A&N Police introduces AI Chatbot for implementation of New Criminal Laws - Naye Kanoon Mitra



Port Blair, May 1

The three New Criminal Laws are set to roll out on 1st July, 2024 ushering in an era of modernized, reformed criminal jurisprudence. Andaman and Nicobar Police has launched the Artificial Intelligence (AI) based Chatbot called 'Naye Kanoon Mitra' yesterday by DGP,ANI, Shri Devesh Chandra Srivastva, IPS in the presence of IGP, Smti Sindhu Pillai A.,IPS, DIGP, Shri Ajay Krishan Sharma, IPS, DIGP, Smti Monika Bhardwaj, IPS and other senior officers of Andaman & Nicobar Police.

The chatbot has been created for the ease of understanding and referring to the three New Laws viz. Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita (BNS),



Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS) and Bharatiya Sakshya Adhiniyam (BSA).

The adoption of this AI Chatbot is an effort to harness the potential of Artificial Intelligence in delivering efficient and accessible services to the public. The Chatbot developed by SP South Andaman, Smti Niharika Bhatt, IPS and ASP, South Andaman, Shri Vikas Swami, IPS will serve as a virtual assistant, offering assistance on the principles and guidelines, outlined in the newly enacted laws. The chatbot



'Naye Kanoon Mitra' has been made accessible through two ways - a weblink and QR-code. This is the 3rd Chatbot launched by Andaman & Nicobar Police in its endeavor to make service delivery and legal knowledge more accessible with adoption of latest technology. The first Chatbot 'Election Mitra', launched on April 2, 2024 is focussed on providing

authentic information provided by various manuals of ECI in a user friendly and interactive manner. The second chatbot 'Cyber Saarthi' launched on April 9, 2024, is aimed at transforming the way in which information related to cyber crime is made accessible to the public. This chatbot answers the many questions that people may have regarding cyber crimes. Both the

chatbots are accessible through widely advertised and circulated QR codes. The Andaman & Nicobar Police in its endeavor to create awareness of the three new Criminal Laws has undertaken a Union Territory wide campaign in the last 4 months. All the three districts viz. South Andaman, North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar District have shown keen interest

In all, 8 teams out of 30+ teams from all disciplines were shortlisted for the final competition Prakalp-2024. The teams made presentations and real time demos of the projects. External experts spanning diverse Engineering backgrounds were drawn as judges for the competition. Mentors from Deptt. of Industries were also invited for start-up mentoring since engineering projects are proof of concepts and has huge potential for being converted to Start-up ventures. Prakalp-2024 provided a platform for seamless integration of showcasing engineering solutions and pitching of ideas for start-ups. Shri Manohar Singh, Retd. SE (Electricity Dept), ex-Chairman IEI (ANSC), Shri Vijayratnam, Consultant Designer and Engineer M/s Globe Consultancy Services, Shri S. Sendil Kumar, Joint Director (IT), NIC Port Blair, Shri Debdas Paik, Scientist and Manager (ISRO) Port Blair, Ms. S. Sunita Kumari, AD (Tech) Deptt. of Industries and Shri Mohd. The projects evaluation revolved around the parameters like Presentation, Demonstration, Innovation, Application, Social Viability and Environmental Sustenance and was assessed through a scientifically designed rubric to eliminate any subjectivity in evaluation.

Speaking on the occasion, Veteran Engineer Shri Manohar Singh appreciated the students' efforts and urged them to take the projects to the next higher level. Veteran Engineer Shri Vijayratnam, Consultant Designer and Engineer M/s Globe Consultancy Services also motivated the student participants and advised them to include AI components wherever applicable.

The team of B.Tech (ECE) and Diploma (Mech) was adjudged the Winner and Runner of Prakalp-2024 respectively. The best project concerned with designing various antennas for tracking and retrieving weather related information from freely available bands of NOAA Satellites whereas the runner up team designed and fabricated a Solar Dryer System that combines solar energy with forced convection for efficient drying of agricultural produce. The other projects included creating paver blocks using recycled waste materials by partial replacement, e-shopping platform, Tourist App using AR/VR, Design, fabrication and installation of car parking indicator system, design, fabrication and installation of motorized white board wiping system and swotting AR. The winning team bagged Rs. 10,000 and the runner-up team bagged Rs. 5000/- cash award.

Mumbai, May 1

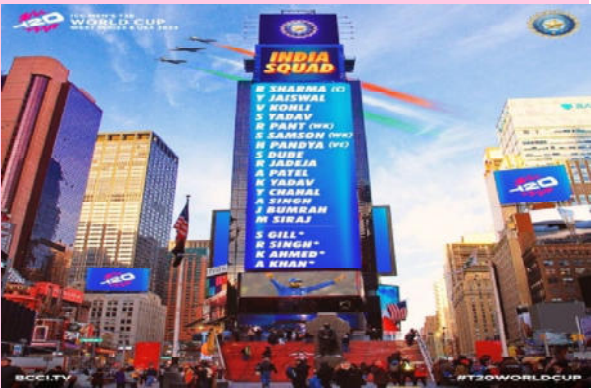

Do's

For general population

Stay hydrated:

Drink sufficient water whenever possible, even if you are not thirsty.

Thirst is not a good indicator of dehydration.

- ◆ Carry drinking water when travelling.
- ◆ Use Oral Rehydration Solution (ORS), and consume homemade drinks like lemon water, buttermilk/lassi, fruit juices with some added salt.
- ◆ Eat seasonal fruits and vegetables with high water content like watermelon, musk melon, orange, grapes, pineapple, cucumber, lettuce or other locally available fruits and vegetables.

Stay covered:

- ◆ Wear thin loose, cotton garments preferably light coloured.
- ◆ Cover your head: use an umbrella, hat, cap, towel and other traditional head gears during exposure to direct sunlight.
- ◆ Wear shoes or chappals while going out in the sun.

Stay alert:

- ◆ Listen to the Radio; watch TV; read the Newspaper for local weather news.
- ◆ Get the latest update on weather on India Meteorological Department (IMD) website at <https://mausam.imd.gov.in>.

Stay indoors/in the shade as much as possible:

- ◆ In well-ventilated and cool places.
- ◆ Block direct sunlight and heat waves: Keep windows and curtains closed during the day, especially on the sunny side of your house. Open them up at night to let cooler air in.

If going outdoors, limit your outdoor activity to cooler times of the day i.e., morning and evening.

Reschedule or plan outdoor activities during cooler parts of the day.

Don'ts

Avoid getting out in the sun, especially between 12:00 noon and 03:00 pm.

Avoid strenuous activities when outside in the afternoon.

Do not go out barefoot.

Avoid cooking during peak summer hours.

Open doors and windows to ventilate the cooking area adequately.

Avoid alcohol, tea, coffee and carbonated soft drinks or drinks with large amounts of sugar- as these actually, lead to loss of more body fluid or may cause stomach cramps.

Avoid high-protein food and do not eat stale food.

The vessel MV Swaraj Dweep which sailed from Chennai is expected to arrive at Port Blair tomorrow (May 2) at 1700 hrs. She has on board, a total of 196 passengers plus 3 infants, 281 MT

cargo and 22 containers.

On arrival at Port Blair, the vessel will be berthed at Haddo Wharf and passengers will be disembarked immediately, a press release from DSS said.

Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo System successfully flight-tested by DRDO off Odisha coast

New Delhi, May 1(PIB)

Supersonic Missile-Assisted Release of Torpedo (SMART) system was successfully flight-tested at around 0830 hrs on May 01, 2024 from Dr APJ Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha. SMART is a next-generation missile-based light-weight torpedo delivery system, designed and developed by the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO) to enhance the anti-submarine warfare capability of the Indian Navy far beyond the conventional range of lightweight torpedo.

This canister-based missile system consists of several advanced sub-systems, namely two-stage solid propulsion system, electromechanical actuator system, precision inertial navigation system etc. The system carries advanced light-weight torpedo as payload along with parachute-based release system.

The missile was launched from the ground mobile launcher. Several state-of-the-art mechanisms such as symmetric separation, ejection and velocity control have been validated in this test.



Disaster Management Deptt. issues advisory on forest fire safety measures

Port Blair, May 1

The A & N Islands are covered with 81% of tropical rain forests of its total geographical area and it is rich heritage of biodiversity having various eco-systems like marine, terrestrial, coastal, mangroves etc.

Extended summer season may cause forest fire as dry leaves are susceptible and works as good fuel. In past, few forest fires have caused damage of forest, wildlife and environment etc. The residents of rural areas surrounding forest have been requested to follow Do's and Don'ts of forest fire and to safeguard the eco-system of the territory.

Know your forest fire risk:

- Be aware of weather updates, emergency instructions of evacuation orders.

- Teach all household members the technique of stop, drop and roll methods in case of fire.

- Create a safety zone by removing vegetation/articles that easily catches fire. Consult with local Fire & Forest Departments about making home fire-resistant.

- Keep evacuation checklist and emergency Kit (including a flashlight, mobile phone, batteries, cash, water bottle, dry fruits/ snacks, first aid supplies

etc.) ready before the fire season sets in.

- Breathe close to the ground preferably through moist cloth to avoid inhaling smoke.

- During any fire activity keep a shovel, water and fire extinguisher nearby to keep fires in check in dry seasons.

- Never leave a fire unattended without completely extinguishing, checking and re-checking the ashes near the vegetation.

- Do not leave/throw cigarettes, matches, and other smoking near forest area without completely extinguishing it.

- Do not leave behind flammables during outdoor camping in forest areas.

- Avoid any open burning in windy conditions in forest area.

The Disaster Management Department has urged the general public to contact & report immediately to the local Fire & Emergency Services, Forest Department and Control Rooms of A&N Islands in case of Forest Fire over (Helpline Numbers: 101 (Fire), 112 (ERSS) 244166 (Forest), 1070 (SEOC) & 1077 (DEOC), a press release from Disaster Management Department said.

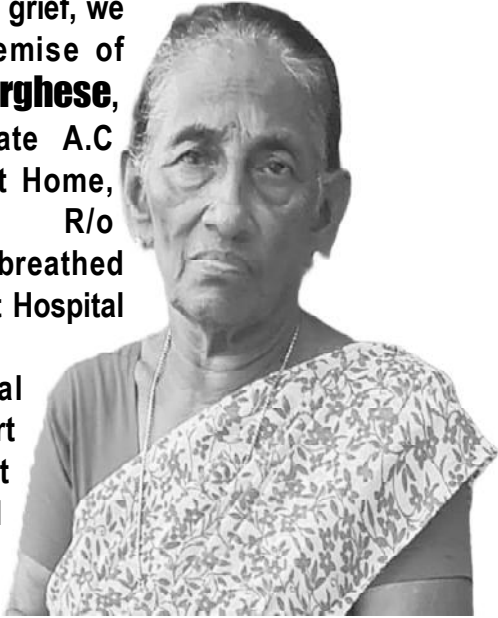
