## ECI to provide Mobile Deposit Facility for voters at Polling Stations Rationalises norms for Canvassing

New Delhi, May 23 (PIB)

In line with various initiatives aimed at enhancing voter convenience and streamlining poll day arrangements, the Election Commission has issued two more comprehensive instructions for providing mobile deposit facility for voters just outside the polling stations and rationalising norms for canvassing. The instructions are in line with the relevant provisions of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 and the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961.

Recognising the increasing coverage and usage of mobile phones in both urban and rural areas and the challenges faced not only by the voters at large but also by senior citizens, women, and PwD electors in managing mobile phones on the poll day, the Commission has decided to allow a mobile deposit facility just outside the polling stations. Only mobile phones shall be allowed within 100 meters of the polling station and that too in switched-off mode. Very simple pigeonhole boxes or jute bags shall be provided near the entrance door of the polling station where the voters would be required to deposit their mobile phones. Mobile phones shall not be allowed to be carried inside the polling station by the voter. However, certain Polling Stations can be exempted from this provision based on adverse local circumstances by the Returning Officer. Rule 49M of the Conduct of Elections Rules, 1961, which ensures secrecy of voting within the polling station, will continue to be strictly enforced. Further, in a move aimed at improving election day facilitation, the Commission has rationalised the permissible norms for canvassing in line with the electoral laws to 100 meters from the entrance of the polling station. However, electioneering shall not be allowed within a 100-meter radius around the Polling Station on the day of poll. Therefore, the candidates on poll day for issuing unofficial identity slips to electors, in case the electors are not carrying their official Voter Information Slips (VIS) issued by the Commission, can now be set up just beyond 100 meters of any polling station. ## District Administration, SA imposes fines against illegal extraction of White Moorum

Sri Vijaya Puram, May 23

District Administration, South Andaman has taken strict action against violators who indulged in illegal extraction of White Moorum in contravention of Land Revenue Regulations and mines and Mineral Rules. During a recent field inspection, the revenue officials found unauthorized extraction of White Moorum at Rabindra Nagar Village under Little Andaman Tehsil. As a result, a fine of Rs 24,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Four Lakh only) has been imposed on the violators against illegal extraction and dumping of White Moorum. The Deputy Commissioner has issued a stern warning to all such unscrupulous elements indulging in illegal mining, earth transportation and unauthorized dumping. Further the District Administration, South Andaman reiterates that such illegal activities will not be tolerated. Strict penal action will be taken against all violators. The law will take its own course and those who attempt to bypass it, will face the consequences. The general public have been advised to

## Restrictions imposed on movement of heavy vehicles over Chatham Bridge

In exercise of the powers conferred under the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (Act No. 59 of 1988), read with the Administration's Notification No./2008/F.No.32-95/2008-TR dated 10<sup>th</sup> March, 2008, the District Magistrate, South Andaman has notified for the information of all concerned that the Chatham Bridge has been found to be in a deteriorating condition. The bridge serves as the only access connecting Chatham Island to the Headquarter area, and its structural integrity is of critical importance. As a precautionary measure to ensure public safety and to prevent any further deterioration of the bridge, the following restrictions have been imposed on the movement of heavy vehicles over the Chatham Bridge with immediate effect:

successful conduct of the programme. He emphasized the long-term value of such capacity-building initiatives in fostering sustainable aquaculture and urged the participants to take full advantage of Government schemes under PMMSY, especially those aimed at Brackishwater Aquaculture development to target commercially viable species like shrimp, Mud Crab, Mulletts, Milk fish, Seabass etc. He reiterated the potential of such programmes to significantly advance brackishwater aquaculture in the region and urged for conducting advanced programmes for better understanding of the participants.

Dr. K. Ambasankar addressed the key challenge of limited land availability in private sector for brackishwater aquaculture in the Islands. He informed the gathering that the Department of Fisheries with the technical support of ICAR-CIBA is actively working on facilitating brackishwater land leases to support aquaculture expansion. Dr. A. Panigrahi, Principal Scientist, expressed gratitude to the Director of Fisheries for the opportunity to train local fishers. He emphasized the importance of initiating small-scale pilot projects as a model to inspire broader aquaculture development across the Islands.

The participating trainees expressed their appreciation for the valuable training and shared that it had motivated them to consider venturing into mud crab fattening and shrimp farming. They also requested more hands-on training opportunities to strengthen their practical skills.
