Kamarajar Port to Submit DPR for Rs 1 Trillion Great Nicobar Project

Kamarajar Port (KPL) is set to submit the Detailed Project Report (DPR) for the Rs 1 trillion International Container Transshipment Port (ICTP) proposed at Galathea Bay in Great Nicobar Island. The DPR will soon be presented to the Union Shipping Ministry for approval, said JP Irene Cynthia, Managing Director, KPL, during India Maritime Week 2025 in Mumbai.

Once approved, tenders will be issued within six to eight months to attract private players under a public-private partnership model. In the first two phases, Rs 400 billion will be invested to create a capacity of 11 million twenty-foot equivalent units (TEUs) over three to four years. The project's total capacity is planned at



16.2 million TEUs. The strategic port will leverage its proximity-just 40 nautical miles-from key international shipping routes, reducing India's dependence on transshipment hubs like Colombo and Singapore. Environmental clearance for the project was granted in November 2022, and KPL has been appointed as the nodal agency for implementation. The Great Nicobar ICTP is expected to position India as a competitive global maritime hub. (Source:www.constructionworld.in)

Inter-State Mock Disaster Management Exercise on Earthquake & Tsunami conducted in A&N Islands

An Inter-State Mock Disaster Management Exercise (ISME-2025) Earthquake & Tsunami was conducted today by the Directorate of Disaster Management, A&N Administration, in coordination with the National Disaster Management Authority (NDMA), New Delhi, Indian National Centre for Ocean Information Services (INCOIS), Hyderabad, Andaman & Nicobar Command (ANC), National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), District Administrations and other Emergency Support Functionaries (ESFs) of the A&N Islands. The exercise simulated an earthquake followed by a tsunami scenario.

The objective of the exercise was to test the Incident Response System (IRS) and assess the level of preparedness of all



stakeholders in the A&N Islands. ISME-2025 commenced with the detection of an earthquake by INCOIS at 8:45 AM, followed by the issuance of a tsunami alert to local authorities at 8:46 AM from INCOIS, Hyderabad, to the State Emergency Operation Centre (SEOC) at Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan, Sri Vijaya Puram.

During the exercise, tsunami sirens were activated across the entire UT of A&N Islands. Alerts and warnings were issued, and Incident Response Teams (IRTs) carried out operations at identified incident sites. Search and Rescue (SAR) teams were deployed by the District Administrations, with assistance from the A&N Command and NDRF for rescue and evacuation operations. Various Departments, including Police, APWD, Shipping, Controller of Ports, SVPNC, Education, and

Special Intensive Revision of Electoral Rolls begins in A&N Islands: CEO, A&N Islands

House-to-House Enumeration Phase to continue till December 4; Draft Roll to be published on December 9

The Election Commission of India has announced the schedule for the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of the Electoral Rolls for the Union Territory of



December 4, 2025. This was stated by the Chief Electoral Officer (CEO), A&N Islands, Shri L Kumar, IAS, while addressing a press conference in the Conference Hall of Secretariat today. The Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman, Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, was also present on the occasion.

The CEO informed that as per the schedule, the Draft Electoral Roll will

others, were engaged in different tasks.

With the help of the A&N Command, aerial surveys and airdropping operations were conducted over low-lying and inundated areas in North & Middle Andaman and Nicobar districts. All key activities such as evacuation, search and rescue, medical support, setting up of relief shelters, use of equipment and materials, provision of relief, transport arrangements (air/ship/road), and deployment of personnel, volunteers, and NGOs were successfully executed to manage the simulated earthquake and tsunami scenario.

A dedicated Command and Control Centre was established at the Conference Room of Aapda Prabandhan Bhawan, Sri Vijaya Puram. All communications were coordinated through the State Emergency Operation Centre as well as District EOCs. Ms. Purva Garg, IAS, Secretary (Disaster Management), A&N Administration, along with Shri Rakesh Das, Director (Disaster Management), and Comdt. (Retd.) Aditya Kumar, Senior Consultant, NDMA, New Delhi, monitored the Inter-State Level Mock Exercise from the Situation Room of the Directorate of Disaster Management.

Officials from the Situation Room also interacted virtually through video conferencing with officials of districts and ESFs across different islands to assess their alertness, response, and preparedness in handling disaster situations. Hotlines, satellite phones, and VHF sets were utilized as alternate channels of communication with districts and other EOC in-charges. Requirements for manpower and materials were received from simulation sites, and immediate orders were issued to line Departments for necessary deployment. Requests for additional equipment and emergency support were also sent to the A&N Command and NDRF.

In South Andaman, the mock drill was conducted in the Tehsils of Sri Vijaya Puram, Swaraj Dweep, and Little Andaman, covering identified locations such as Flag Point, JNRM, Girls School, Bambooflat Jetty to Old Surya Chakra Power House, Junglight Jetty, Swaraj Dweep, and Little Andaman. In similar manner, Mock Exercise was also conducted in various locations of N&M Andaman and Nicobar Districts.

Comdt. (Retd.) Aditya Kumar, Senior Consultant, NDMA, New Delhi, along with officials, visited several sites in the city to assess the functioning of the Incident Response System and evaluate the preparedness and response levels of Incident Commanders to handle any eventuality. The exercise focused on the effectiveness of information dissemination, alert and warning systems, and the timely response of IRTs to save lives and property. The exercise concluded with an "All Clear" message issued from SEOC to all EOCs and stakeholders.

A debriefing session was later held in the Conference Hall of the Directorate of Disaster Management under the chairmanship of Ms. Chanchal Yadav, IAS, Commissioner-cum-Secretary (Disaster Management), A&N Administration. During the session, activities carried out during the exercise by the District Administrations, line departments, A&N Command, NDRF, INCOIS, Incident Commanders, and observers were comprehensively reviewed, and feedback was taken from all stakeholders.

Comdt. (Retd.) Aditya Kumar identified gaps and key areas requiring attention from the Administration. He appreciated the efforts of all IRTs, District Administrations, NDRF, ANC, and other stakeholders for the successful completion of the exercise. He emphasized the need for conducting such exercises regularly in the A&N Islands. Expressing satisfaction over the preparedness level of the UT, he stressed that the Administration should work on lessons learned from this exercise.

In her closing remarks, the Commissioner-cum Secretary, A&N Administration, Ms. Chanchal Yadav expressed happiness over the effective coordination among all participating agencies and noted that performance had improved compared to the last mock exercise. She appreciated the NDMA for executing the exercise with the cooperation of line Departments and the A&N Command. She assured that the gaps pointed out by NDMA would be addressed and necessary measures would be taken to strengthen disaster management mechanisms in the A&N Islands.

The Commissioner-cum-Secretary also highlighted that the Administration had successfully generated widespread public awareness about the exercise. She thanked the A&N Command, Indian Navy, Coast Guard, District Administrations and all Departments for their wholehearted support in ensuring the successful conduct of ISME-2025. She further emphasized the need for enhanced coordination among all Departments and agencies for better preparedness to tackle any potential disaster in the future.

be published on December 9, 2025. Claims and objections can be submitted from December 9, 2025 to January 8, 2026, followed by the Notice Phase (hearing & verification) from December 9, 2025 to January 31, 2026. The final Electoral Roll will be published on February 7, 2026.

During the enumeration phase (Nov. 4 to Dec. 4), Booth Level Officers (BLOs) will visit every household across the UT, covering a total of 3,10,404 electors (As on October 27, 2025). Each elector will be provided two copies of the pre-printed enumeration form by BLOs which contains details such as Name, EPIC Number, Address, Part Number, Constituency Name and Photograph. Electors are required to verify these details carefully and fill in missing information such as Date of Birth, Aadhaar Number (optional), Mobile Number, Parent's Name, and EPIC Numbers. They may also attach a fresh photograph in the space provided. BLOs will assist voters wherever necessary. Once electors complete the form and establish the required link, they must sign it and keep it ready for collection by the BLO during their next visit. BLOs will make up to three visits per household and will provide an acknowledgement copy upon receipt of the filled form. The filled in enumeration form will be reflected in the Draft Electoral Roll on December 9, 2025. During enumeration, Form 6 for registering new electors will also be done. In case some family members are absent, a senior member may sign the form on their behalf, the CEO stated.

For the ongoing SIR, a new section has been introduced in the enumeration form requiring electors to trace their own or their parent's name in the electoral roll from the last Intensive Revision conducted in 2002. The part-wise 2002 electoral roll is available on the CEO's website in PDF format at <https://www.ceoandaman.nic.in/election/E-ROLL-2002/default.htm>. A convenient search facility is also available at <https://ceo.andamannicobar.gov.in/sir2002/>, enabling voters to locate their names by entering basic details. Electors can contact ERO Office or call 1950 for clarification of doubts.

The CEO further mentioned that Voters who have shifted or migrated from other States and are presently enrolled in the A&N Islands Parliamentary Constituency are required to visit their respective State CEO's website or the Election Commission of India's portal (<https://voters.eci.gov.in/>) to trace or link their or their parent's names in the rolls prepared during the last SIR in their home State.

The CEO urged all voters to extend full cooperation to BLOs by providing accurate and complete information, stressing that the goal of the exercise is to ensure "No eligible voter is left out and no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll."

Pre-Test of Census 2027 starts in A&N Islands

Census of India will be conducted in 2027. The first phase of census namely, Houselisting and Housing Census (HLO) will start from 1st April, 2026. The Census 2027 shall be first fully digital Census, where data collection, management and monitoring of census functionaries shall be through mobiles applications and census portal. For testing the efficacy of the ecosystem created for census 2027, the testing exercise shall be conducted. The testing shall be done at selected villages of Diglipur Tehsil of North and Middle Andaman, Nancowry Tehsil of Nicobar and in one ward of SVPNC.

During the exercise, the mobile applications for mapping, houselisting data collection, portal for monitoring the census activities, self enumeration portal and other activities of census would be put to test. Before assigning field work, the appointed enumerators and Supervisors shall be imparted 3 days training by the officers from Directorate of Census Operations, A&N Islands between 1-6 November, 2025. The training started in Nancowry on 1st November, 2025 under the supervision of Shri Santosh Prakash, Assistant Commissioner and Shri Mohammed Yunus M., Block Development Officer. It was

inaugurated in Diglipur and SVPNC on 3rd November, 2025. Shri Abhishek Gulia, Assistant Commissioner, and Shri Biswanath Sen, Deputy Tehsildar, Diglipur are monitoring the training in Diglipur.

Ms Purva Garg, IAS, Director of Census Operations, A&N Islands visited the training facility at Sri Vijaya Puram and laid emphasis on hands-on training for the participants. Shri Azharuddin Zahiruddin Quazi, IAS, Secretary (SVPNC) also graced the occasion at Sri Vijaya Puram in the capacity of Town Census Officer, a press release from Directorate of Census, A&N Islands said.

GST Commissionerate intensifies compliance drive across A&N Islands following implementation of GST 2.0

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 4
Following the recent rate revisions and regulatory changes under GST 2.0, the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Department, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, has intensified its compliance enforcement measures across the Union Territory. Despite sufficient time and wide dissemination of the updated provisions, it has been observed that several business establishments continue to operate without adhering to the revised GST rates, exemptions and reporting norms.

Under the guidance of the Commissioner (UTGST), dedicated enforcement teams have been conducting surprise inspections of business establishments across Sri Vijaya Puram and adjoining areas since 22nd September, 2025. As part of this ongoing drive, 46 business units were inspected to verify

compliance with the latest GST provisions.

During these inspections, instances of non-compliance including incorrect rate application, non-display of GST registration details and failure to issue tax invoices as per the prescribed format were identified. On-the-spot penalties were levied in accordance with the provisions of the GST Act and Rules. A total penalty amount of Rs. 2.53 lakh has been recovered from defaulting establishments to date.

The Department reiterates that this enforcement initiative is part of a sustained compliance campaign aimed at ensuring that all registered taxpayers align with the revised GST framework. The drive will continue in the coming weeks, covering additional sectors and regions across the Islands.

Businesses are advised to strictly adhere to the

revised GST rates, exemption notifications, and procedural requirements to avoid penal action. Continued non-compliance will attract penalties and where necessary, prosecution under the applicable sections of the GST law.

Citizens and traders are also encouraged to play an active role in ensuring transparency in the tax ecosystem. Any instance of GST-related irregularities or non-compliance may be reported via WhatsApp at 9595359698.

The Department also welcomes queries or requests for clarification regarding GST rates, exemptions or related matters. The GST Department remains committed to promoting voluntary compliance and protecting consumer interests by ensuring that the benefits of tax reforms under GST 2.0 are effectively passed on to the public, a press release from DC (SA) said.
