WIPO Treaty, a big win for India and Global South

New Delhi, May 26 (PIB)

The World Intellectual Property Organization (WIPO) treaty on intellectual property, Genetic resources and associated traditional knowledge, is a significant win for countries of the global South and for India, which is a mega biodiversity hotspot with abundance of traditional knowledge, and wisdom.

For the first time, the system of knowledge and wisdom which have supported economies, societies and cultures for centuries are now inscribed into the global IP system. For the first time, the connection between local communities and their GRs and ATK is recognised in the global IP community. These are historic achievements long championed by India as a provider of traditional knowledge and wisdom and repository of biodiversity.

The treaty will not only safeguard and protect biodiversity but will increase transparency in the

patent system and strengthen innovation. Through this, the IP system can continue to incentivize innovation while evolving in a more inclusive way, responding to the needs of all countries and their communities.

The treaty also marks a big win for India and the global south which has for long been a proponent of this instrument. After two decades of negotiations and with collective support, this treaty has been adopted at the multilateral fora, with a consensus among more than 150 countries.

With the majority of the developed countries on board, who generate IP and use these resources and knowledge for research and innovation, this treaty paves the way for bridging conflicting paradigms within the IP system and the protection of biodiversity which have existed for decades.

The treaty on ratification and entry into force will require contracting parties to put in place, mandatory disclosure obligations for patent applicants to disclose the country of origin or source of the genetic resources when the claimed invention is based on genetic resources or associated traditional knowledge. This will offer added protection to Indian GRs and TK, which while currently protected in India are prone to misappropriation in countries, which do not have disclosure obligations.

Govt. issues directions for blocking of incoming international spoofed calls displaying Indian mobile numbers

New Delhi, May 26 (PIB)

It has been reported that fraudsters are making international spoofed calls displaying Indian mobile numbers to Indian citizens and committing cyber-crime and financial frauds. These calls appear to be originating within India but being made by the cyber-criminals from abroad by manipulating the calling line identity (CLI). Such international spoofed calls have been misused in recent cases of fake digital arrests, FedEx scams, drugs/narcotics in courier, impersonation as Govt. and Police officials, disconnections of mobile numbers by DoT/TRAI officials, etc.

Therefore, Department of Telecommunications (DoT) and Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) have devised a system to identify and block such incoming international spoofed calls from reaching any Indian telecom subscriber. Now directions have been issued to the TSPs for blocking of such incoming international spoofed calls.

The incoming international spoofed calls with Indian landline numbers are being already blocked by the TSPs as per the directions issued by DoT.

As safety and security of the users is an integral part of vision of Digital India, DoT has already taken many initiatives including citizen centric Sanchar Saathi portal (<https://sancharsaathi.gov.in/>) to protect telecom users.

Despite best efforts, there may still be some fraudsters who succeed through other means. For such calls, you can help everybody by reporting such suspected fraud communications at Chakshu facility on Sanchar Saathi.

ECI prohibits conducting & publishing of Exit Poll till 6.30 pm on 1st June, 2024

All concerned have been informed that the Election Commission of India has notified the period between 7 am on 19th April, 2024 (Friday) and 6.30 pm on 1st June, 2024 (Saturday) as the period during which conducting and publishing or publicising exit poll by means of the print or electronic media in manner whatsoever, the result of any exit poll in connection with the General Elections-2024, shall be prohibited.

Furthermore, displaying any election matter including results of any opinion poll or any other poll survey, in any electronic media, would be prohibited during the period of 48 hours ending with the hours fixed for the conclusion of the poll. Moreover, adequate provisions are available under the Representation of People Act, 1951 for any contravention.

All the electorates under the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Parliamentary Constituency have been appealed to be informed citizens and to be cautioned for any kind of act in contravention of the provisions envisaged under the statute, a press release from RO, ANIPC said.

Self-medication poses significant danger to health

DHS issues advisory on 'risks & harms' & appeals to citizens to refrain from taking antibiotics without prescription

Port Blair, May 26

The Directorate of Health Services has issued an advisory regarding the critical issue of self-medication and its associated risks. Self-medication, the practice of obtaining and using medications without guidance of a physician and a valid prescription, poses significant dangers to individuals and communities alike. Therefore, it is need-of-the-hour to launch a massive public awareness campaign to educate general population about risks and harms of self-medication.

Self-medication may seem convenient, especially for minor ailments or symptoms perceived as common. However, it can lead to serious health consequences, including:

- > **Misdiagnosis:** Without proper medical assessment, individuals may misdiagnose their condition and administer inappropriate treatment, leading to delays in proper diagnosis and treatment.
- > **Adverse Drug Reactions:** Improper use of medicines without knowledge of action, indication and dose may lead to serious adverse drug reactions which may at times be life threatening.
- > **Drug Interactions:** Mixing medications without professional guidance can result in harmful drug interactions, with a potential for adverse effects as well as reducing effectiveness of treatment.
- > **Masking of Disease Symptoms:** Self-medication may alleviate symptoms temporarily, masking underlying disease that may worsen and require medical attention. This can lead to progress of undiagnosed and untreated conditions.
- > **Development of Antibiotic Resistance:** Inappropriate use of antibiotics, a common practice in self-medication not only contributes to antibiotic resistance, rendering these crucial medications ineffective against bacterial infections, but also makes a patient prone to infection with resistant organisms.
- > **Addiction and Dependency:** Many especially opioids and sedatives, carry a risk of addiction and dependency when used without medical supervision. Self-medication with these substances can lead to substance abuse disorders and other health complications.

The Ministry of Social Justice and Empowerment, Gol is implementing the Central Sector Scheme of 'Free coaching for SC and OBC students'. The objective of the scheme is to provide coaching of good quality for economically disadvantaged Scheduled Castes (SCs) and Other Backward Classes (OBCs) candidates to enable them appear in competitive examinations for appropriate jobs in Public/Private Sector and/or for securing admissions in reputed technical and professional higher education institutions.

Eligibility criteria for students:

- > Only students belonging to SCs and OBCs, having total family income of Rs.8.00 lakh or less per annum from all sources will be eligible for benefits under the Scheme.
- > SC/OBC candidates belonging to a Minority community may apply under the similar scheme(s) of Ministry of Minority Affairs, or the State Govts., as the case may be.
- > The student should have a valid Aadhaar number and a bank account seeded therewith, allotted to him/her.

At the time of application, if the students does not have Aadhaar number, he/she can submit his/her EID number. However, the payment shall be released only after obtaining the Aadhaar Number and shall be disbursed to the Aadhaar seeded bank account of the student only.

India's historic show at Cannes- Payal Kapadia wins Grand Prix Award for her film 'All We Imagine as Light'

"Sunflowers were the first ones to know" - course end film by FTII student Chidanand S Naik (Director) bags 'La Cinef' Award

New Delhi, May 26 (PIB)

India's performance at 77th Cannes Film Festival has been phenomenal with 2 filmmakers, an actress and a cinematographer won top awards at the world's leading film festival. As one of the largest film producing Nation with a thriving Film industry, Indian Film makers have fetched huge accolades at this year's Cannes.

For the first time in 30 years, an Indian film, Payal Kapadia's 'All We Imagine as Light' which centers around the lives of two nurses, was nominated for the Palme d'or, the highest award in the festival. Kapadia's film won the Grand Prix, the second position in the category. With this win Payal Kapadia, a FTII alumnus, becomes the first Indian to bag this prestigious award. This comes after 30 years when Shaji N Karun's 'Swaham' competed for highest honour.

Payal's film was granted official Indo-French co production status by the Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, under the signed Audio-Visual treaty between India and France. Permission for shooting of the film was also granted by the Ministry in



Maharashtra (Ratnagiri and Mumbai). The film received Interim approval for 30% of the Qualifying Co-production expenditure under the Incentives Scheme of the Government of India for Official Co-production.

Film and Television Institute of India's student Chidananda S Naik bagged the first prize in the La Cinef section for "Sunflowers were the first ones to know", a 15-minute short film based on a Kannada folklore. This FTII film is a production of the FTII's TV Wing's One-year program where four students from different disciplines i.e. Direction, Electronic Cinematography, Editing, Sound worked together for one project as a year-end coordinated exercise.

The Festival celebrated the work of world famous Director Shyam Benegal. After 48 years of its release in India Benegals' Manthan, preserved at the National Film

Archives of India (NFDC-NFAI under Ministry of Information and Broadcasting) and restored by the Film Heritage Foundation, was showcased at Cannes in the classic section.

The much renowned Cinematographer Santosh Sivan, known for his rich body of work in Indian cinema became the first Asian to be awarded the prestigious Pierre Angénieux Tribute award at the 2024 Cannes film festival in recognition of his "career and exceptional quality of work". Another individual who made history at Cannes is Anasuya Sengupta as she became the first ever Indian to win the Best Actress award for her performance in 'The Shameless' in the 'Un Certain Regard' category.

Another independent film maker who shines at Cannes was Maisam Ali, also a FTII alumnus. His film 'In Retreat' was screened at the ACID Cannes sidebar programme. It

was the first time an Indian film was screened in the section run by the Association for the Diffusion of Independent Cinema, since its inception in 1993.

As we witnessed a historic year for Indian Cinema at 77th Cannes Film Festival, Film and Television Institute of India has a special reason for celebrating its accomplishments as its Alumni such as Payal Kapadia, Santosh Sivan, Maisam Ali and Chidanand S Naik shines at Cannes. disclosure of origin obligations, this treaty creates an unprecedented framework within the IP system for provider countries of Genetic resources and associated traditional knowledge.

At present, only 35 countries have some form of disclosure obligations, most of which are not mandatory and do not have appropriate sanctions or remedies in place for effective implementation. This treaty will require contracting parties, including the developed world, to bring changes in their existing legal framework for enforcing disclosure of origin obligations on patent applicants.

The treaty marks the start of the journey to achieve collective growth and deliver the promise of a sustainable future, a cause which India has championed for centuries.

➤ Income Certificate: Income declaration of self employed parents/guardian should be in the form of a certificate issued by a Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar. Employed parents/guardians are required to obtain Income Certificate from their employer and submit consolidated certificate from Revenue Officer including any other additional source of income.

➤ For the competitive exams for which the qualifying exam is class XII, benefits under the scheme will be available to a candidate only if the candidate has passed class XII or is studying in class XII as on the date of receiving the benefit under the scheme. Student will be required to declare the marks obtained by him/her in class X in the application form. Students having less than 50% marks in their class X exam, shall not be considered under the scheme.

➤ Further, in case of competitive exams for which the qualifying exam is Under Graduate level only/students/candidates having completed the Under Graduate level course or studying in the final year of the Under Graduate course, student will be required to declare the marks obtained by him/her in class XII in the application form. Students having less than 50% marks in their class XII exam, shall not be considered under the scheme.

➤ Benefit under the Scheme can be availed by a particular student not more than twice, irrespective of the number of chances he/she may be entitled to take in a particular competitive examination and irrespective of the number of stages in the exam. The students will be required to provide a declaration that he/she has not taken benefit more than twice under the Scheme or any other similar coaching scheme run by the Central or State Government.

➤ The candidate shall be precluded from availing benefit under any other coaching scheme of the Centre or State Government and will be required to provide a declaration to this effect. A list of beneficiaries availing the scheme will also be uploaded on the website of the Ministry and shall be shared with Central Universities/Central Institutes to avoid possibility of the candidate availing benefits of similar coaching scheme simultaneously or more than twice.

For further details, students need to apply directly in the portal i.e., coaching.dosje.gov.in as per their choice of coaching institute and the last date for receipt of application is 31.05.2024, a press release from Director (Social Welfare) said.

category shall carry a Medal, a Certificate and Cash Prize of Rs. 1,00,000/-.

These awards aim to give due recognition to young hearts who have done selfless acts of exceptional abilities and outstanding achievements. Child Bravery Award is given to a child to acknowledge her /his selfless service in the face of risk to her/his own life; and /or an act of outstanding courage and daring, against an act of mental strength, quick wit and presence of mind in the face of grave danger to self and society.

The Child Excellence Award is given to children with exceptional abilities and outstanding achievements in Sports, Social Service, Science & Technology, Environment, Arts & Culture and Innovation, which deserve due recognition at the national level. These awards are conferred by the Hon'ble President of India in a special ceremony at New Delhi.

Any child, who is an Indian citizen and residing in India, and not exceeding 18 years (as on the last date of receipt of application/nomination) may apply for the award. The act/incident/achievement should have been within 2 years of the last date of receipt of application/nomination for the year of consideration in the website i.e. https://awards.gov.in. The applications for the PMRBP 2024 will be received only on the online portal https://awards.gov.in upto 31.07.2024, designed for this purpose. There are two options on the portal i.e. either the applicant child himself/herself can fill the form or anyone else parents/officials/teachers etc can nominate the child.

The applicant should not be a previous recipient of the same award earlier in any category (including National Child Award for exceptional Achievement as were awarded by the Ministry earlier).

If any applicant has applied in more than one category, it will be at the discretion of the National Selection Committee to accept only one application, a press release from Directorate of Social Welfare said.
