SVPMC's zero-tolerance policy towards illegal waste disposal

Action taken against illegal garbage dumping; Defaulters nabbed through surveillance & penalties imposed

General public urged to cooperate in maintaining cleanliness and report any illegal dumping activities on helpline number: 03192-231179

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 17

Sri Vijaya Puram Municipal Council demonstrated a zero-tolerance policy towards illegal waste disposal by taking swift punitive action against a private individual for illegally dumping garbage near Carmel Senior Secondary School yesterday.

The action was initiated after the Council received a complaint, which was further amplified through social media platforms, regarding a carriage auto rickshaw discarding waste in an unauthorized manner. Responding promptly to the public concern, the SVPMC immediately deployed a team of officials to the site for verification.

In a coordinated effort with local police personnel, a thorough investigation was conducted. The investigation successfully identified and traced the carriage auto rickshaw to a private owner. The identified defaulter was held accountable and was



compelled to clear the entire illegally dumped waste from the site. The clean-up was conducted under the supervision of SVPMC

officials Shri. Vijay Kumar, Senior Sanitary Inspector, Ward No. 06 along with Ward staff, ensuring proper segregation of the waste as

per municipal norms.

Furthermore, a stringent financial penalty of Rs. 2,000 was imposed on the offender under the relevant provisions of the Solid Waste Management (SWM) By-laws. Additionally, SVPMC notes that a similar violation was penalised on Nov. 13 & 17 at Ward No. 03, reflecting the Council's zero-tolerance approach towards illegal dumping.

The SVPMC reaffirms its commitment to upholding cleanliness standards and will continue to take appropriate and punitive action against any such illegal activities in the future.

SVPMC has urged the general public to cooperate in maintaining cleanliness and to report any illegal dumping activities to the Council for immediate action. Complaints may be lodged 24x7 on the helpline number: 03192-231179, a press release from SVPMC said.

Electors urged to submit Enumeration Forms to Booth Level Officers at the earliest

All electors of Andaman & Nicobar Islands have been informed that their respective Booth Level Officers (BLOs) have already distributed pre-filled Enumeration Forms in duplicate during the enumeration phase under the ongoing Special Intensive Revision of electoral roll w.r.t. 01.01.2026 as the qualifying date.

It is now time for electors to submit their duly filled forms to the BLO without delay, to ensure their name appears in the draft electoral roll to be published on Dec. 9, 2025.

Booth Level Officers (BLOs) are collecting Enumeration Forms during house visits and will assist electors with any queries or guidance related to filling the forms and mapping. If any elector has not received the Enumeration Form, they may contact their BLO or call the Voter Helpline (1950) for assistance.

The names of electors who submit their signed Enumeration Forms will be included in the Draft Electoral Roll. The event, which underscored the collective responsibility towards child welfare, concluded with a vote of thanks delivered by Ms. Sunita Sharma, Faculty, SIE, a press release from Principal, SIE said.
