Taxpayers advised to link PAN with Aadhaar by May 31 to avoid TDS deduction

New Delhi, May 30

The Income Tax Department has once again alerted the taxpayers. Taxpayers have been advised to link Permanent Account Number (PAN) with Aadhaar by May 31 to avoid TDS deduction. The Department has given detailed information on how to complete this process.

The Income Tax Department said in a statement on Thursday that only one day is left to avoid tax deduction rate. In such a situation, taxpayers should link their Permanent Account Number (PAN) with



Aadhaar before 31st May. According to the Income Tax Act, if PAN is not linked with biometric Aadhaar, then TDS is required to be deducted at double the applicable rate. However, the Income Tax Department had issued a circular last month, which said that if PAN is linked with Aadhaar by the due date of

31st May, then no action will be taken. Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) is a tax deducted from a person's salary. In simple words, you can say that TDS is a process in which tax is taken from a person at the source of his salary or other income. The purpose of TDS is to collect income tax and prevent tax evasion.

National Lok Adalat to be held at Port Blair, Mayabunder & Diglipur on June 15

Port Blair, May 30

The District Legal Services Authority, Andaman & Nicobar Islands will be holding National Lok Adalat in the District Court Complex at Port Blair and Sub-Divisional Court Complex at Mayabunder and Circuit Court at Diglipur on June 15. Besides the compoundable nature of cases pending in different Courts, disputes at the pre-litigation stage will

also be entertained by the National Lok Adalat for disposal upon consensual settlement between the parties. Pre-litigation disputes include NI Act cases u/s 138, Money recovery cases, Labour dispute cases, Electricity and water bills cases (excluding non compoundable), Maintenance cases Civil disputes and disputes under the Consumer Protection Act. The general public

having any such dispute at the pre-litigation stage or post-litigation stage are at liberty to submit their disputes in writing to the Secretary, District Legal Services Authority, Port Blair before 07.06.2024, so that their disputes may be processed and made ready for hearing before the National Lok Adalat on June 15, a press release from Chairman (i/c), DLSA said.

The Government of India's initiative to integrate emergency Helplines into a single Helpline has resulted in the rolling out of 112 number. ERSS is a unified, Andaman-wide response system, accessible through the single number 112, providing immediate assistance from agencies such as Police (100), Fire (101), Health (102) and Disaster Management.

Any citizen in distress can dial 112 from their phones; press the power button thrice on any smart phone, or long-press the "5" or "9" key on a

call to the dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room. Additionally, SOS alerts can be sent via email or by using the 112 India mobile app, available for free on Google Play Store and Apple Store.

This system includes a dedicated DIAL 112 Control Room staffed with trained call-takers and dispatchers to handle emergency requests for assistance from Police, Fire, Health, and other agencies. All call logs are maintained digitally. This Control Room is linked to Emergency Response Vehicles and Control Rooms of various Departments to provide assistance to victims, a press release from SP (SA) said.

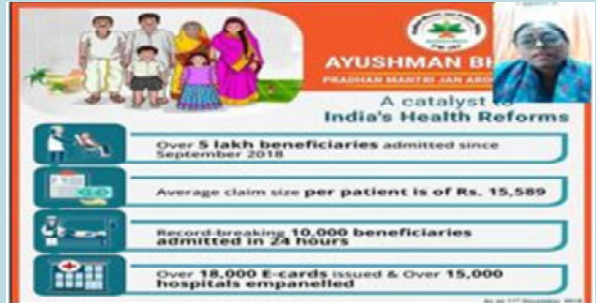

During the session, Ms. P. Lily, Call Operator explained about child abuse and POC SO Act, 2012, physical emotional impacts on victims and society support services for victim and families. She also touched upon legal obligations to report suspected abuse, resources and helpline for reporting and support. The

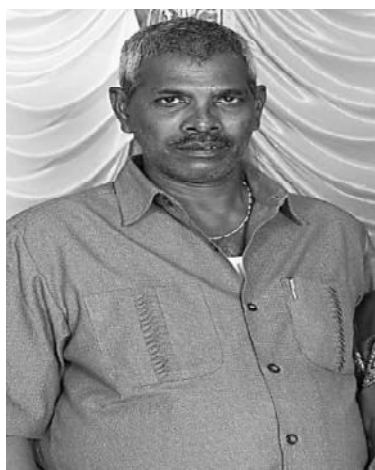
