Hon'ble President presents sixth National Water Awards and Jal Sanchay-Jan Bhagidari Awards

Effective water management is possible only with the participation of individuals, families, society, and the Govt.: Hon'ble President

New Delhi, Nov. 18 (PTI)

The Hon'ble President of India, Smt. Droupadi Murmu presented the sixth National Water Awards and Jal Sanchay-Jan Bhagidari Awards at a function held in New Delhi today. Speaking on the occasion, the President said that the story of human civilization is the story of groups settling in the river valleys, along seashores, and around various water sources. In our tradition, rivers, lakes, and other water sources are revered. In our national song, the first word Bankim Chandra Chatterjee wrote is Sujalam. This means "blessed with abundant water resources." This fact reflects the priority of water for our country. The Hon'ble President said that

efficient water use is a global imperative. Efficient water use is even more crucial for our country because our water resources are limited compared to the population. Per capita water availability is a major challenge. She underlined that climate change is affecting the water cycle. In such circumstances, the government and the public should work together to ensure water availability and water security.

The Hon'ble President was happy to note that under the Jal Sanchay-Jan Bhagidari initiative launched last year, more than 35 lakh structures have been constructed.

The Hon'ble President said that by adopting circular water economy systems, all

industries and other resources. She noted that, stakeholders can make along with water effective use of water treatment and

recirculation, many industrial units have achieved the target of zero fluid discharge. She stated that such efforts are useful for water management and conservation.

The Hon'ble President emphasised on prioritization of water conservation and consistent management at the level of central and state governments, district administrations, village panchayats, and municipal bodies. She was happy to note that numerous educational institutions, citizen groups, and non-governmental organizations are also contributing in this direction. She advised farmers and entrepreneurs to adopt innovative methods of maximizing production while minimizing water consumption. She highlighted that

rational citizens who enthusiastically contribute individually are also important stakeholders in the water-prosperity value chain. Effective water management is possible only with the participation of individuals, families, society, and the government.

The Hon'ble President said that while using water, everyone should remember that we are using a very valuable asset. She underlined that tribal communities treat all natural resources, including water, with great respect. She stressed that the most efficient use of water resources should be an integral part of the lifestyle of all our citizens. She advised everyone to remain constantly vigilant

The District Administration, South Andaman, as part of its continued efforts to safeguard Government land and prevent unauthorised occupation, carried out a series of coordinated anti-encroachment drives across Ferrargunj and Little Andaman Tehsil. These operations led to the successful removal of fresh encroachments and the restoration of 5100 sq. mtr of revenue land.

In Ferrargunj Tehsil,



eviction drives were carried out at multiple locations. At Mathura and Tushnabad villages, encroachments in the form of fencing were cleared, reclaiming 1500

sq. mtr of Government land. At Bambooflat village, 500 sq. mtr of encroached land was restored to its original condition. Additionally, at Craikabad village, an

unauthorised tent structure used for dwelling was removed, retrieving 100 sq. mtr of revenue land. In total, 2100 sq. mtr of

The State Transport Authority (STA) has been receiving complaints from general public regarding plying of Autorickshaw without putting/switching on the fare meters and charging exorbitant fares by the drivers. Section 74 (2)(viii) & Section 96(xx) of the MV Act 1988 mandates

that in case of Autorickshaw/Taxi, a fare meter shall be fitted and maintained in proper working order. This has been informed to the general public as well as Autorickshaw owners/drivers through releases in local media on many previous occasions. The Autorickshaw Permit

holders have been informed once again to refrain from such practices as repeated violations will warrant actions for cancellation of Permits. Enforcement drives will be carried out to ensure the strict compliance of the permit conditions.

Government land was restored in Ferrargunj Tehsil.

In Little Andaman, the Revenue Team also took swift action in Ongi Tirkey, Hutbay village, clearing fencing, tin sheds, banana trees, and garden patches erected by occupants of the nearby Tsunami Shelter. This resulted in the reclamation of 1500 sq. mtr of Government land. At Netaji Nagar, encroachments involving coconut and areca nut plantations were removed, restoring an additional 1500 sq. mtr of revenue land. Altogether, 3000 sq. mtr of Government land was retrieved in Little Andaman.

ensure their name appears in the draft electoral roll to be published on Dec. 9, 2025. If any elector has not received the Enumeration Form, they may contact their BLO or call the Voter Helpline (1950) for assistance.

In his address on the occasion, Dr. N. Balakrishnan, Nodal Officer (SVEEP), highlighted various Systematic Voters' Education and Electoral Participation (SVEEP) activities conducted across the Islands to strengthen electoral literacy. He urged the JNRM students to register themselves as voters so that they can also participate in the democratic process by voting in the elections. The SIR exercise is aimed to ensure that no eligible voter is left out and no ineligible person is included in the Electoral Roll, he concluded.

Dr. R. P. Palanisamy, Associate Professor, Nodal Officer, ELC, JNRM, also addressed the gathering on the importance of voting and the role of responsible citizens in strengthening democracy.

The resource person, Shri. Raja Ram, State Level Master Trainer, delivered insightful session with special reference to the ongoing SIR activity and enlightened the participants about the eligibility criteria for voters, detailed explanation of the enumeration process and also demonstrated the procedure for filling up the enumeration form and clarified the doubts regarding voter ID correction, inclusion and deletion process. The Social Impact Assessment (SIA) was carried out by Social Welfare Department through M/s Probe Research and Social Development Pvt. Ltd., Delhi and a report submitted/preliminary investigation was conducted by a team constituted by Collector as laid down under Rule 4 of the said Rule vide Order No. 50 dated 10.06.2025 and report was received vide Letter No. General-69/EE/CD/CB/2025/2378 dated 19.09.2025. The copy of SIA Report, copy of Expert Group Report and copy of Committee Report have been annexed as ' Annexure-I ', ' Annexure-II ' and ' Annexure-III ' respectively. The summary of the Social Impact Assessment Report/ Preliminary investigation is as follows:										
This development of Greenfield International Airport is for Defense, Strategic, National Security, and Public Purpose. Hence, as per the Right to Fair Compensation and Transparency in Land Acquisition Rehabilitation and Resettlement Act, 2013 Section 2- (1)-(a & b), the acquisition of land for the project serves public purpose.										
The Committee finds that the public purpose of the proposed airport project is immense. The project not only holds substantial benefits for the local community including the people affected by the land acquisition, but also serves a larger purpose for the nation as a whole. The strategic location of the Nicobar Islands, coupled with improved connectivity, will enhance economic, social, and defence-related integration with mainland India, thereby bolstering national security and development.										
A total of 263 families are likely to be displaced due to the land acquisition. The reason necessitating such displacement is that as per findings of the committee, the acquisition of land for the aforementioned project serves public purpose and after going through all the required technicality of the airport construction by the experts, SIA team and all stakeholders have selected the Gandhi Nagar village and Shastri Nagar village as the most suitable site.										
The Deputy Commissioner, Nicobar District is appointed as Administrator for Rehabilitation and Resettlement vide A&N Administration Notification F. No. 34-725/2017-Rev dated 14.11.2017 under Section 43 of the Act for the purpose of rehabilitation and resettlement of the affected families. 
