renewals by visiting the website <https://labour.and.nic.in/labour/>. The employers may submit their applications by visiting the nearest Common Service Centre (CSC) or through their own resources. The employers can also view the status of their applications on this website. Upon approval, the employers can conveniently make online fee payments and download the certificate without a physical visit to the office. Instructions for making online fee payments are also available on the mentioned website, a press release from Labour Department said.

RudraM-II air-to-surface missile successfully flight-tested by DRDO from Su-30 MK-I off Odisha coast

New Delhi, May 29 (PIB)

Defence Research & Development Organisation (DRDO) successfully flight-tested the RudraM-II air-to-surface missile from Su-30 MK-I platform of the Indian Air Force (IAF) off the coast of Odisha at around 1130 hours today. The flight-test met all the trial objectives, validating the propulsion system and control & guidance algorithm. The performance of the missile has been



validated from the flight data captured by range tracking instruments like electro-optical systems, radar and telemetry stations deployed by Integrated Test Range, Chandipur at various locations, including the on-board ship. RudraM-II is an indigenously developed solid-propelled air-launched missile system meant for Air-to-Surface role to neutralise many types of enemy assets. A number of state-of-the-art indigenous technologies developed by various DRDO laboratories have been incorporated in the missile system.

The fourth & final round of training for Counting Supervisors, Micro Observers, Counting Assistants and Counting Staff engaged to assist the Returning Officer, A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency in counting of votes for General Election-2024, was held in the DBRAIT auditorium here today. The Counting will take place in JNRM Counting Centre, earmarked for Counting of Votes for the A & N Islands Parliamentary Constituency on June 4, 2024. The Returning Officer, ANIPC, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, visited DBRAIT auditorium and interacted with the Counting Personnel.

Addressing the officials/staff engaged in Counting, the RO urged them to execute their roles & responsibility sincerely and diligently for the smooth counting of votes on June 4. He said, today marks the final round of training and by this time, all the counting personnel are well equipped with



knowledge of step by step counting process as per the laid down guidelines of the ECI. The RO urged the Counting Personnel to execute the task assigned to each one in a professional manner. Pointing that the entire crux of the Election of ANIPC depends on transparent Counting of Votes, the RO urged the Counting Personnel to execute their work showing utmost professionalism, cordial manner and maintaining decorum inside the

Counting Hall for the smooth completion of the entire Counting process. Highlighting the importance of hands on training, the RO said that, if any Counting personnel still need hands on training it can be arranged for them. The RO further said that 'Postal Ballot Papers' will be counted first at 8 am and thereafter, the counting of EVMs will be taken up at 8.30 am at JNRM on June 4, 2024 in day. The trainees also two counting halls. Altogether, 28 counting tables will be set up and

each counting hall will have 14 tables. He said, all the persons engaged in counting must reach the Counting Centre, JNRM before 5 am on June 4, 2024 as Counting Teams & Tables will be allotted after randomization at 5 am. He further said, bus facility will be provided for the convenience of those Counting Personnel who are in need of conveyance facility so that they can reach the Counting Centre, JNRM in time.

The Resource Person, Shri Som Naidu, DANICS Retd. also addressed the trainees on the occasion. The team of Master Trainers led by Shri M. Papa Rao, assisted by Dr. A. Abraham imparted training to the counting personnel on counting of 'Postal Ballot Papers', on handling the polled EVMs, especially Control Unit and VVPAT machines on the counting day. The trainees also engaged themselves on training for the Counting.

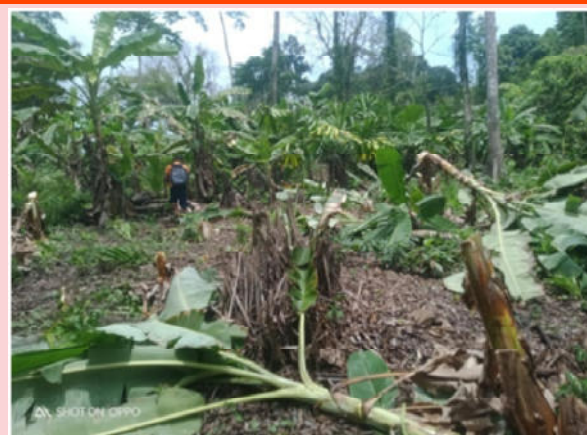

Deptt. of AH&VS issues advisory for dairy farmers on preparatory actions to be taken during monsoon season

Port Blair, May 29

To minimize the impact of monsoon and to prevent serious ailment or death, the Department of AH&VS has issued the following advisory for dairy farmers on preparatory actions to be taken during monsoon season:

Do's

- Keep update on local weather forecast.
- Adequate availability of feed and fodder and establishment of fodder banks and must be stored in moisture-proof stores.
- Ensure mixing of salt mixture / electrolytes with feed and water and provide balance feed especially to dairy animals.
- The drinking troughs should be kept clean and animals should be provided clean and fresh water.
- Pregnant animal (more than 6 months) should be given additional feed.
- Materials like corrugated iron or timber, aluminium or galvanized steel should be used for animal's shelters and roofs.
- The dead animal burial areas should be away from water bodies, public area and must be well protected with display board.
- Use of social media X handle of Deptt. of AH&VS i.e @dirahvsandaman for regular update of news related to Animal Husbandry.
- Need to ensure proper preservations of green fodder through hay and silages techniques to feed during scarcity in monsoon.
- Maggot wound cases increase with breeding of fly in rainy seasons so the use of camphor or turpentine oil along with manual removal of maggot with regular dressing is necessary.
- External and internal parasite cases increase in rainy season so take care of it in consultation with local Senior Veterinary Officer.
- As green fodder are not available always during monsoon, so farmers should go for unconventional fodder like trees leaf and grasses to feed livestock.

Dont's

- Avoid large number / overcrowding of animals in animal shade.
- Animal movement should be avoided during rains.
- Animals should not have to walk too far for the water and feed.
- The carcasses of dead animals should not be discarded on the regular grazing routes of the animals and water bodies.
- Entry of animal in water bodies should be avoided.
- Animals should not be tied to electric poles and should be kept away from electrical instruments and area.

Indian mountaineer Satyadeep Gupta has scripted history by becoming the first person to scale Mt. Everest and Mt. Lhotse twice in one season. He also set another record by being the first Indian to traverse from Mt. Everest to Mt. Lhotse in 11 hours and

15 minutes. According to the organizers, Gupta conquered the 8,516 metre-high Mt. Lhotse on Monday at noon, followed by a triumphant ascent of the towering 8,849 metre high Mt. Everest at 12:45 am, midnight.

This historic achievement marks the first Double

Ascent of the world's highest and the fourth highest peaks in a single season. He was accompanied by climbing guides Pastemba Sherpa and Nima Ungdi Sherpa. Gupta had previously summited Mt Everest on May 21 and Mt Lhotse on May 22.
