

## President graces 7<sup>th</sup> Convocation of Central University of Himachal Pradesh

**Education should also focus on creating awareness among students about their culture, tradition and civilization: President**

New Delhi, May 6 (PIB)

The President of India, Smt Droupadi Murmu graced and addressed the 7<sup>th</sup> convocation of Central University of Himachal Pradesh at Dharamshala today. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that change is the law of nature. But, the pace of change was not so rapid in the past. Today we are in the era of the 4<sup>th</sup> Industrial Revolution. New areas like Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning are emerging rapidly. Both the speed and magnitude of change are very high, due to which technology and required skills are changing very quickly. At the beginning of the 21<sup>st</sup> century no one knew what kind of skills people would need in the next 20 or 25 years. Similarly, many



current skills will no longer be useful in the future. Therefore, we have to continuously adopt new skills. Our focus should be on developing flexible minds so that the young generation can keep pace with the rapid changes taking place. We have to strengthen the curiosity and the desire to learn in the students to prepare them for facing the challenges of the 21<sup>st</sup> century.

Addressing the teachers, the President said that education should be such that along with educating the students, it makes them self-reliant and builds their character and personality. The aim of education is also to bring awareness among the students about their culture, tradition and civilization. She stressed that the role of teachers is very important in this regard. Their scope of work is not limited to teaching only, and

they have the huge responsibility of building the future of the nation.

The President said that our focus should be on 'what to learn' as well as 'how to learn'. She underlined that when students learn independently, without any stress, their creativity and imagination take flight. In that case they do not consider education as just a synonym for

## Emergency Response Support System - Dial 112

**People can register voluntarily on 112 India mobile app and utilize ERSS 112 in case of any emergency**

Port Blair, May 6  
The Government of India's initiative to integrate emergency Helplines into a single Helpline has resulted in the rolling out of 112 number. ERSS-112, launched in 2019 in A & N Islands, offers residents the opportunity to access emergency services through the 112 helpline during any crisis. ERSS is a unified, Andaman-wide response system, accessible through the single number 112, providing immediate

assistance from agencies such as Police (100), Fire (101), Health (102) and Disaster Management. Any citizen in distress can dial 112 from their phone, press the power button thrice on any Smartphone, or long-press the '5' or '9' key on a regular phone to activate a panic call to the dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room. Additionally, SOS alerts can be sent via email or by using the 112 India mobile app, available for free on Google Play Store and

Apple Store. This system includes a dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room staffed with trained call-takers and dispatchers to handle emergency requests for assistance from Police, Fire, Health, and other agencies. All call logs are maintained digitally. This Control Room is linked to Emergency Response Vehicles and Control Rooms of various Departments to provide assistance to victims.

**A&N Police apprehends a person for circulating intimate video over WhatsApp**

Port Blair, May 6

In a significant breakthrough, the Police Station Cyber Crime has s u c c e s s f u l l y apprehended a person named Vijay Victor, aged about 30 years for circulating intimate video of a victim girl over WhatsApp. A formal complaint was lodged by the victim in which she stated that, earlier she was in a relationship with the offender for more than four years and at that time, the offender had recorded their intimate moments in his mobile phone. Later, when the relationship turned sour, then in order to teach the victim a lesson the offender circulated their intimate video over WhatsApp.

The Investigation Officer, Inspector Ranga Raj, SHO, Cyber Crime Police Station, Port Blair, put the offender under sustained interrogation, during which the offender accepted his guilt and the video which was circulated over WhatsApp was also recovered from the mobile phone of offender. Later, the offender, Vijay Victor was arrested and sent to judicial custody where he will face charges under Information Technology Act and other applicable laws. The section in this FIR are: 66(E) (Punishment for publishing or transmitting the image of a private area of a person, without his or her consent)/67 (publishing or transmitting obscene material in electronic form)/67(A) (publishing or transmitting of material containing sexually explicit act, in electronic form) of IT Act, 2000, r.w.s 323 IPC(voluntarily causing hurt)/292 IPC (Circulation of obscene video)/427 IPC (for committing mischief and thereby causes loss or damage to the property)/ 506 IPC (For criminal intimidation).

The entire investigation was carried out under the supervision of Shri Lakshay Pandey, Dy.SP (Cyber Crime) and overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranian, IPS, Superintendent of Police (CID/Vigilance Security). The A&N Police is committed to ensure the safety and honour of the women within these Islands.

The A&N Police has urged the public to stay alert and report any such unlawful activities immediately.
