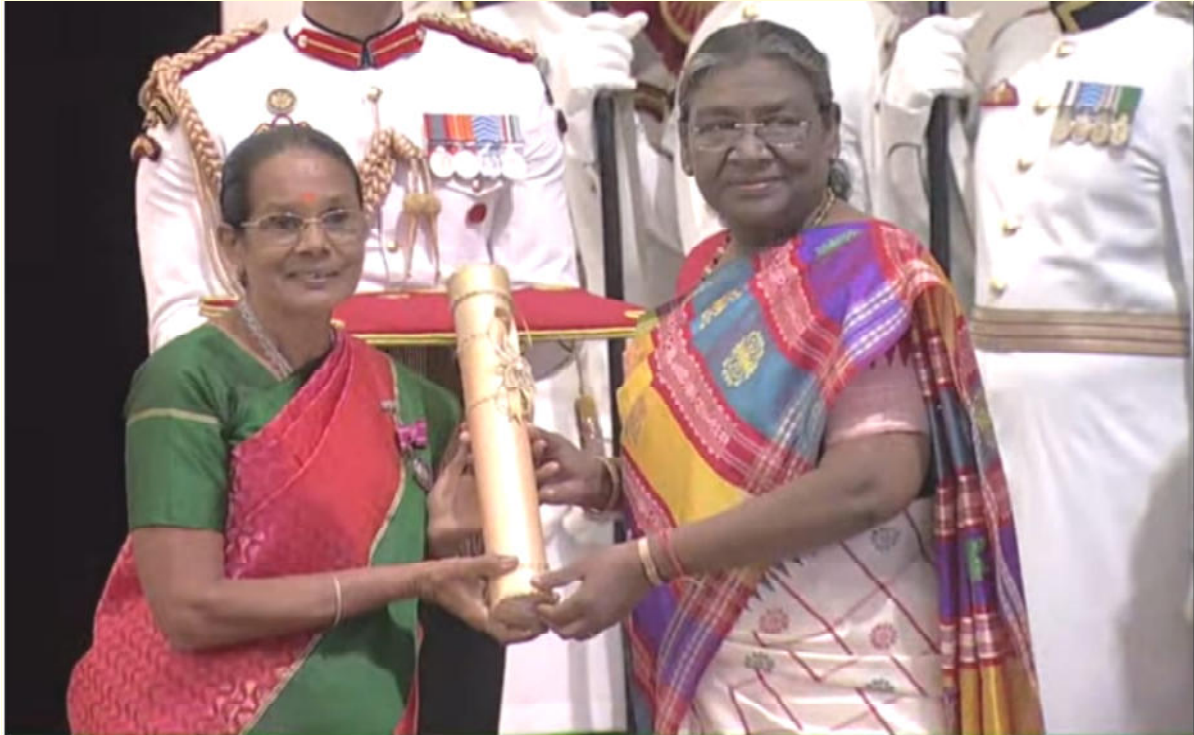

Isles organic farmer, Smt. K. Chellammal receives Padma Shri Award



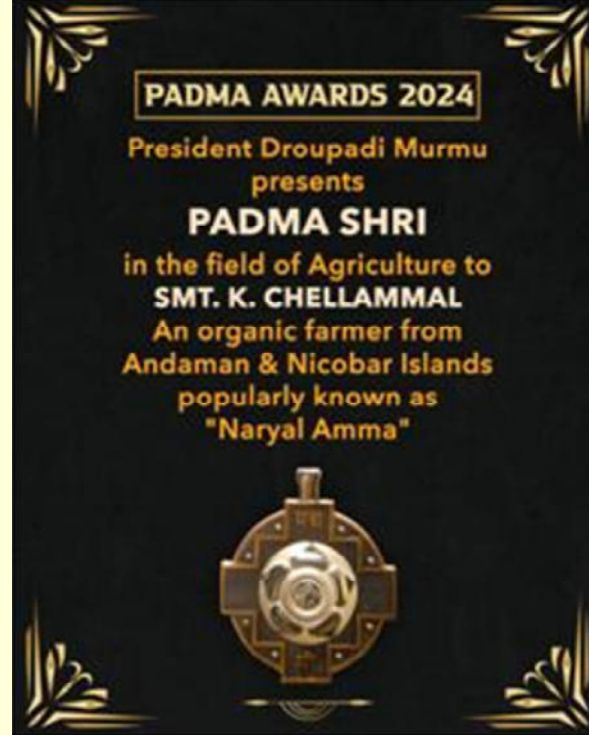
President presenting Padma Shri Award to Smt. K. Chellammal from A&N Islands

New Delhi, May 9

The President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu presented Padma Vibhushan, Padma Bhushan and Padma Shri Awards for the year 2024 at the Civil Investiture Ceremony-II held at Rashtrapati Bhavan today. The Vice President of India, Shri Jagdeep Dhankhar, Prime Minister, Shri Narendra

Modi, Union Home Minister and Minister of Cooperation, Shri Amit Shah, many Ministers of the Union and other dignitaries were present on the occasion.

One among the recipient of the award was Smt. K. Chellammal, an organic farmer from Andaman and Nicobar Islands for her outstanding



contribution in the field of agriculture. Her methods include mulching for moisture retention, integrated pest management, and diversified cropping. She is known as "Naryal Amma" because of her sustainable and profitable coconut-based cropping system. She promotes agro tourism and has introduced innovative solutions for many crop production related issues.

Safeguarding various species of wild animals through enforcement of Rules under Section 49M of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972

Section 49 M of the Act mandates registration of possession, transfer and birth as well as reporting the death of living scheduled animal species

Port Blair, May 9

The Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972) stands as a pivotal legal framework for safeguarding various species of wild animals ensuring the preservation of their habitats and regulating the trade in products derived from them. The most recent amendment to the Act in 2022, known as the Wild Life (Protection) Amendment Act, 2022 has been in effect since 1st April, 2023.

Section 49 M of the Act mandates the registration of possession, transfer and birth as well as reporting the death of living scheduled animal species listed in the Appendices of CITES and classified under Schedule IV of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change in line with its commitment to Wildlife Conservation has notified rules

called the Living Animal Species (Reporting and Registration) Rules, 2024 issued vide Gazette Notification on February 28, 2024 regarding the enforcement of rules U/s- 49 M of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

This Notification signifies a significant step forward in wildlife conservation efforts. The notification outlines the procedures and requirements for

registration and reporting under Section 49 M facilitating efficient compliance and monitoring.

Under the new rules, individuals possessing living specimens of such animal species are obligated to apply for registration within six months of the Rule's commencement. Subsequently, any possession of such species must be reported within thirty

Repeat offender arrested in connection with jewellery theft case in Joda Kilan

Port Blair, May 9

A complaint was registered at PS Phargaon from a R/o Jodakilan, Bimblitan regarding theft of jewellery i.e. 02 Gold Necklace, 01 Long chain, 03 small chain, 03 finger ring, 02 pair

of earring, 02 Nos. bangles and 01 ear mat worth Rs. 10 lakh approx. Upon this, an FIR vide No. 86/24 dated 08/05/2024 U/s. 457/380 IPC was registered at PS Pahargaon and investigation was

entrusted to SI Viswanand.

Acting swiftly on the complaint, a team comprising of SI Viswanand, PC D Shiv Kumar and PC Sandeep Lakra was constituted by

PS Crime & Economic Offence raid shatters
Methamphetamine network

Port Blair, May 9

In a decisive crackdown on drug trafficking, a team comprising of Inspector Girish Kumar, SHO, PS Crime & Economic Offence, ASI Mohd. Rafique, HC/ Sanjit Madhu, HC/Sanjay Kujur, HC/Shibani Biswas, PC/N. Thangaraj, PC/K. Rajendran and PC/Y. Srinivas Rao from PS Crime & Economic Offence (Then CCS) under the supervision of Shri Kumar Abhishek, Dy.SP (CID) conducted a meticulously planned raid at Malai Bijan, Haddo on the night of April 26-27, 2024, which led to the swift arrest of accused T. Naveen Kumar, S/o Shri T. Dharma Rao, 23 yrs, Pvt. Worker R/o House No. 18/ 21, M.B. Street, Malai Bijan, Haddo and recovered 31 grams of Methamphetamine.

Following the arrest, a thorough investigation uncovered a complex network of drug distribution. Accused T. Naveen Kumar disclosed the involvement of Sanjeev Mazumdar in procuring Methamphetamine from Hut Bay. Sanjeev Mazumder, S/o Late Mihir Mazumder, 23 yrs, R/o Craikabad, Chouldari was subsequently arrested with 18 grams of Methamphetamine seized from his possession by the same team on April 27, 2024.

Further unraveling the chain, accused Eswar Rao, 33 yrs, R/o Behind Kalapani Museum, Garacharma was identified as the recipient of the illicit substance and was subsequently arrested on April 28, 2024 with 4.36 grams of Methamphetamine recovered from his possession by the team from PS Crime & Economic Offence.

In the coordinated effort to dismantle the syndicate,

a dedicated team led by SI Parvash, HC/ Sanjit Madhu & HC/Sanjay Kujur was deployed to investigate further at Hut Bay. On April 5, 2024, the team recovered 200 grams of Methamphetamine from Bittu Gharami, S/o Shri Jasomanto Gharami, 23 yrs, R/o Ward No.1, R.K.Pur, Little Andaman and 45 grams from Shridam Xalxo, S/o Late Silvanus Xalxo, 34 yrs, R/o Ward No.9 R.K.Pur, Little Andaman. The above two accused persons were promptly arrested under relevant sections of the NDPS Act 1985.

Continuing the vigilant operation, the team recovered an additional 10 grams of Methamphetamine from the residence of accused Shridam Xalxo on May 7, 2024. Furthermore, 200 grams of Methamphetamine were seized from another accused, Saurav Dhali, S/o Sudev Dhali, 22 yrs., Pvt. Worker, R/o Ward No.06, Ramakrishnapur, Hutbay, Little Andaman, leading to his prompt arrest. All the seizure and arrest at Little Andaman was effected by the above team deputed from PS C&EO in the presence of Shri Ajoy Mondal, Executive Magistrate-cum- Tehsildar, Little Andaman.

Investigations revealed the involvement of prime accused Shridam Xalxo and Bittu Gharami (old acquaintances) from Little Andaman who were approached by Naveen Kumar and Sanjeev Mazumder during a visit to Hut Bay on 11 April, 2024. A lucrative deal was struck, with an initial payment of Rs. 47,000 digitally transferred to the account of the now-apprehended Sukumar Mondal, S/o Late Swapan Mondal, 27 yrs, Pvt. Worker, R/o RK Pur,

Little Andaman. However, due to the parliamentary elections, the contraband delivery was delayed. Undeterred, Sanjeev & Naveen revisited Hut Bay post-elections, finalizing the delivery of Methamphetamine with an additional cash & digital payment of Rs. 1.5 Lakhs to Shridam Xalxo and Bittu Gharami.

The Investigative team and Officers of Police Station Crime & Economic Offence conducted the operation under the leadership of Inspector Girish Kumar, SHO, PS C&EO, resulting in the seizure of 508.36 grams of Methamphetamine and subsequent arrest of seven individuals involved in its possession and distribution sends shockwaves through illicit networks, highlighting the relentless pursuit of justice and the uncompromising stance against drug-related offenses. This bold action underscores the Law Enforcement's unwavering commitment to preserving community safety and upholding the rule of law.

Transit remand of all the four accused persons from Little Andaman have been obtained for production before the Hon'ble Court at Port Blair today.

The entire operation was conducted under the command of Shri Lakshay Pandey, Dy. SP (CID) and under overall supervision of Shri Rajeev Ranjan, IPS, SP (CID).

Meanwhile, the general public have been requested to inform about any credible information pertaining to sale or possession of contrabands or any other illegal activity on the following telephone numbers- 100, 232586, 233307, 9933242204 & 9434280100. The identity of the informer will be kept secret, a press release from SP (CID) said.

Accommodation under General Pool and as such their applications will not be entertained.

Applications from the Government servants who are on fresh appointment or on transfer from Out Station or on Deputation (after last date of receipt of online application i.e., 14/06/2024) and 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground shall be received throughout the year through online and their placement in the seniority list shall be made accordingly.

The allottee/ occupants who desire to apply for change of their present quarter to Same Type on repair/medical/mutual/transferral grounds etc. and Higher Type shall also register their applications on online portal only. No hard copy of application is required to be submitted or forwarded to Assistant Secretary (H&E), Secretariat and such applications will not be entertained.

Note:

i) The applicants, who intends to apply for allotment of Government Accommodation on seniority basis, should upload recent passport size photo, signature, copy of initial appointment order, pay slip, transfer order/deputation order (in case of transfer/ deputation from out station after the last date of receipt of online application) in the online portal for verification of concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary(H&E). Photo & Signature should be in jpg/jpeg format (size 20-50 kbs) and documents should be in complete shape & in jpg/jpeg/pdf format (size 20-200 kbs) only.

ii) The applicants those who desire to apply for change of quarter for Same Type should upload copy of quarter allotment order/occupation report in the online portal alongwith the documents mentioned at SL.No.(i).

days through the PARIVESH 2.0 portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/parivesh-ua/#/>) to the concerned State Chief Wild Life Warden.

Moreover, the rules stipulate that any transfer of possession and the birth of offspring of such specimens shall also be registered while the death of such specimens must be reported promptly to the respective Chief Wild Life Warden through the PARIVESH 2.0 portal.

This initiative underscores the Government's commitment to bolstering wildlife protection measures and fostering greater accountability in the management of schedule species.
