



This extended policy aims to provide a cashless treatment worth Rs 5 lakh to all senior citizens, with an only eligibility criterion, that the individual must be aged 70 years and above, as determined by the age recorded in their Aadhaar Card, regardless of economic status. who are already availing benefits of other public health insurance schemes such as Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS), Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS), Ayushman Central Armed Police Force (CAPF) may either choose their existing scheme or opt for AB-PMJAY. It has been clarified that senior citizens of 70 years and above who are under private health insurance policies or Employees' State Insurance scheme will be eligible to avail benefits under AB-PMIAY.

The enrollment of senior citizens 70 years and above under the scheme may be done by visiting the website - pmjay.gov.in, where they can click on the "PMJAY for 70+" option on the homepage and self register as beneficiary or one can download "Ayushman App" from Google play store and self register as beneficiary. 


