Sheetalam Sasyashyamalam Mataram"-and interpreted it as a tribute to our motherland adorned with nature's divine blessings.

The primary objective of organising the programme was to educate and create awareness about the provisions of the POSH Act, 2013 among employers and employees of the public, private sector and unorganized sector too including the High Court and District Court.

Addressing the gathering, Hon'ble Justice Shampa Sarkar emphasized that as 37% of the workforce comprises women, and with the increasing participation of women in the workplace, it is essential to ensure that every woman feels comfortable and respected. The Lordship observed that workplaces must be sensitized to eliminate gender injustice and urged employers to strictly comply with the provisions of the Act. She further highlighted the importance of establishing dedicated helpline numbers, email IDs, and complaint boxes, all of which must be displayed prominently at every workplace.

While Hon'ble Justice Ananya Bandyopadhyay summarizing the discussions in detail, urged employers to prepare and distribute pamphlets in regional languages containing information about offences under the POSH Act, penalties, and punishments. The Lordship also recommended organizing regular awareness programmes and displaying relevant information within office premises to promote better understanding and compliance.

During the programme, the speakers highlighted various key aspects of the Act, including the importance and functioning of the Internal Committee (IC), the need for regular awareness initiatives, Creation of accessible complaint mechanisms, Maintenance of confidentiality and adherence to time-bound inquiries, Implementation of actions based on inquiry findings, Protection from retaliation, Educating employees about their rights and obligations, Employer responsibilities and legal consequences for non-compliance, Punishments for perpetrators and provisions against false complaints.

2. HOW TO APPLY:

(i) Eligible candidates may apply online through the website <https://erecruitment.andamannicobar.gov.in> from 17th November, 2025 (from 12.00 Noon) up to 17th December, 2025 (till 12:00 Midnight) after which the link will be disabled.

(iii) The candidates must go through the INSTRUCTIONS FOR APPLYING ONLINE carefully while filling up Online Application Form for the post concerned.

(iv) The candidates must submit their application through Online Mode only. No other mode of application shall be accepted. Applications received through any other mode i.e. by post/by hand/by mail etc. will not be accepted and will be summarily rejected. No correspondence will be entertained in this regard.

(v) Online application consists of five sections viz. (1) Personal details, (2) Post selection, (3) Qualification details, (4) Experience details and (5) Photograph and Signature.

(vi) Only those application which are complete with all the above five section will be treated as complete. However, applications that are submitted partially, due to reasons such as network issues, can be resumed and completed at a later point in time through appropriate options in the recruitment portal. All such applications are to be completed before the last date of the online application.

(vii) Candidates have to upload good quality Photograph and Signature in jpg/jpeg format. The background should be a plain white or off-white. It should have full face, front view, eyes open. The photograph should be without cap, mask or glasses/spectacles. If the uploaded photograph is not legible and of poor quality then his/her admission to the examination hall may be prohibited. Applications with inappropriate photographs and signature or blurred, not meeting with the prescribed requirement, will be rejected summarily.

* Photograph should be between 20 KB to 50 KB and the resolution recommended is 200x230 (width x height) in jpg/jpeg format and

* Signature should be between 10 KB to 20 KB and the resolution is 140x60 (width x height) in jpeg format.

* Other documents such as proof of age, qualifications, category, NOC etc. should be between 100 KB to 500 KB to be uploaded as instructed in the online portal.

(viii) Before submitting his/her ONLINE application, the candidate should read and follow the instructions for filling the online application and follow the instructions as directed in the online portal. Candidates should read the eligibility conditions for the examination and satisfy himself/herself that he/she fulfills all eligibility conditions to avoid rejection of her/his candidature, before submitting his/her ONLINE application.

(ix) Candidates are advised in their own interest to submit the online application much before the closing date and not to wait till the last date to avoid the possibility of disconnection/ inability or failure to login to the A & N Administration's website on account of heavy load on the website during the closing days. A & N Administration will not be responsible for the candidates not being able to submit their applications in stipulated time limit for any reason(s) stated to be beyond their control.

(x) The candidates should apply in order of their preferences of posts under each Nodal Department conducting recruitment.

(xi) Before submission of the online application, candidates must check and ensure that they have filled correct details in each field of the online application form. Once online application form is submitted, no request for change/ correction/ modification (including change of category) will be entertained or allowed under any circumstances. Request received in this regard in any form like Post, Email, by hand, etc. shall not be entertained and no correspondence will be made in this regard. Candidates will be responsible for any mistake in the data of application form & fee paid by him/her.

(xii) The A & N Administration does not accept any responsibility towards the candidates not being able to submit their application within the last date on account of any reasons beyond the control of the Administration.

(xiii) The information furnished by the candidates in their application(s) will be verified by the Nodal/ concerned Department/A & N Administration with reference to original documents during the Document Verification. If it is found during verification of documents that any information furnished by the candidate in online applications is wrong/false, his/her candidature will be rejected forthwith. The candidates should ensure that they have furnished correct information in the application form.

3. Eligibility Conditions:

(i) Applicant must be an Indian National.

(ii) All eligible candidates shall be required to apply Online for the post(s) whether they are registered with the Employment Exchange or otherwise.

(iii) The Departmental Candidates must also apply online within the due date and also upload the 'NOC' through the online submission of application for the respective post and must be produced at the time of verification of original certificates/documents.

(iv) The candidates should apply for the posts in order of opting their preferences (see Annexure-I).

4. Age Limit:

5. Educational& Other Qualifications prescribed for the post(s):-

The same is available in the link corresponding to the specific post they wish to apply.

a) PROCESS OF CERTIFICATION AND FORMAT OF CERTIFICATES:-

Candidates who wish to be considered against the vacancies reserved of seek age-relaxation must produce their original certificates issued by the competent authority and to submit a copy of the original certificate duly self-Attested whenever sought by the Administration, otherwise, their claims for ST/OBC/ EWS/ Pwd/ESM status will not be entertained and their candidature/ applications shall be considered under General(UR) category. Certificate for the status of Creamy Layer issued between 17.11.2023 to 17.12.2025 only will be accepted.

NOTE : Candidates are cautioned that they shall be permanently debarred from the examination conducted by the A & N Administration in case, they fraudulently claim ST/ OBC/ EWS/ ESM/PwD status.

b) Visually handicapped (VH) candidates with visual disabilities of forty percent (40%) and above and candidates suffering from Cerebral Palsy can avail the assistance of a SCRIBE in the Examination subject to such requests being made in the application form beforehand. Question Papers and Answer Sheets will not be provided in BRAILLE. No attendant will be allowed with Visually Handicapped (VH)/ Cerebral Palsy candidates inside the examination premises.

Note: Persons with Visual disability of less than forty percent (40%) will not be considered as visually handicapped persons. One eyed candidates and partially blind candidates who are able to read the normal Question Paper set for all the candidates with or without magnifying glass and who wish to write/indicate the answer with the help of Magnifying Glass will be allowed to use the Magnifying Glass in the Examination Hall and will not be entitled to a Scribe. Such candidates will have to bring their own Magnifying Glass to the Examination Hall. Similarly, other persons with less than forty percent (40%) disability will not be considered under the VH/HH/OH/M category as the case may be.

6. Fee Payable: - Rs.100/-(Rupees)

7. Centre of Examination for Online examination for All Posts:-

The Examination will be held (in Online mode) at the designated centres located at Sri Vijayapuram. The date and Venue/Centre of the CBT shall be intimated later through News Paper/Website by the concerned Nodal Department.

8. SYLLABUS/DURATION/MARKS/NEGATIVE MARKS: The detailed Syllabus/Duration/Marks/Negative Marks for the Recruitment Examination for the posts is available in the link corresponding to the specific post they wish to apply.

9. Method of Selection: - By CBT Online Examination & Skill tests wherever applicable.

10. TIER-II (SKILL/TRADE TEST):-

Wherever, Skill/Trade Test is prescribed as essential qualification for the post and qualifying in nature, it will be conducted by the concerned Nodal Department/ concerned department in respect of the successful candidates in the CBT Online examination, before finalizing the final merit list of the candidates.

11. VERIFICATION OF DOCUMENTS BY THE NODAL/CONCERNED DEPARTMENT:-

All the successful candidates short listed through Online Examination to get their original certificates/ Testimonials duly verified as are mandatory. They should submit a self-attested copy of all those mandatory certificates /testimonials in person along with the printed copy of Online Application to the authorized officers/ officials at the prescribed venue on the schedule date & time, failing which, his/her candidature shall be struck off from the relevant panel for all purposes and no further request/correspondence shall be entertained.

12. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS TO BE COMPLIED WITHBY THE CANDIDATES IN THE CBT ONLINE EXAMINATION

NOTE:-The admission of the candidates for the online examination is provisional. If it is found later on or any stage that he/she does not fulfil any of the conditions of the eligibility, the candidature will be cancelled and no appeal against such cancellation will be entertained. Therefore, candidates are advised to check carefully and satisfy themselves that he/she fulfill all the conditions of eligibility to the post applied.

a) The candidate will be admitted to take the recruitment examination at the centre specified in the Admit Card only and no other centre will be allowed. It shall be desirable to familiarize themselves with exact location of the examination centre in advance.

b) The candidates must bring in original a photo-bearing identity card such as Islander Card, Pan Card, Voter ID Card, Driving License, Aadhaar Card, etc. issued by the Competent Authority.

c) Candidates are required to bring one recent passport size photograph.

d) The candidate should not bring any other paper except the Admit card to the Recruitment Examination Hall/Room. Candidate found using or attempting to use any unfair means shall be liable to such punishment as Competent Authority may decide to impose.

e) Candidates are not permitted to use Mobile Phone, Micro Phone, Calculators, or any other associated accessories, Log Tables, Pager, Digital Diary, Electronic/Smart Watch, Bluetooth devices or any other electronic/electrical devices, Book and Note etc. Therefore, candidate must not bring the said items inside the recruitment examination hall/room. Possession of these items, whether in use or otherwise, will be considered as "Use of unfair means" in the recruitment examination and appropriate action will be taken by the Department against such candidates.

f) During the recruitment examination the candidates shall strictly follow the instructions provided in the Admit Card.

13. MODE OF SELECTION:

a) The recruitment process will consist of the Online Examination, Document/Certificate verification/Skill-Trade test where applicable for the posts.

b) All the candidates whose applications were received through online will be called for appearing to the online Examination. The A & N Administration will not undertake detailed scrutiny of the applications for the eligibility and other aspects at the time of Online Examination. Therefore, the candidature will be accepted provisionally.

c) Candidates will be short-listed on the basis of their merit and preferences in the Computer Based Test (CBT) . Candidates for each vacancy will be finally selected based on their performance in the CBT Online Examination (Tier-I), subject to their meeting basic qualifying standards fixed in skill/trade test (Tier-II), if any/as applicable for the posts.

d) The shortlisted candidates, who qualify the online examination, will be called for certificate/document verification in person.

e) The candidates shortlisted for certificate/document verification will be based on merit in the Recruitment Examination, in the respective category.

f) ST, OBC, EWS, MSP & PwDs candidates, who are selected on their merit without relaxed standards, will not be adjusted against the reserved share of vacancies.

g) The reserved vacancies will be filled up separately from amongst the eligible ST, OBC, who are domicile of A & N Islands and who are lower in merit than the last General candidate (UR) in merit list of un-reserved category but otherwise found suitable for appointment even by relaxed standard.

h) Physically Handicapped (OH/VH) category candidate who qualifies on the basis of relaxed standards viz. age limit, experience or qualifications, permitted number of chances in CBT Online examination, extended zone of consideration, etc. is to be counted against reserved vacancies and not against general vacancies subject to fitness of such candidate for selection. Such candidates may also be recommended at relaxed standards to the extent of the number of vacancies reserved for them, to make up for the deficiency in the reserved quota, irrespective of their rank in the order of merit. NOTE: The candidate applying for the post should ensure that they fulfil all eligibility conditions prescribed for the post. Their admission at all the stages of recruitment process will be purely provisional, subject to their satisfying the prescribed eligibility conditions. Success in the

recruitment examination confers no right of appointment unless government is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects for appointment to Government service/post and the decision of the A & N Administration in this regard shall be final & binding. Provided that ST, OBC, MSP, EWS, ESM and PwD candidates, who are selected on their own merit without relaxed standards, will not be adjusted against the reserved share of the vacancies. Such MSP, ESM and PwD candidates will be accommodated against the general/unreserved vacancies as per their position in the overall Merit List.

Success at the examination confers no right of appointment whatsoever unless the A & N Administration is satisfied after such enquiry as may be considered necessary that the candidate is suitable in all respects of appointment to the service/post and the decision in this regard shall be final & binding.

14. RESOLUTION OF THE TIE CASES

In cases where more than one candidate secures the equal aggregate marks, tie will be resolved by applying the following methods one after another:-
1. Date of birth i.e. the candidate older in age gets preference.

2. By referring to the alphabetical order of the names taking first name into consideration.

15. ADMISSION TO THE EXAMINATION

1. All candidates who apply in response to this advertisement by the CLOSING DATE FOR RECEIPT OF ONLINE APPLICATION shall be assigned registration numbers/unique application number. The Registration number/unique application number will be mandatorily required to download the Admit Card for the recruitment examination. Admit Card to candidates for online examination will be issued by the Nodal Department through online mode which will be intimated through Press Note and website. The candidates have to download and take printout of the admit card from the website. The A & N Administration shall not be responsible for non-receipt/delay in obtaining the same by the candidate or any other reason(s). The candidates are advised to regularly read the local Newspaper or visit the Department's website for examination related latest updates/information. No admit card for the aforesaid posts will be sent by post. In case, a candidate does not find his/her name in the above uploaded list, candidate must immediately contact the Nodal Department with proof of having submitted his/her application online. Failure to do so shall deprive him/her of any claim for consideration subsequently.

16. ACTION AGAINST CANDIDATES FOUND GUILTY OF MISCONDUCT:

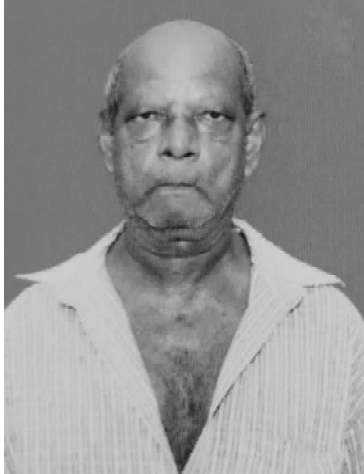

F. No. 34-725/2021, Whereas, in terms of Notification S.O. No. 1997(E) dated 23rd June, 2017, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, until further orders, exercises the powers and discharges the functions of the **“Appropriate Government”** under the *Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013* (RFCTLARR Act, 2013) and the rules made thereunder for acquisition of private land at *Village Govind Nagar, Campbell Bay, Great Nicobar, Andaman & Nicobar Islands*, as per the details given below:

And whereas, the said acquisition has been justified as being in the interest of national security and strategic requirements of the State. The matter, therefore, falls squarely within the ambit of Section 40 of the *Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013*, which empowers the Government to invoke the urgency clause in cases where land is required for the defence of India or national security.

And whereas, the above area proposed to be acquired for the construction of critical military infrastructure represents the minimum extent required for the defence of India and national security. The provisions of sub-sections (1), (2), and (3) of Section 40 of the said Act are therefore applicable to the acquisition of the aforesaid land.

And whereas, the construction of this infrastructure on the said land is of vital importance to the sovereignty, integrity, security, and strategic interests of the nation.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-sections (1) and (4) of Section 40 of the *Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition, Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 (30 of 2013)*, the Hon'ble Lt. Governor, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, hereby directs that:

(a) The provisions of Chapters II and III and Sections 15 to 18 of the said Act shall not apply to this acquisition, and declaration may be made under Section 19 in respect of the said land at any time after publication of the preliminary notification under sub-section (1) of Section 11;

(b) The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District, though no award has been made, may, on the expiration of 30 days from the publication of notice under Section 21, take possession of any land required for public purpose, and such land shall thereupon vest absolutely in the Government, free from all encumbrances; and

(c) No additional compensation shall be payable for the acquisition of the said land.
