All eligible electors are requested to cooperate with the BLOs and ensure that their details are correctly entered in the Enumeration Forms. If any elector has not received the Enumeration Form as on date, they may contact their Booth Level Officer (BLO) for any assistance, queries, or guidance related to filling the Enumeration Form or its online submission. 


