CBSE declares Class 10 & 12 Board Exam Results, Girls outshine Boys

New Delhi, May 13

The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) today declared the results of Class 10th and 12th board examinations in which girls have outshined boys. In a statement, CBSE said, 87.98 per cent of students have passed 12th board exams. The passing percentage is 0.65 per cent higher than the last year. Over 24 thousand candidates have scored above 95 per cent and over one lakh sixteen thousand students



got above 90 per cent in this examination.

In 10th board examination, overall passing percentage is 93.60. The passing percentage of girls is 94.75 while for boys, it is 92.71. The results can be accessed at websites including www.cbseresults.nic.in, www.cbse.gov.in as well as digilocker and Umang apps.

Safeguarding various species of wild animals through enforcement of Rules under Section 49M of Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972

Section 49 M of the Act mandates registration of possession, transfer and birth as well as reporting the death of living scheduled animal species

Port Blair, May 13

The Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972 (53 of 1972) stands as a pivotal legal framework safeguarding various species of wild animals ensuring the preservation of their habitats and regulating the trade in products derived from them. The most recent amendment to the Act in 2022, known as the Wild Life (Protection) Amendment Act, 2022 has been in effect since 1st April, 2023.

Section 49 M of the Act mandates the registration of possession, transfer and birth as well as reporting the death of living scheduled animal species listed in the Appendices of CITES and classified under Schedule IV

of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change in line with its commitment to Wildlife Conservation has notified rules called the Living Animal Species (Reporting and Registration) Rules, 2024 issued vide Gazette Notification on February 28, 2024 regarding the enforcement of rules U/s- 49 M of the Wild Life (Protection) Act, 1972.

This Notification signifies a significant step forward in wildlife conservation efforts. The notification outlines the procedures and requirements for registration and reporting

under Section 49 M facilitating efficient compliance and monitoring.

Under the new rules, individuals possessing living specimens of such animal species are obligated to apply for registration within six months of the Rule's commencement. Subsequently, any possession of such species must be reported within thirty days through the PARIVESH 2.0 portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/parivesh-ua/#/>) to the concerned State Chief Wild Life Warden.

Moreover, the rules stipulate that any transfer of possession and the birth of offspring of such specimens shall also be registered while

the death of such specimens must be reported promptly to the respective Chief Wild Life Warden through the PARIVESH 2.0 portal.

This initiative underscores the Government's commitment to bolstering wildlife protection measures and fostering greater accountability in the management of schedule species.

It had built in feature of online verification by DDOs, Medical Department (for medical cases) and H&E Department for further verification.

Now, the Housing & Estate Department, Andaman and Nicobar Administration, Secretariat has invited online applications for allotment of Government Accommodation under General Pool from Government employees of various Departments under Andaman & Nicobar Administration for the Session 2024-2025 from 16/05/2024 to 14/06/2024.

The Government Servants whose name enlisted in the existing seniority list under General category and 'Out of Turn' on medical ground for the Session 2023-2024 and not allotted Government Accommodation till date have been requested to apply afresh for the Session 2024-2025.

As per Rule-5 of Allotment of Accommodation of Andaman and Nicobar Administrative Residences (General Pool) Rules, 1991, allotment to such regular Government Servants of the Administration will be made on the basis of seniority as determined from the date of their entry into Government service under the A&N Administration. Adhoc/Contract employees are not eligible for allotment of Government Residential Accommodation under General Pool and as such their applications will not be entertained.

Applications from the Government servants who are on fresh appointment or on transfer from Out Station or on Deputation (after last date

of receipt of online application i.e., 14/06/2024) and 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground shall be received throughout the year through online and their placement in the seniority list shall be made accordingly.

The allottee/ occupants who desire to apply for change of their present quarter to Same Type on repair/medical/mutual/transferal grounds etc. and Higher Type shall also register their applications on online portal only.

No hard copy of application is required to be submitted or forwarded to Assistant Secretary (H&E), Secretariat and such applications will not be entertained.

Note

i) The applicants, who intends to apply for allotment of Government Accommodation on seniority basis, should upload recent passport size photo, signature, copy of initial appointment order, pay slip, transfer order/deputation order (in case of transfer/deputation from out station after the last date of receipt of online application) in the

online portal for verification of concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary (H&E). Photo & Signature should be in jpg/jpeg. format (size 20-50 kbs) and documents should be in complete shape & in jpg/jpeg/pdf format (size 20-200 kbs) only.

ii) The applicants those who desire to apply for change of quarter for Same Type should upload copy of quarter allotment order/occupation report in the online portal alongwith the documents mentioned at Sl.No.(i).

iii) The applicants those who desire to apply for 'Out of Turn' allotment on medical ground should upload copies of latest medical certificates in the online portal for verification of Medical Board alongwith the documents mentioned at Sl.No.(i).

iv) Online registration of application is available in the portal <https://aaga.andaman.gov.in> from 16/05/2024 to 14/06/2024.

v) The applicants should register online application form very carefully as no option for alternation/modification in

the submitted application is available in the portal. On rejection of application, the applicant should again submit fresh application in the online portal within the stipulated period.

vi) The applicant should ensure that his application is verified and accepted by his DDO/HOO within two days of its submission and within the stipulated period. No request for acceptance of delayed application shall be entertained.

vii) The applicant should provide/ fill all the mandatory details in capital letters in the online portal and upload documents in complete shape, failing which, the application will not be accepted by the concerned DDOs and Assistant Secretary (H&E) or summarily rejected.

viii) Before registering online application, the applicants should watch the videos provided in the homepage of AAGA portal.

ix) The portal will also allow the applicant to take printout of the submitted application for record purpose only, a press release from Assistant Secretary (H&E) said.

Do's & Don'ts during Earthquake

Port Blair, May 13

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to geological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts (Zone -V) of the world and several great earthquakes have occurred in the past. The severe earthquake that occurred on December 26, 2004 caused horizontal and vertical shift of land mass in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, which caused the loss of lives and property of this UT.

Considering the above, the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has urged the general public of A&N Islands to adhere to the Do's & Don'ts of Earthquake to mitigate the impact of earthquake and save their precious lives.

Before Earthquake

⇒ Consult a structural engineer to make your house earthquake resilient.

⇒ Fasten shelves securely to walls; place heavy/ large objects on lower shelves. Provide strong support to power and gas appliances.

⇒ Prepare an emergency kit with essential items for safety and survival.

⇒ Develop an emergency communication and evacuation plan for your family and community.

⇒ Learn the technique of 'Duck-Cover-Hold.

⇒ Educate yourself and family members about earthquake risk by participating in earthquake safety programmes.

During Earthquake

If you're indoors, stay inside. If you're outside, stay outside.

⇒ Don't use matches, candles, or any flame. Broken gas lines and fire don't mix.

⇒ If you are in a car, stop the car and stay inside until the earthquake stops.

⇒ Duck under a table; Cover your head with one hand and hold the table till the tremors last.

⇒ Stay away from mirrors and windows. Do not exit the building while the earth is still shaking.

⇒ Move outside as soon as the tremors stop. Do not use a lift.

⇒ When outside, move away from buildings, trees, walls and poles/ electric lines.

⇒ When inside a vehicle, pull over in an open place and remain inside, avoid bridges.

After Earthquake

⇒ Do not enter damaged buildings.

⇒ If trapped in rubble: Do not light a matchstick Cover your mouth with a cloth

Tap on a pipe or a wall Sound a whistle

⇒ Use stairs and not lifts or elevators.

⇒ Move cautiously and check for unstable objects and other hazards above and around you. Check yourself for injuries.

⇒ Stay away from beaches. Tsunamis and seiches sometimes hit after the ground stops shaking.

⇒ Do not spread and/ or believe in rumours.

A&N Police Public issues advisory regarding fake delivery parcel scam to get OTPs from targeted victims

As people become more aware about the methods used by cybercriminals, they are getting creative, developing new methods for fraud. Cybercriminals are perpetrating a new scam targeting many people to get OTPs (One Time Passwords) for making fraudulent bank transactions and getting access to the victims' email addresses/ smart phones by manipulating them with Fake Delivery Parcel Scam. These scams are often carried out by people who work closely with delivery agents or delivery agencies. When they find out that a particular person receives a lot of packages from various e-commerce companies, then they plan to target him. In this regard, Andaman and Nicobar Police has issued the following advisory to safeguard the citizens:

➤ Confirm your order history and the potential delivery dates before accepting / cancelling any package.

➤ Avoid clicking on any link received in an SMS when dealing with such package deliveries.

➤ Scrutinize all the URLs (links) before opening and filling in any information/ OTP.

➤ Avoid sharing your personal details such as address, email id, phone number, etc. if not required.

➤ Avoid clicking on a link or calling back the number from an unexpected delivery notice via a SMS or email.

Precautionary measures during Tsunami

Port Blair, May 13

The Andaman & Nicobar Islands are prone to Geological and Hydro-meteorological disasters and located in one of the most seismically active parts of the world and vulnerable to earthquake and tsunami disasters. Tsunamis are powerful and dangerous natural disasters that can cause devastating damage and loss of life. The Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration has requested the general public of A&N Islands to follow the Do's & Don'ts of Tsunami, if it occurs.

DO's:

► Pay attention to tsunami warnings: If you live in a coastal area or are visiting one, make sure to be aware of any tsunami warnings issued by the authorities.

A tsunami warning is issued, move to higher ground

immediately. Do not wait for official instructions or for the wave to arrive.

► Follow evacuation orders: If authorities issue an evacuation order, follow it immediately. Do not delay or hesitate.

► Stay tuned to local news: Stay tuned to local news and radio stations for updates on the situation.

► Be prepared: Have an emergency kit ready, including food, water, medications, and important documents.

DON'Ts:

► Don't stay in low-lying areas: If you are in a low-lying area and a tsunami warning is issued, do not stay there. Move to higher ground immediately.

► Don't go to the coast to watch the wave: Tsunamis are not a spectator sport. Stay away from the coast and do

not go there to watch the wave.

► Don't use the beach as a shelter: Do not use the beach or shoreline as a shelter during a tsunami. The wave can be much higher than the normal tide level and can quickly flood the area.

► Don't use elevators: If you are in a building during a tsunami, do not use the elevators. Use the stairs instead.

► Don't return to the area until it is safe: After a tsunami, do not return to the area until authorities declare it safe to do so.
