NCW to host National Consultation on "Laws Relating to Women in Prison" in A&N Islands today

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 21

The National Commission for Women will organise a National Consultation on "Laws Relating to Women in Prison" tomorrow (Nov. 22) in A&N Islands as part of its nationwide review for 2025-26. The consultation aims to identify urgent reforms needed to strengthen the rights, welfare, and dignity of women inmates across India. This flagship initiative is being led by Hon'ble Chairperson, NCW, Smt. Vijaya Rahatkar.

Women constitute 4.3% of the prison population, yet in many States they continue to face significant systemic barriers, including overcrowded facilities, inadequate medical and mental-health services, lack of gender-sensitive infrastructure, poor hygiene, and heightened safety vulnerabilities.

The National Consultation will bring together experts, prison administrators, and policymakers to deliberate on critical reforms.

To ensure inclusivity and representation, NCW conducted eight Regional Consultations in Noida, Panaji, Aizwal, Patna, Bhopal, Patiala, Hyderabad, and Dehradun. These consultations generated over 300 expert recommendations, of which 205 key proposals will now be taken up at the National Consultation.

Dr. Chandra Bhushan Kumar, IAS, Chief Secretary, A&N Administration, graced the occasion as the chief guest. Shri Arjun Sharma, IAS, Deputy Commissioner, South Andaman and Ms. Purva Garg, IAS, Secretary, A&N Administration, also graced the occasion as guests of honour.

Administration launched open-sea cage culture, marking a major milestone in the region's fisheries sector. At the event, the chief guest handed over leasing orders to the three selected applicants, engaging with them on their aspirations and challenges, and assuring them of sustained institutional support.

Addressing the gathering, the Chief Secretary underscored the significance of World Fisheries Day as a moment to reaffirm collective commitment to marine conservation and responsible harvesting. He highlighted the relevance of this year's national theme and stressed that the A&N Islands possess immense potential to become a leading hub for sustainable fisheries and seafood-based industries.

The chief guest also launched the Training Manual and Documentary Videos on Seaweed Cultivation in the A&N Islands, developed as part of culmination of 45 days Seaweed culture training programme for SHGs to promote capacity-building and skill enhancement. He stated that such knowledge resources will empower local communities and help them tap into new avenues of sustainable livelihoods. He noted that the fisheries sector in the Islands is witnessing steady progress, and with coordinated efforts, it can contribute substantially to employment generation, export growth, and economic resilience. The Chief Secretary encouraged stakeholders to adopt scientific and eco-friendly fishing methods, upgrade skills, and explore new technologies that can enhance productivity. He further elaborated on the promising Tuna Cluster Development initiatives and stressed the importance of improving product quality, establishing cold-chain systems, and creating strong branding for island fish varieties in global markets. He added that the Administration remains committed to providing every possible support, be it technological assistance, training, infrastructure, or policy facilitation, to ensure that fishermen and fish farmers truly benefit from the region's rich marine resources.

Ms. Jagtap Kalyani Rajendra, Director of Fisheries, in her welcome address emphasized the importance of commemorating World Fisheries Day to recognize the valuable contributions of fishermen and fish farmers in ensuring food security and sustainable livelihoods. She highlighted the Department's recent initiatives to support the small-scale fishermen community across the Islands, reaffirming the Administration's commitment to inclusive fisheries development. She elaborated on the progress of Open Sea Cage Culture, Seaweed Cultivation, and other emerging fisheries-based livelihood options that hold immense potential for boosting the island economy.

focus on key legislations including the Model Prison Act 2023, Prison Act 1894, Model Prison Manual 2016, Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act 2019, and the Repatriation of Prisoners Act 2003.

Core themes include gender-sensitive correctional systems, improved medical and mental-health support, rights of incarcerated mothers and their children, safe accommodation for transgender inmates, and humane treatment of foreign national prisoners. The recommendations emerging from the consultation will contribute to NCW's final report to the Government of India.

During her visit to the Islands, the Hon'ble Chairperson, NCW, Smt. Vijaya Rahatkar, also led several important initiatives aimed at strengthening women's safety and empowerment at the grassroots. The Chairperson called on Admiral D K Joshi, PVSM, AVSM, YSM, NM, VSM, (Retd.), Hon'ble Lt. Governor, A&N Islands and Vice-Chairman, Islands Development Agency at Raj Niwas and discussed ongoing initiatives and the future roadmap for strengthening women's welfare across the UT. 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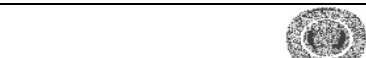

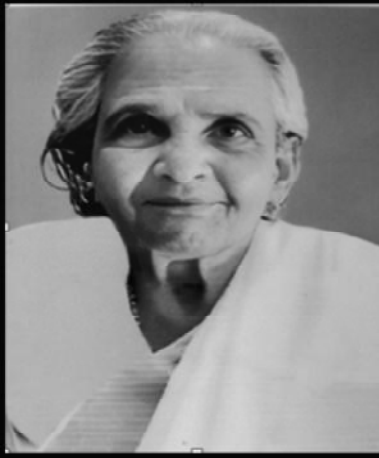
