Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Returning Officer, A & N Parliamentary Constituency in the presence of Observers from Election Commission of India, Shri B. N. Singh, IAS, General Observer and Shri Ravi Joseph Lokku, IPS, Police Observer today conducted a meeting for allotment of symbols for the contesting candidates of the General Elections to the House of People from A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency after the expiry of the stipulated time for withdrawal of candidature as notified by Election Commission of India.

The Returning Officer, ANIPC briefed the attendees that the process of allotment of symbols shall be taken up in accordance with the provisions of Election Symbols (Reservation and Allotment) Order, 1968 and different symbols shall be allotted to the contesting candidates from either a reserved



symbol which is reserved for a recognized political party which can either be a National Party or a State Party or a free symbol other than a reserved symbol list of which has been approved by the Commission.

13 (Thirteen) candidates were validly nominated after completion of scrutiny on 28th March 2024. Subsequently, 1 (One) candidate withdrew and a total of 12 (Twelve) contesting candidates were taken up for symbol allotment.

On 30th March 2024, the process of allotment of symbols was taken up and the following symbols were allotted to the

percent benchmark disability can vote from home. Volunteers and wheelchairs will be available at every Polling Station. The poll body is also arranging transport facilities for Persons with Disabilities and Elderly.

The Commission launched Saksham

App to facilitate easier voting for Persons with Disabilities and to avail facilities at Polling Stations. It is also pushing for permanent Assured Minimum Facilities (AMF) in schools as a gift of election process to the students. Assured Minimum Facilities consist of

Drinking Water, Toilets, Signage, a Ramp or Wheelchair, Helpdesk, Voter Facilitation Centre, Sufficient Light and Shed. There will also be Polling Stations managed by Persons with Disabilities, Polling Stations exclusively managed by women and Model Polling Stations.



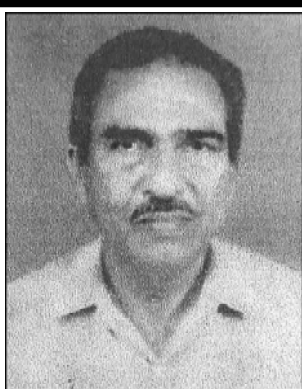
