## RO, ANIPC holds meeting with Candidates/Representatives of Political Parties

### Apprised them on Counting Procedures to be followed on June 4 as per the laid down guidelines of ECI

Port Blair, May 27

A meeting was held under the Chairmanship of the Returning Officer, ANIPC, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, in the conference hall of the District Office South Andaman to apprise the Candidates/representatives of the Political Parties about the Counting Procedures, as per the laid down guidelines of the ECI, to be followed by the Office of the Returning Officer on the day of Counting of votes on June 4.

Initiating the meeting, the RO, at the outset, welcomed the Candidates and representatives of the Political Parties and enlightened them about the step by step Counting Procedures to be carried out at the JNRM Counting Centre, earmarked for Counting of Votes for the A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency on June 4, 2024. The RO further said that the Strong Room will be opened in the



presence of General Observer, Returning Officer and the Candidates and urged them to be present without fail.

Entry of Counting Agents shall be regulated strictly by colour coded entry passes to be issued by the Office of the Returning Officer, ANIPC for both counting halls.

He said that the 'Postal Ballot Papers' and Electronically

Transmitted Postal Ballot System (ETBPS) will be counted first and thereafter the counting of EVMs will be taken up at 8.30 am at JNRM on June 4, 2024 in two counting halls. Altogether, 28 counting tables will be set up and each counting hall will have 14 tables. These tables will be manned by Counting Supervisor, Micro Observer, Counting Assistant and Counting Staff and

Counting will be completed in approx 15 rounds. He said, as per the instructions of the ECI, a separate designated Counting booth for VVPAT machines have been established inside the main Counting Hall wherein 5 VVPATs will be randomly selected through draw of lots for Counting.

He further informed that no mobile phones/calculators will be allowed inside the Counting Hall. The RO informed that adequate measures will be put in place for the dissemination of results on completion of every round of Counting. He said, apart from social media platforms, the results will be announced through public address system at designated places and it will also be screened on LED monitors to be installed at Netaji Stadium.

Road diversions have also been proposed on the day of counting. Barricades shall be put in place at

Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-

litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138, Money recovery cases, Labour dispute cases, Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non compoundable), Maintenance cases, Civil disputes and disputes under the Consumer Protection Act.

The general public having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before 07.06.2024, so

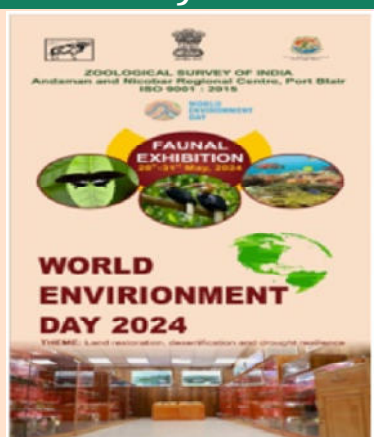

It is to inform to all general public that, the deck slab of the bridge at Km 88.300 (B.D. Nallah) within the Jarwa Reserve Areas has got damaged on Left Hand Side (from JPP Jirkatang).Consequently, the left carriageway has been barricaded and the traffic has been diverted to the Right Hand Side (Half Carriageway) of the Bridge.Now, some cracks have also been noticed on the Right Hand Side deck slab of the bridge (from JPP Jirkatang).

In order to ensure the safety of the road user and to prevent any potential incident, following precautions need to be taken with respect to all the vehicles crossing the bridge:

1. Vehicle weight is restricted to 20MT per vehicle.
- a) All heavy vehicles carrying construction materials/goods shall restrict to carry only 7-8 cbm load (excluding 10 MT weight of unloaded truck).
- b) All oil tankers/LPG Cylinder carrying vehicles shall restrict to carry only 7-8 cbm load (excluding 10 MT weight of unloaded truck).
2. Vehicle speed is limited to 10Km/hrs.

Only one vehicle is allowed to cross the Bridge at a time.

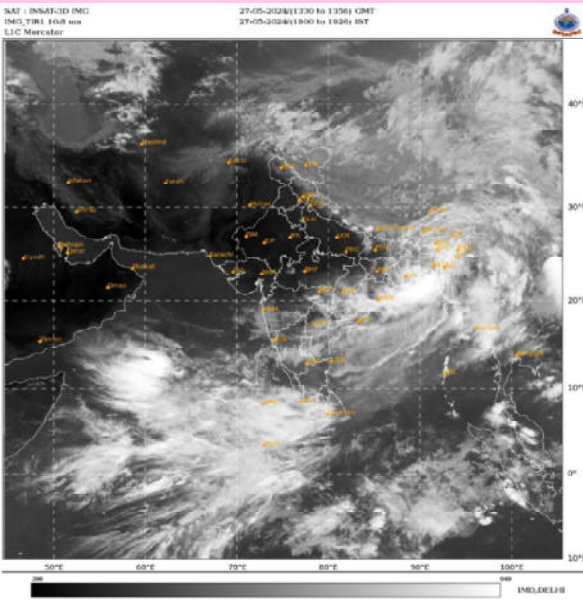


Heavy rain to lash Isles on May 30 & 31

## IMD updates Long Range Forecast Outlook for Southwest Monsoon Rainfall Season (June-Sept.) 2024

### Above normal rainfall of 106 % LPA likely during the Monsoon (June to September) season 2024

New Delhi, May 27 (PIB)

The Indian Meteorological Department (IMD) today updated its Long-Range Forecast Outlook for the Southwest Monsoon Rainfall Season (June-September) 2024. It also released the Monthly Rainfall and Temperature Forecast for June 2024 in a virtual media interaction today in New Delhi. Dr. Mritunjya Mohapatra, Director General of Meteorology, presented the forecast.

Highlights of the Long Range forecast

Quantitatively, the southwest monsoon seasonal rainfall over the country as a whole is likely to be 106% of the long period average (LPA) with a model error of  $\pm 4\%$ . Thus, Above Normal rainfall is most likely over the country as a whole during the monsoon season (June to September), 2024.

The southwest monsoon seasonal (June to September, 2024) rainfall is most likely to be above normal over Central India and South Peninsular India (>106% of LPA), normal over Northwest India (92-108% of LPA) and below normal over Northeast India (<94% of LPA).

The southwest monsoon seasonal rainfall over the Monsoon Core Zone (MCZ) consisting of most of the

rainfed agriculture areas in the country is most likely to be Above Normal (>106% of LPA).

Above Normal rainfall is most likely over most parts of the country except many areas of northern part of Northwest India, Northeast India and eastern part of the Central India and adjoining areas of east India, where below normal to normal rainfall is most likely.

Normal rainfall (92-108% of LPA) is most likely over the country as a whole during June, 2024. The above normal monthly rainfall is most likely over most areas of the south peninsula, and adjoining areas of central India and over isolated areas of Northwest and Northeast India. Below normal rainfall is most likely over many areas of northern and eastern parts of Northwest India and eastern part of Central India, and over some areas over Northeast India and southeastern part of South Peninsula.

In June, above-normal monthly maximum temperatures are likely over most parts of the country, except many parts of the southern peninsular India, where normal to below-normal temperatures are most likely. Above-normal monthly minimum temperatures are likely

across most parts of the country, except extreme northern parts of northwest India and a few pockets of east and northeast India, where normal to below-normal minimum temperatures are most likely.

During June, above-normal heatwave days are likely over most areas of Northwest India and adjoining areas of Central India.

The strong El Niño conditions observed over equatorial Pacific in the beginning of this year have weakened rapidly into weak El Niño conditions and currently transitioning towards ENSO neutral conditions. The latest Climate model forecasts indicate ENSO-neutral conditions are likely to get established during the beginning of the monsoon season and La Niña conditions are likely to develop during the later part of the monsoon season.

At present, neutral Indian Ocean Dipole (IOD) conditions are prevailing over the Indian Ocean. The latest forecasts from many global climate models indicate positive IOD conditions are likely to develop during the monsoon season.

IMD will issue the forecast for the July rainfall in the last week of June

## DoT and MHA strike down on SMS scammers

New Delhi, May 27 (PIB)

The Department of Telecommunications (DoT), in collaboration with the Ministry of Home Affairs (MHA), has taken decisive action to protect citizens from potential SMS fraud through the Sanchar Saathi initiative.

Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C), MHA, provided information about misuse of eight SMS Headers for sending fraudulent communications for committing cyber-crime.

Action taken by DoT:

> It was noted that more than 10,000 fraudulent messages were sent using these eight headers in the past three months.

> These SMS Headers pertained to 8 different Principal Entities (PEs). Analysis was done for other SMS headers/templates owned by these PEs.

> All the 8 PEs along with the 73 SMS Headers and 1522 SMS content templates owned by them have been blacklisted.

> None of these Principal Entities, SMS Headers or templates can now be used to send SMS any telecom operator.

The DoT has prevented further potential victimization of citizens by



blacklisting these entities. DoT reiterates its commitment to safeguarding citizens against cybercrime.

Citizens can report suspected fraud communications at Chakshu facility on Sanchar Saathi to help DoT in prevention of misuse of telecom resources for cyber-crime and financial frauds.

About Telemarketing SMSs/ Calls

● Prohibition of Mobile Numbers for Telemarketing: It is not permitted to use mobile numbers for telemarketing activities. If a consumer uses

their telephone connection to send promotional messages, their connection will be liable for disconnection on the first complaint, and their name and address may be blacklisted for a period of two years.

● Identifying Telemarketing Calls: Telemarketing calls can be identified by their prefixes: 180, 140, and 10-digit numbers are not permitted for telemarketing.

● Reporting Spam: To report spam, dial 1909 or use the DND (Do Not Disturb) service.
