# **Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo System successfully flight-tested** by DRDO off Odisha coast

New Delhi, May 1(PIB)

Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo (SMART) system was successfully flighttested at around 0830 hrs on May 01, 2024 from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha. SMART is a nextgeneration missile-based lightweight torpedo delivery system, designed and developed by the Defence Research Development **Organisation** (DRDO) to enhance the antisubmarine warfare capability of the Indian Navy far beyond the conventional range of lightweight torpedo.

This canister-based missile system consists of several advanced sub-systems, namely two-stage propulsion solid system, electromechanical actuator system, precision inertial navigation system etc. The system carries advanced light-weight torpedo as payload along with parachute-based release system.

The missile was launched from the ground mobile launcher. Several state-of-the-art mechanisms such as symmetric separation, ejection and velocity control have been validated in this test.


