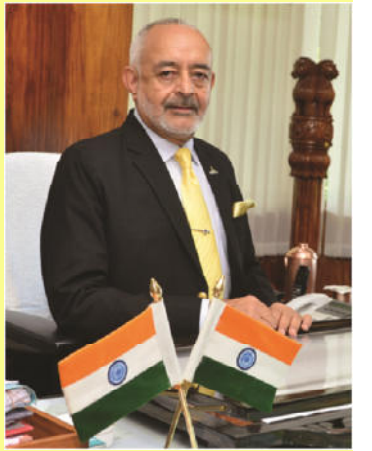

Andaman and Nicobar Police has always taken proactive steps to ensure the safety and security of the Island communities.

In line with the commitment to disaster preparedness, the A&N Police has undertaken extensive training initiatives throughout the years for its personnel which also include training a total of 206 personnel from the India Reserve Battalion (IRBn) representing various ranks by the National Disaster Response Force (NDRF) team stationed at the IRBn campus as part of the State Disaster Response Force (SDRF) initiative.

Building upon this foundation of readiness, the India Reserve Battalion, A&N Police is further enhancing the capabilities of these personnel through refresher training in Collapsed Structure Search and Rescue (CSSR) and Medical First Response (MFR) which encompasses a diverse range of topics vital for effective disaster response such as Structural Collapse Rescue, Incident Command System (ICS), Urban Search and Rescue (USAR) Strategies, Hazardous Materials (HAZMAT) Response in Search and Rescue, Basic Life Support (BLS) Techniques, Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) Procedures, Bleeding Control and Wound Care, Fracture and Spinal Injury Management etc. This training will incorporate the latest techniques, equipment, and methodologies available, leveraging the expertise of the NDRF team. By providing the personnel with advanced training and equipping them with the latest tools and techniques, it is aimed to enhance their readiness to respond effectively to any disaster or emergency situation.

Under the able guidance of Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, DGP, ANI, and under the supervision of Smt. Sindhu Pillai A, IPS, IGP, ANI, Smt. Monika Bharadwaj, DIGP (IRBn) & Ms. Shweta K Sugathan, Commandant (IRBn), the collaborative effort between the A&N Police and the NDRF underscores a shared commitment to proactive disaster preparedness and response. Do's

For general population

Stay hydrated:

Drink sufficient water whenever possible, even if you are not thirsty.

Thirst is not a good indicator of dehydration.

- ◆ Carry drinking water when travelling.
- ◆ Use Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), and consume homemade drinks like lemon water, buttermilk/lassi, fruit juices with some added salt.
- ◆ Eat seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content like watermelon, musk melon, orange, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, lettuce or other locally available fruits and vegetables.

Stay covered:

- ◆ Wear thin loose, cotton garments preferably light coloured.
- ◆ Cover your head: use an umbrella, hat, cap, towel and other traditional head gears during exposure to direct sunlight.
- ◆ Wear shoes or chappals while going out in the sun.

Stay alert:

- ◆ Listen to the Radio; watch TV; read the Newspaper for local weather news.
- ◆ Get the latest update on weather on India Meteorological Department (IMD) website at <https://mausam.ind.gov.in>.

Stay indoors/in the shade as much as possible:

- ◆ In well-ventilated and cool places.
- ◆ Block direct sunlight and heat waves: Keep windows and curtains closed during the day, especially on the sunny side of your house. Open them up at night to let cooler air in.

If going outdoors, limit your outdoor activity to cooler times of the day i.e., morning and evening.

Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.

Don'ts

Avoid getting out in the sun, especially between 12:00 noon and 03:00 pm.

Avoid strenuous activities when outside in the afternoon.

Do not go out barefoot.

Avoid cooking during peak summer hours.

Open doors and windows to ventilate the cooking area adequately.

Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks or drinks with large amounts of sugar- as these actually, lead to loss of more body fluid or may cause stomach cramps.

Avoid high-protein food and do not eat stale food.

Do not leave children or pets in parked vehicles. The temperature inside a vehicle could get dangerous. (Source: State Health Society, UTHM)

Do's & Don'ts during Earthquake

Port Blair, Apr. 30

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to geological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts (Zone -V) of the world and several great earthquakes have occurred in the past. The severe earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical shift of land mass in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which caused the loss of lives and property of this UT.

Considering the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to the Do's & Don'ts of Earthquake to mitigate the impact of earthquake and save their precious lives.

Before Earthquake

- ⇒ Consult a structural engineer to make your house earthquake resilient.
- ⇒ Fasten shelves securely to walls; place heavy/ large objects on lower shelves. Provide strong support to power and gas appliances.
- ⇒ Prepare an emergency kit with essential items for safety and survival
- ⇒ Develop an emergency communication and evacuation plan for your family and community.
- ⇒ Learn the technique of 'Duck-Cover-Hold'.
- ⇒ Educate yourself and family members about earthquake risk by participating in earthquake safety programmes.

During Earthquake

- ⇒ Stay calm do not panic.

If you're indoors, stay inside. If you're outside, stay outside.

- ⇒ Don't use matches, candles, or any flame. Broken gas lines and fire don't mix.
- ⇒ If you are in a car, stop the car and stay inside until the earthquake stops.
- ⇒ Duck under a table; Cover your head with one hand and hold the table till the tremors last.
- ⇒ Stay away from mirrors and windows. Do not exit the building while the earth is still shaking.
- ⇒ Move outside as soon as the tremors stop. Do not use a lift.
- ⇒ When outside, move away from buildings, trees, walls and poles/electric lines.
- ⇒ When inside a vehicle, pull over in an open place and remain inside, avoid bridges.

After Earthquake

- ⇒ Do not enter damaged buildings.
- ⇒ If trapped in rubble: Do not light a matchstick Cover your mouth with a cloth Tap on a pipe or a wall Sound a whistle
- ⇒ Use stairs and not lifts or elevators.
- ⇒ Move cautiously and check for unstable objects and other hazards above and around you. Check yourself for injuries.
- ⇒ Stay away from beaches. Tsunamis and seiches sometimes hit after the ground stops shaking.
- ⇒ Do not spread and/or believe in rumours.

Precautionary measures during Tsunami

Port Blair, Apr. 30

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public of A&N Islands to follow the Do's & Don'ts of Tsunami, if it occurs.

DO's:

- Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.
- Move to higher ground: If a tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.
- Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
- Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
- Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

DON'Ts:

- Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-

lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.

- Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.
- Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the

beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.

- Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.

- Don't return to the area

until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

Medium Range Weather Forecast from 1 - 5 May, 2024

Port Blair, Apr.30

The forecast for the next five days indicates generally cloudy weather in the South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman and no rainfall is expected. Whereas in Nicobar Islands cloudy weather with light to moderate rainfall is likely to occur and during this period 56 mm of rainfall is expected. The maximum temperature is projected to range between 33.0 and 37.0 degrees Celsius, while the minimum temperature is expected to be within the range of 27.0 to 28.0 degrees Celsius. Additionally, the forecast suggests that the maximum relative humidity will fall between 70 % and 77 %, and the minimum relative humidity will be in the range of 64 % to 72 % in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speeds are expected to range from 5.0 to 16.0 kmph, predominantly

from the South Westerly direction.

Weather based agro advisories

For South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman
⇒ As the monsoon season is approaching farmers are requested to procure or collect the quality seeds of paddy crops from ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair.

- ⇒ Desilting of pond and BBF can be done as the weather is conducive.
- ⇒ Spray carbendazim @ 2 g/ lit to control powdery mildew in Bhendi.

- ⇒ To attract and kill the adults of slug caterpillar, controlled burning of infested leaves in pits/metal drum can be done during evening hours very carefully.
- ⇒ Provide plenty of drinking water with homemade butter milk to all livestock/ poultry to reduce mortality due to heat stress.

- ⇒ All types of domestic

livestock and poultry should be supplemented with mineral mixture along with Vitamin-C to control heat stress.

For Nicobar

- ⇒ Farmers of Campbell Bay are requested to procure or collect the quality seeds of paddy crops from ICAR-CIARI, Port Blair as the monsoon season is approaching.
- ⇒ To attract and kill the adults of slug caterpillar, controlled burning of infested leaves in pits/metal drum can be done during evening hours very carefully.
- ⇒ Make trenches across the slop in between coconut trees to harvest the rain water.

- ⇒ Rainfall is expected and advice to prevent sudden exposure of animals to rain/wet condition.
- ⇒ Deworm/vaccinate the animals before start of rainy season.
- ⇒ Provide sufficient green fodder along with dry fodder to the animals.(Source: CIARI, Port Blair)


