In this regard, from May 6, 2024, service of electric buses will be available to provide connectivity between airport passenger terminal, Haddo, Phoenix Bay Jetty, Bus Terminus and other important points in the city. It will benefit mainly senior citizen, especially abled, children etc. apart from other commuters.

requests, messages from unknown numbers. Similarly, avoid sending friend requests to people you do not know.

➤ Avoid sharing your phone number online with anyone unless you know the person well.

➤ Avoid sharing intimate photos or videos with others on social media or other messaging apps, as these may be used for blackmailing.

➤ Keep a record of all contacts from the blackmailer(s), particularly any demands or threats and make a note of everything you know about them for reporting purposes.

Do's & Don'ts during Earthquake

Port Blair, May 4

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to geological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts (Zone -V) of the world and several great earthquakes have occurred in the past. The severe earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical shift of land mass in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which caused the loss of lives and property of this UT.

Considering the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to the Do's & Don'ts of Earthquake to mitigate the impact of earthquake and save their precious lives.

Before Earthquake
⇒ Consult a structural engineer to make your house earthquake resilient.
⇒ Fasten shelves securely to walls; place heavy/ large objects on lower shelves. Provide strong support to power and gas appliances.
⇒ Prepare an emergency kit with essential items for safety and survival.
⇒ Develop an emergency communication and evacuation plan for your family and community.
⇒ Learn the technique of 'Duck-Cover-Hold'.
⇒ Educate yourself and family members about earthquake risk by participating in earthquake safety programmes.

During Earthquake
⇒ Stay calm do not panic.

If you're indoors, stay inside. If you're outside, stay outside.

⇒ Don't use matches, candles, or any flame. Broken gas lines and fire don't mix.
⇒ If you are in a car, stop the car and stay inside until the earthquake stops.
⇒ Duck under a table; Cover your head with one hand and hold the table till the tremors last.

⇒ Stay away from mirrors and windows. Do not exit the building while the earth is still shaking.
⇒ Move outside as soon as the tremors stop. Do not use a lift.
⇒ When outside, move away from buildings, trees, walls and poles/electric lines.
⇒ When inside a vehicle, pull over in an open place and remain inside, avoid bridges.

After Earthquake
⇒ Do not enter damaged buildings.
⇒ If trapped in rubble: Do not light a matchstick Cover your mouth with a cloth Tap on a pipe or a wall Sound a whistle
⇒ Use stairs and not lifts or elevators.
⇒ Move cautiously and check for unstable objects and other hazards above and around you. Check yourself for injuries.
⇒ Stay away from beaches. Tsunamis and seiches sometimes hit after the ground stops shaking.
⇒ Do not spread and/or believe in rumours.

Precautionary measures during Tsunami

Port Blair, May 4

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public of A&N Islands to follow the Do's & Don'ts of Tsunami, if it occurs.

DO's:
► Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.
► Move to higher ground: If a tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.
► Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.
► Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.
► Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

DON'Ts:
► Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-

lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.

► Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do not go there to watch the wave.
► Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the

beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.

► Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.

► Don't return to the area

until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.

Agromet Advisory Bulletin : Medium Range Weather Forecast

Port Blair, May 4

The forecast for the next five days indicates generally cloudy weather and light rainfall is expected in South Andaman and North and Middle during this period. Whereas in Nicobar Islands cloudy weather and light rain with thunder is likely to occur and during this period 24 mm of rainfall is expected. The maximum temperature is projected to range between 33.0 and 34.0 degrees Celsius, while the minimum temperature is expected to be within the range of 26.0 to 27.0 degrees Celsius. Additionally, the forecast suggests that the maximum relative humidity will fall between 65 % and 73 %, and the minimum relative humidity will be in the range of 59 % to 65 % in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. Wind speeds are expected to range from 5.0 to 11.0 kmph, predominantly from the South Westerly direction.

Weather based agro advisories
For South Andaman and North and Middle Andaman

⇒ After harvesting the pulse crop, dry the seeds adequately to reduce moisture level to 10 % and pack in polythene lined gunny bags for storage.
⇒ Make soil mount around the gourd (Cucurbit) to avoid moisture stress and irrigate the crops during evening hours.
⇒ Collect and chop the available unwanted organic materials and fill the vermicompost tank for compost preparation.
⇒ Fix 4 to 5 light traps per acre and fill 1/4th of the container with water and add 5 ml kerosene to control coconut leaf eating caterpillar.
⇒ Take up land shaping work in low lying area as the soil condition is good.
⇒ Provide vitamin-C and electrolyte along with cool drinking water to the poultry birds to prevent from heat

stress as maximum temperature likely to be from 33 to 34 oC.

For Nicobar
⇒ Collect and chop the available unwanted organic materials and fill the vermicompost tank for compost preparation.
⇒ Fix 4 to 5 light traps per acre and fill 1/4th of the container with water and add 5 ml kerosene to control coconut leaf eating caterpillar.
⇒ Take up land shaping work in low lying area as the soil condition is good.
⇒ Make trenches across the slop in between coconut trees to harvest the rain water.
⇒ Rainfall is expected and advice to prevent sudden exposure of animals to rain/wet condition.
⇒ Deworm/vaccinate the animals before start of rainy season
⇒ Provide vitamin-C and electrolyte along with cool drinking water to the poultry birds to prevent from heat stress as maximum temperature likely to be from 33 to 34 oC. (Source: CIARI, Port Blair)

- (3) to answer the claim and you are directed to produce on that day all the documents upon which you intend to rely in support of your defence.

Take notice that in default of your appearance on the day before mentioned, the suit will be heard or determined in your absence.
