

- · Identifying new eligible voters, including those who have attained the qualifying age as of January 1, 2025.
- Prospective electors for future qualifying dates (April 1, 2025; July 1, 2025; October 1, 2025).
- Reporting multiple entries, deceased electors, and those who have permanently shifted.
- Necessary corrections to electoral roll entries.

As part of the Annual Summary Revision (ASR) of the electoral roll for SSR-2025, the integrated draft electoral roll was published on October 29, 2024. The Deputy Commissioner (South Andaman)/District Election Officer (South Andaman) has appealed to the public to actively participate in this crucial democratic exercise by submitting claims and objections during the designated period from October 29, 2024, to November 28, 2024. The finalized electoral roll is scheduled for publication on January 6, 2025.

To facilitate public engagement, special camps were held on November 9 and 10, 2024 (Saturday and Sunday). Additional camps are scheduled for 23rd November, 2024 and 24th November, 2024, at all Polling Stations across the region.
