we must check for oxygen plants and preparations to be ready for any Covid related challenges. He said that the States need to expand telemedicine so that good doctors' can be connected from District Hospitals and E-Sanjeevani & teleconsultation benefits should be made available.

Prime Minister mentioned that 'Operation Sindoor should not be treated as a one-off initiative and we must adopt a long-term approach. Prime Minister mentioned that we must modernize our approach to civil preparedness. He said that the recent mock drills have reignited our attention to civil defence states should institutionalize Civil Defence preparedness.

The CMs and LGs praised Operation Sindoor for its precision and targeted strikes which led to destruction of terror infrastructure. In one voice, they praised PM's leadership and the valour of the Armed Forces. They also praised the efforts towards Aatmanirbharta in the defence sector which have strengthened the defence forces and bolstered confidence in our capabilities.

Chief Minister/Lt. Governors gave various suggestions for the vision of Viksit Rajya for Viksit Bharat @ 2047 and also discussed steps being taken in their States. a comprehensive health camp was organized. General, dental, and h o m e o p a t h i c consultations were provided, along with blood sugar testing and m e d i c i n e distribution. A Navy doctor from the Kardip team joined the effort, enhancing outreach and service quality. The health team, comprising Medical Officers, a Pharmacist, and a Lab Attendant, also visited bedridden patients at their homes, assessed disability cases, and collected CB NAAT samples for suspected TB patients.



The Assistant Commissioner, Shri Aditya Sangotra visited the camp site, interacted with the villagers, and patiently listened to their concerns. He assured the residents of appropriate follow-up and timely redressal through administrative channels.

During the visit, several key demands were raised by the community. These included the early commencement of road work to connect Upper Katchal with Katchal Jetty, the urgent repair of the school building which has started leaking during rains, and the construction of staff quarters for teachers to ensure consistent educational services. Villagers also requested an increase in the diesel quota for community power generation from the current 8 hours to 16 hours a day, to support daily living needs.

Another major demand was for the installation of a floating jetty as a temporary solution until a permanent jetty can be constructed, improving connectivity and transportation. Additionally, the Captain of Upper Katchal, Shri S. Andrew Lewis, emphasized the urgent need for the erection of a BSNL mobile tower to enable basic connectivity, especially for use during emergencies. He also appealed for the posting of a Community Health Officer (CHO) at the Health & Wellness Centre in Upper Katchal to ensure consistent and quality primary healthcare.

Captain Lewis expressed his deep gratitude to the District Administration for organizing the camp.

The camp marked a successful instance of Inter-Departmental coordination and brought Government services to the doorstep of one of the most remote settlements in the region.
