauk timber. The discovery prompted the team to conduct a thorough investigation to determine the ownership and legality. Despite exhaustive efforts, no individuals or evidence indicating legality were found.

During the operation, 02 pieces of length 24 x 15 cm x 160 cm measuring 0.0576 cbm and 01 piece of 15 x 12 cm x 160 cm measuring 0.0288 cbm, total 03 pieces measuring 0.1440 cbm of hand sawn padauk timber were recovered.

The illegally obtained hand sawn padauk timber was promptly seized on the spot under the cover of a seizure memo. Subsequently, the information was conveyed to the concerned Forest Official, who assured their commitment to

take over the seized articles from the spot. The seized articles were handed over to Shri Anoop Singh, Forester, Ograbraj Beat, Tushnabad Range on the same day for necessary action at their end.

The operation was carried out within the jurisdiction of PS Ograbraj under the leadership of SI Devanand Pathak, SHO, PS Ograbraj, over a l l supervision of Shri Sandeep Lamba, Sub Divisional Police Officer, Bambooflat and the overall command of Smti Niharika Bhatt, Superintendent Police, South Andaman District, a press release from SP (SA) said.

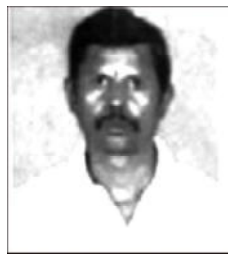
