Vocational skill development training programme on Traditional Nicobari Handicrafts launched under Nancowry Block

Nancowry, May 26
In a significant step towards preserving cultural heritage and reviving traditional craftsmanship, a 10-days Vocational Skill Development Training Programme on Traditional Nicobari Handicrafts has been launched across all five Tribal Councils viz. Kamorta, Nancowry, Katchal, Teressa and Chowra Islands under the Nancowry Block in Nicobar District. The programme is a collaborative effort of the District Administration, Nicobar and the Directorate of RD, PRIs & ULBs, A&N Administration, being conducted by the Community Development Block, Nancowry as part of implementation of the Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana-National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM).

Under the guidance of Shri Amit Kale, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District, the events at Kamorta and Nancowry Islands were formally inaugurated by Shri Aditya Sangotra, Assistant Commissioner, Nancowry with the traditional lighting of lamp, joined by Shri Charles Jacob, CTC, Kamorta, Smti Aysha Majid, CTC, Nancowry, Shri Mohammed Yunus M, Block Development Officer and Lt. Sri Vijaya Puram, dated the 23rd May, 2025.

No. F.No.34-1024/2023/Rev, in exercise of the powers conferred by Section 2(f) of the Civil Defence Act 1968, thereof, the Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby pleased to invoke necessary Emergency Procurement Powers to the Director Civil Defence of our State/UT, so that efficient implementation of the necessary precautionary measures can be implemented.

Whereas, the preparation of civil administration and adoption of precautionary measures against hostile attacks are governed by the provisions of the Civil Defence Act, 1968 and the Civil Defence Rules, 1968;

And whereas, in view of the current hostile attack scenario, it is imperative to ensure preparedness and safeguard the lives and property of the citizens, as well as to maintain essential services within the Andaman and Nicobar Islands;

And whereas, under Rule 11 of the Civil Defence Rules, 1968, the State Government is empowered to take such measures as may be necessary for the protection of persons and property from injury or damage, and for ensuring the due maintenance of vital services in the event of a hostile attack;

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred under Rule 11 of the Civil Defence Rules, 1968, and in accordance with the provisions of the Civil Defence Act, 1968, the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman and Nicobar Islands hereby:

1. Invokes the provisions of Rule 11 of the Civil Defence Rules, 1968, in the interest of public safety and vital service maintenance;
2. Grants Emergency Procurement Powers to the Director, Civil Defence, Andaman and Nicobar Islands, to take all necessary steps for the effective implementation of precautionary measures, including procurement of essential items and services related to civil defence operations;

3. Delegates to the Director, Civil Defence, the authority to undertake emergency procurement of goods, services, and equipment necessary for civil defence operations within the Union Territory. This delegation is intended to ensure the prompt and effective implementation of precautionary and protective measures in the event of hostile attacks, natural disasters, or other emergencies that threaten public safety and the maintenance of vital services. The Director, Civil Defence, is authorized to:

a) Procure essential materials and services required for civil defence preparedness and response without prior approval, subject to compliance with existing financial regulations and accountability standards.

b) Issue directives to relevant departments and agencies to facilitate the procurement process and ensure timely delivery of necessary resources.

c) Utilize funds allocated for civil defence purposes to meet the expenses incurred under this delegation.

4. Directs that priority shall be accorded to such measures over all other duties and obligations of local authorities;

5. Specifies that funds of the concerned local authorities shall be applicable to the payment of all charges and expenses incidental to compliance under these provisions.

This order shall come into force with immediate effect and remain valid until further orders.


