Labour Deptt. urges Platform and Gig Workers to register on e-Shram portal

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 21

The Ministry of Labour & Employment, Government of India, New Delhi, has proposed a second round of nationwide campaign from May 21 to 30, 2025 to organize 'Special Registration Camps' for the registration of Platform and Gig Workers. The objective of this campaign is to facilitate the registration of Gig and Platform Workers on the e-Shram portal, enabling them and their families to avail health coverage under Ayushman Bharat - Pradhan Mantri Jan Arogya Yojana (AB-PMJAY).

The term 'Platform Worker' refers to an individual engaged in a work arrangement outside of the traditional employer-employee relationship, wherein organizations or individuals use an online platform to access other organizations or individuals to solve specific problems or provide specific services, or any other activity as notified by the Central Government, in exchange for payment. Similarly, a 'Gig Worker' is a person, who performs work or participates in a work arrangement and earns from such activities, also outside of the traditional employer-employee framework.

This initiative aligns with the Union Budget 2025-26, which announced the registration of Platform and Gig Workers on the e-SHRAM portal. All Platform and Gig Workers have been urged to avail themselves of this facility.

Fishermen/Fish Traders/General Public advised to strictly comply to provisions of A&N Marine Fishing Rules, 2004 for prohibited areas of fishing

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 21

In accordance with the A&N Marine Fishing Rules, 2004, the following areas specified is prohibited for fishing in the Territorial water of Andaman and Nicobar Islands:

- ◆ Areas falling within the port limits as defined in the Indian Ports Act, 1908 (15 of 1908)
- ◆ Areas reserved for Aboriginal Tribes of the Islands under the Andaman and Nicobar Islands (Protection of Aboriginal Tribes) (Regulation) 1956 (Regulation No. 3 of 1956)
- ◆ Areas Protected or Prohibited in the Islands under the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972.

Nothing contained in the said rule shall apply to any class or classes of fishing vessels for innocent passage to carry out fishing in the permitted areas.

The fishermen/fish traders/general public of A&N Islands have been advised to strictly comply to the provisions of A&N Marine Fishing Rules, 2004 for prohibited areas of fishing. Failing to comply, necessary

Forest Fire Mock Drill conducted at Brindaban RF-I, Tushnabad

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 21

In accordance with the directive of the Chief Secretary mandating quarterly mock drills across all Departments of the A&N Administration, the Directorate of Disaster Management organized a Forest Fire Mock Drill at Brindaban RF-I, Teak P l a n t a t i o n , Tushnabad, South Andaman today. The objective of the drill was to evaluate the preparedness and response of the Forest Department in the event of a forest fire.

As part of the drill scenario, a simulated fire broke out at the Teak Plantation in Brindaban RF-I at around 11.15 am. Upon receiving the alert, the Forest Range Office, Tushnabad, i m m e d i a t e l y deployed a response team to the site. The Assistant Conservator of Forests (ACF) promptly directed the team to clear nearby plants and bushes to create a firebreak and prevent the spread of the blaze. In addition, the team employed the beating method to control and extinguish the fire. Simultaneously,



the ACF instructed officials to communicate with emergency support Departments. The A&N Police arrived to manage law and order, while fire tenders, assisted by forest personnel, worked to fully extinguish the fire. During the mock drill, three forest personnel were rendered unconscious due to smoke inhalation and were immediately shifted to medical facilities via ambulance.

The drill concluded with a debriefing session, during which Shri Janik Ram, Assistant Director, Directorate of Disaster M a n a g e m e n t , commended the Forest Department and the c o o r d i n a t i n g Departments viz. Police, Fire, and Health for their effective response and successful execution of the mock drill, a press release from Directorate of Disaster Management said.

Blind hit-and-run case cracked by PS Pahargaon

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 21

In pursuit of the Andaman & Nicobar Police unwavering commitment to public safety and reinforcement of law and order, the team of Police Station Pahargaon under the leadership of Inspector Mohd Elias, SHO, PS P a h a r g a o n , successfully cracked a blind hit-and-run case through exceptional investigative skills and swift decisive action.

On May 17, 2025, at around 2200-2230 hrs, a pedestrian was hit by a speeding motorcycle near Bird Line, in front of Karpagam Hotel and the rider fled from the spot. Based on the statement of an eyewitness, a hit-and-

run case has been registered at PS Pahargaon. The investigation of the case was entrusted to SI Manish Narayan and a dedicated team comprising of HC Ravi Kumar Limbu, PCs Shiv Kumar and Rahul Mourya were formed to trace the accused.

During the course of investigation, CCTV footages from the vicinity were thoroughly analyzed. Based on the visuals and inputs received, it was revealed that the involved motorcycle was a Yamaha R15 with a modified headlight. Further, inquiries were conducted through local garages and workshops to identify owners of R15 motorcycles with

similar modifications. The Birdline locality was extensively searched and found one suspect, who happened to be in Kamraj Nagar with same modifications on his R15 Bike.

The identified suspect namely Avinit Singh, S/o Shri Rajesh Singh, 22 years, R/o Sippighat was apprehended and interrogated. During sustained questioning, he confessed to his involvement in the incident. Following his confession, the motorcycle used in the accident along with the helmet, raincoat, and attire worn during the time of incident were recovered and seized, a press release from SP, SA said.

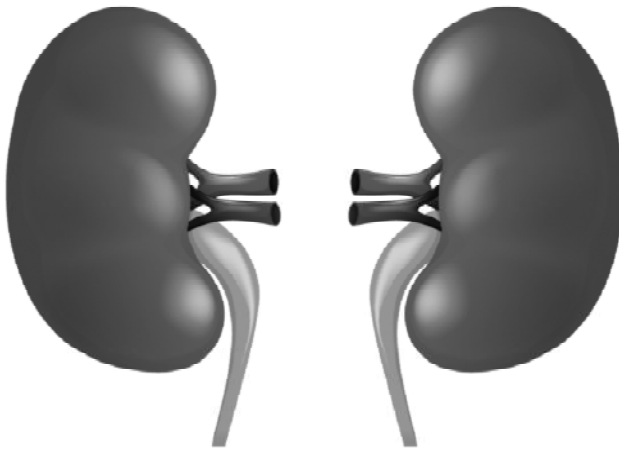

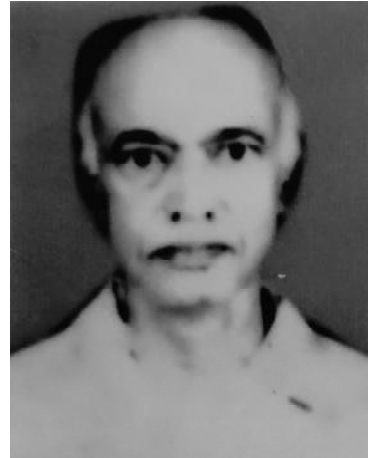
