

contribute to building a more robust and resilient Brackishwater Aquaculture activity in the Islands by availing financial assistance under PMMSY. She also acknowledged the continued effort of the Department of Fisheries towards capacity building and the promotion of sustainable fisheries development in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. The Secretary (Fisheries) also released the Training Manual prepared by ICAR-CIBA during the inaugural session.

In his address, Dr. K. Ambasankar, HoD, Nutrition, Genetics & Biotechnology Division of ICAR-CIBA, emphasized on the immense potential of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands for brackishwater aquaculture, owing to the region's natural pristine environment and availability of natural resources. He elaborated on the comprehensive nature of the training, which provided both theoretical and practical exposure.
