Hon'ble Lt. Governor flags-off three Mobile Forensic Vans to strengthen Forensic Support for Law Enforcement in A&N Islands



Sri Vijaya Puram, May 15

In a significant step towards modernizing forensic infrastructure and enhancing scientific support for law enforcement, the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor of Andaman and Nicobar Islands & Vice Chairman, Islands Development Agency, Admiral D. K. Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM (Retd.), officially flagged off three State-of-the-Art Mobile Forensic Vans today. Hon'ble Lt. Governor formally dedicated the Mobile Forensic Vans to the law enforcement agencies of the UT, affirming their critical role in ensuring efficient investigation and timely delivery of justice in line with the rule of law.

The ceremony was held in the presence of Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Islands, Shri Hargobinder Singh Dhaliwal, IPS, Director General of Police, Smt. Sindhu Pillai, IPS, IGP (L&O/Intl) and other senior officials and dignitaries from A&N Administration and Police.

In his welcome address, the Director General of Police, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, stated that these fully-equipped Mobile Forensic Vans, procured from the National Forensic Science University (NFSU), Gandhinagar have been introduced to support the effective implementation of the three newly enacted criminal laws. He emphasized that their induction marks a major milestone in strengthening forensic capabilities across the Union Territory, enabling investigations that are faster, more accurate, and grounded in scientific evidence. He also acknowledged the vital support of the Hon'ble Lieutenant Governor and Civil Administration in advancing forensic services across the Islands.

A detailed presentation was delivered by Dr. Devinder Kumar, Assistant Director, FSL, highlighting the key features and operational capabilities of the newly inducted Mobile Forensic Vans. Each van is equipped with an integrated



suite of basic and advanced forensic kits, digital tools, and field instrumentation designed for on-site collection and preservation of biological, chemical, and physical evidence. These include trace materials, bodily fluids, narcotics, fibers, fingerprints, and other critical substances. Dr. Kumar also informed about the upcoming establishment of DNA Profiling and Cyber Forensic facilities at the new FSL building, which will significantly expand the scope of forensic services in the Islands.

The Mobile Forensic Vans are aligned with the vision of the new criminal justice framework and are expected to:

- ♦ Enhance the scientific rigor of criminal investigations
- ♦ Strengthen the quality and reliability of evidence presented in Court
- ♦ Accelerate justice delivery in a transparent and fair manner

The ceremony concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Shri Jitendra Kumar Meena, IPS, Senior Superintendent of Police (CID), who expressed gratitude to the Hon'ble Lt. Governor and all dignitaries for their continued support in strengthening the forensic ecosystem in the Union Territory.

These developments mark a transformative chapter in the evolution of forensic science services in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, reaffirming the Administration's commitment to scientific, timely, and transparent delivery of justice, a press release from SSP (CID) said.

a complete automation of hold baggage processing and screening system. The advanced ILBS system also include an explosive detection system which can scan baggage 360° and create CT-Slice with 3D image to detect explosive material in baggage. The system is capable of handling up to 1500 bags per hour, making the baggage screening process faster and more efficient.

Earlier, the hold baggage screening was through the stand alone X-ray machines installed. Stand-alone machines occupy space at departure area and because of manual nature of processing, it normally causes big queues, which disrupt passenger flow during peak hours. Keeping in view the security, multi-level CT-EDS based, in-line detection system has been installed at VSI Airport. Now, passengers will not be required to scan their registered baggage before dropping at the check-in counters, resulting in faster passenger processing, minimum queuing time, and less congestion at check-in area and enhance passenger experience at Airport.

The Airport Director stated that with an objective of streamlining the security, passenger flow and unlocking the true efficiency of the Airport, this facility has been operationalized. In the first phase of operationalization from 15.05.2025 to 18.05.2025, this facility will be available only for Akasa Airline passengers. With the first flight of 19.05.2025, the ILBS facility will be available for all airlines passengers. AAI will continue its journey of continuous improvement and excellence to enhance passenger centric facilities and making air travel more convenient, a press release from Airport Director, VSI Airport said.

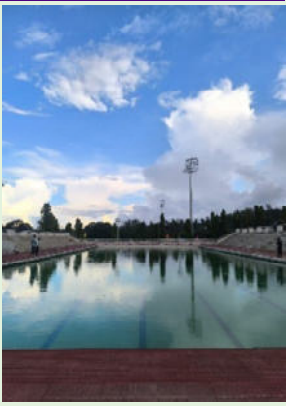
