Biggest drug haul in maritime history

Indian Coast Guard of A&N Command apprehends Myanmarrese boat with 5500 kg of Drugs

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 25
Indian Coast Guard (ICG) of Andaman and Nicobar Command created history in the maritime domain in India by apprehending a Myanmarse Fishing boat named "Soe Wai Yan Htoo" in Andaman seas which was carrying approx. 5500 kgs of prohibited drug Methamphetamine along with one portable Inmarsat Satellite phone today (Nov. 25). The anticipated value of drug haul is expected to be thousands of crores, in international market. Based on the pattern of operations in the past likely areas of Andaman Sea were kept under



surveillance. As part of heightened surveillance measures, Headquarters Andaman and Nicobar Command maintained regular maritime aircraft

missions. On Nov. 23, 2024, the Indian Coast Guard Dornier aircraft whilst on reconnaissance sortie detected a boat which

was operating in suspicious manner. The information was passed on to the Joint Operation Centre (JOC)/ HQANC, (Contd. on last page)

APAAR, which stands for Automated Permanent Academic Account Registry, is a specialized identification system designed for all students in India. This initiative is part of the 'One Nation, One Student ID' program launched by the GoI, aligning with the new National Education Policy of 2020. For students, APAAR functions as a digital record. APAAR also empowers students to accumulate and store their academic accomplishments, facilitating seamless transitions between institutions for the pursuit of further education. The APAAR ID simplifies the processes of credit recognition and transfer right from the school level, thereby, streamlining

academic progression and recognition of prior learning. The Department of Education, A&N Administration has commenced APAAR generation for students of all management schools in the month of October, 2024 in 408 Schools across the Union Territory. It is pertinent to mention that as of Nov. 24, 2024 midnight data, APAARs have been successfully generated for

Whereas, inputs have been received that Anti- national elements might carry out unlawful acts in South Andaman District which might endanger both, persons and property.

And whereas, these Anti-national elements may stay in Hotels, Guest houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. while doing preparation, reconnaissance, and actual execution of these unlawful acts.

And whereas, it is necessary to take speedy measures in this behalf, to protect property and prevent danger to human life and safety, thwart/prevent terrorist activities, which may affect and disturb Public Order and Tranquility in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands.

Now, therefore, I Arjun Sharma, District Magistrate, South Andaman, in exercise of the powers conferred upon me by virtue of Section 163 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023 do hereby make the written order for strict compliance of following Conditions by the Owners of all such establishments in the jurisdiction of South Andaman District, of Andaman & Nicobar Islands:-
1. Only those Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. which possess valid licences, shall be allowed to function.
2. All such establishments shall have sufficient number of CCTV cameras which shall cover persons entering the premises and moving outside. All the cameras installed shall be in working condition, and their coverage shall be preserved for not less than 30 days.
3. All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall maintain a Register having complete details of persons staying in the said premise. A copy of the valid ID proof of such persons shall be kept for record.
4. All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. shall ensure that details relating to Form-C (Arrival Report of Foreigners in Hotel) are submitted to the Registering Authorities within the prescribed period. All procedures/guidelines shall be followed in respect of any Foreign National staying in the said premise.

This order shall come into force w.e.f zero hours of 25.11.24 and shall remain in force for a period of 60 days unless withdrawn earlier.

All such Hotels, Guest Houses, Bed & Breakfast (Home Stays), Lodges, etc. which contravene this order, shall be liable to be punished in accordance with the provision of Section 208 of Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita (BNSS)-2023.

As this order cannot be served individually upon all concerned, this order is hereby passed Ex-Parte. It shall be published for the information of the general public through the press and by affixing copies on the Notice Boards in the offices of all SsP, DySPs, Tehsildars, Patwaries and all Police Stations.

FIR registered against Hotel Manager for violating District Magistrate's orders on guest registration and security measures

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 25

An FIR has been registered at Police Station Aberdeen against the Manager of Hotel Nakshatra U/S 223 of the Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita, 2023 for failing to adhere to essential security protocols as mandated by the District Magistrate's Order No. 2-25/2023-R/TSD/DC(SA)/4434 dated 25/09/2024. The Manager of Hotel Nakshatra, situated at Goalghar, has violated specific directives related to guest registration, check-in procedures, and security measures in the hotel.

As per the District Magistrate's order, it is a legal requirement for hotels to maintain a check-in register that includes the collection of valid identity cards from all guests, as well as retaining CCTV footage for a minimum

of 30 days to ensure safety and security. During a checking, it was revealed that the hotel did not follow these guidelines appropriately, putting the safety of both guests and the general public at risk.

The Manager did not obtain the necessary identification documents from several guests as per the District Magistrate's directive, at check-in. The required check-in register was not properly maintained, leading to concerns about proper guest records and accountability. Moreover, the hotel failed to retain CCTV footage for the mandated 30-day period, compromising critical surveillance and security documentation.

Strict action will be taken to prevent such incidents in the future, emphasizing the importance of adhering to rules that ensure the safety and security of the public. All hotels must comply with these essential guidelines to safeguard both guests and the community. A&N Police urges all Hotel Owners and Managers to review their operations and ensure compliance with all safety regulations.

which subsequently deployed Fast Patrol Vessel, ICG Ship Aruna Asaf Ali captained by Commandant (JG) Ankit Sharma from Sri Vijaya Puram to intercept the suspicious Myanmarese boat. The ICG ship despite prevailing rough sea conditions proceeded with best speed to intercept the suspicious Myanmarese boat. The ICG Ship intercepted the Myanmarese boat and shadowed till early morning of Nov. 24, 2024. The ship crew boarded the suspicious Myanmarese boat for investigation at 0630 hrs on Nov. 24, 2024 when the boat was 8 NM off Barren Island in Indian Territorial waters. The six-boat crew on board were identified as Myanmarese nationals.

During inspection of the boat, the ICG ship crew detected approx. 5500 kgs of white crystalline compound onboard along with one portable Inmarsat



Satellite phone. The white crystalline compound was anticipated to be contraband and hence, boat was apprehended. Subsequently boat was brought to Sri Vijaya Puram by 0500hrs on 25th Nov., 2024 for further investigation. The initial inspection by local police and drug enforcement agencies at Sri Vijaya Puram identified the white compound as pure Methamphetamine worth approx. thousands of crores in international market. The apprehension is one of the biggest drug overhauls in Indian maritime history.

This operation highlights unwavering commitment to safeguarding our territorial integrity and preventing the trafficking of illegal substances. The dedication and swift action of our teams involved in ensuring that such illicit activities do not compromise national security. The Andaman and Nicobar Command remain vigilant and committed to ensuring the safety of the Andamans waters. Enhanced patrolling and intelligence-sharing continue to play a vital role in combating such crimes. India crush Australia by 295 runs in first Test of Border-Gavaskar Trophy

Perth, Nov. 25

In Cricket, India delivered a resounding 295-run victory over Australia in the first Test of the Border-Gavaskar Trophy, in Perth, Australia. This emphatic win marks one of India's largest Test triumphs and the first-ever test win of a visiting team at the new Perth Stadium.

Key performances by Indian skipper Jasprit Bumrah and Mohammed Siraj, who each claimed three crucial wickets, ensured Australia's second-innings collapse. On the batting front, Virat Kohli's unbeaten century and Yashasvi Jaiswal's stellar knock of 161 powered India to set a daunting



target of 534 runs for the hosts.

For Australia, Travis Head was the star player as he scored 89 runs. Apart from him, Mitchell Marsh scored 47 while Alex Carey scored 36.

Earlier, starting their second innings on the final day, Australia were bundled out for 238, falling far short of the target. Skipper Bumrah was adjudged Player of the Match.

With this commanding victory, India climbed to the top of the ICC World Test Championship standings with 61.11 percentage of points, displacing Australia, who dropped to second place with 57.69 percentage of points. The win also gave India a 1-0 lead in the five-match series.

The second Test is scheduled to begin on December 6 at the Adelaide Oval.

AND WHEREAS, copies of the said Official Gazette were made available to the public on the 20th day of July'2023.

AND WHEREAS, no objections and suggestions have been received.

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (XVIII) of Section 96 (2) read with sub-section 41 of section 2 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Lt. Governor (Administrator), Andaman & Nicobar Islands hereby makes the following rules further to Amend the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Rules, 2006, namely:-

1. Short Title and Commencement

i. These rules may be called the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles (Amendment) Rules, 2023.

ii. They shall come into force on the date of their final publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Amendment in Rule 70 (5):

Sub-Rule (5) of Rule 70 of the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Motor Vehicles Rules, 2006 shall be substituted as below:-

“(5) No motor cab, other than a metered taxi and metered autorickshaw, shall be painted in a colour or colours prescribed for motor cabs in this rule and no metered taxi and metered autorickshaw shall be permitted to ply if it does not conform to the provisions of this sub-rule, namely:-

a. (i) colour of the body of all metered taxi shall be painted in white colour.

(ii) In right-hand side and left-hand side, a horizontal strip line of mystic purple colour having 06 inches thickness running from front wheel arch to rear side body and at the end of the strip, there shall be three square dots of mystic purple colour of size 06 inches x 06 inches with a gap of 02 inches in between the square dots.

(iii) The word “TAXI” shall be written at the centre in the mystic purple strips of both right-hand side and left-hand side in bold capital letters having font height of 04 inches.”

(iv) The roof of the metered taxi shall be fitted with Roof top Illuminated Taxi Sign having dimensions 13.78 inches X 3.94 inches X 3.74 inches (LXBXH) respectively.

b. colour of hood of all metered autorickshaw shall be painted in cream yellow and rest of the body in black;

c. the permit number in addition to the registration mark, shall be painted on the cab in white in a red circle, the size of number being 5 centimeters in height and 4 centimeters in breadth at four different places;

i. on left hand top portion of the windscreen readable from inside;

ii. on the rear boot against black background;

iii. on the left front door against black background;

iv. on the right front door against black background,”

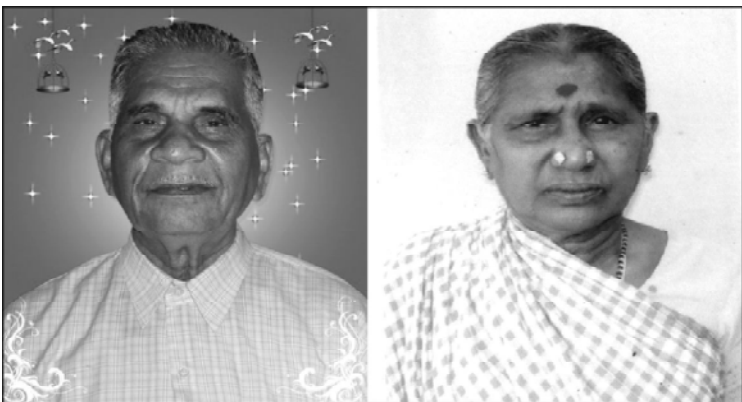
