## Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral Rolls is underway - For any queries related to the SIR process, Dial 1950

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 13

The Chief Electoral Officer, Andaman & Nicobar Islands, Shri L. Kumar, IAS has informed the general public that the Enumeration Phase under the Special Intensive Revision (SIR) of Electoral Rolls is currently in progress.

During this phase, Booth Level Officers (BLOs) are visiting households to distribute pre-filled Enumeration Forms (in duplicate) and assist electors in filling the forms. All eligible electors are requested to cooperate with the BLOs and ensure that their details are correctly entered in the Enumeration Forms. If any elector has not received the Enumeration Form as on date, they may contact their Booth Level Officer (BLO) for any assistance, queries, or guidance related to filling the Enumeration Form or its online submission. A dedicated Voter Helpline (1950) has also been set up to support electors and provide details of their respective BLOs.

also included the rescue of three simulated injured persons, who were promptly given First Aid and evacuated by the response team.

The entire exercise was carried out in a coordinated manner, demonstrating efficient response protocols and inter-agency cooperation under the overall supervision of Shri.J. Gopinath, Deputy Director (i/c), DSS. Once the situation was declared normalized, all personnel returned safely to their respective workstations.

He said that our largest target group is the young electors who have been completed 18 years of age, eligible to become voters. He urged the TGCE trainees to enrol themselves as voters by filling Form- 6 to exercise their franchise to build a strong democracy. Our effort is to ensure that no college students who have attained 18 plus is left out without their enrolment in the voters list, he added.



The resource persons Shri. Raja Ram and Shri. Senthil, State Level Master Trainers enlightened the participants about the eligibility criteria for voters, detailed explanation of the enumeration process and also demonstrated the procedure for filling up the enumeration form and clarified the doubts regarding voter ID correction, inclusion and deletion process. They further informed that under the SIR, at present, the enumeration process is underway and it will

continue up to Dec. 4. The Draft Electoral Roll will be published on December 9, 2025. Claims and objections can be submitted from December 9, 2025 to January 8, 2026, followed by the Notice Phase (hearing & verification) from December 9, 2025 to January 31, 2026. The final Electoral Roll will be published on February 7, 2026. They urged the trainees to disseminate this information to their friends, colleagues, relatives, neighbors about this exercise aimed to ensure that no eligible voter is left out and no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll.

The session emphasized the value of active voter participation, the right to vote, and the responsibility of citizens in strengthening democratic processes. During the question & answer session, the trainees got their doubts clarified by the resource persons which made the awareness programme a participatory one. The Principal, TGCE, Dr. Manjulata Rao and Ms. Ishrat Yousuf, Nodal Officer (ELC) encouraged students to stay informed and actively engage in democratic practices. Around 240 students actively participated in the programme, engaging in discussions and awareness activities, a press release received here said.

3-Day training workshop on conservation & sustainable management of coastal & marine biodiversity gets underway

The 3- days training workshop on conservation and sustainable management of coastal and marine biodiversity of island ecosystem for the personnel of other services under the "Forestry Training and Capacity Building" got underway today in the conference hall of ZSI here. The workshop, an initiative by Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, GoI is being conducted by the Zoological Survey of India, A&N Regional Centre and EIACP Centre on Island Biodiversity.

Inaugurating the workshop as the chief guest, Dr. S. Dinesh Kannan, IFS, Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife), Department of Environment and Forests, A & N Islands appreciated the effort of ZSI for arranging such a valuable training for officers from different departments around the islands. He said the training workshop



would provide participants a broader understanding of the islands' biodiversity, including corals, rare plants and animals, and ecosystem services.

well-being by setting up of own fish seed hatcheries under PMMSY. She emphasized that such programmes not only empower individual livelihoods but also contribute to enhancing the quality of freshwater aquaculture production, which can help the Islands establish a stronger presence in freshwater fish production scenario of India. She also added that this initiative will help in reducing the dependency of Islands in bringing the seeds and freshwater fishes for local use.

The Secretary further encouraged the trainees to implement the knowledge gained during the programme and actively contribute to building a more robust and resilient freshwater aquaculture activity in the Islands by availing financial assistance under PMMSY. The Secretary (Fisheries) also released the Training Manual prepared by the Department of Fisheries during the inaugural session.

Shri Chittaranjan Raul, Scientist, ICAR-CIARI, elaborated on the comprehensive nature of the training. The training programme aims at equipping participants with essential theoretical and practical knowledge on fish seed production, focusing on the principles of freshwater aquaculture, farm design and layout, pond preparation, induced breeding techniques, and nursery management. It also covers aspects related to feeding, water quality maintenance, health care, fabrication of aquarium tanks, feed and breeding management of freshwater ornamental fishes, aquascaping, and common diseases encountered in the Islands.

A field visit to ICAR-CIARI's freshwater ornamental fish breeding unit and freshwater fish seed farm at Nayagaon has also been scheduled as part of the training programme.

Shri Bhargav Chakravarty, Assistant Director of Fisheries (Ext. & Trg.) and Shri G. Amalatheeban, Assistant Director of Fisheries(South Andaman), also spoke on the occasion and appreciated the efforts of the participants. The event concluded with a vote of thanks proposed by Shri.
