

## Promoting new types of tourism in Union Territories Govt. has taken various initiatives to boost potential of eco-tourism in the UTs of A&N Islands & Lakshadweep

New Delhi, Nov. 28 (PIB)

The Government, with an aim to diversify tourism and boost the local economy of the Union Territories (UTs), is actively promoting various new types of tourism like astro-tourism, eco-tourism, nature/biodiversity tourism, heritage/cultural tourism, wellness tourism, spiritual tourism, adventure tourism, monsoon tourism, experiential tourism, religious tourism, cruise tourism, MICE (Meetings, Incentives, Conferences and Exhibitions) tourism, tribal and rural tourism, border tourism, horticulture tourism, sports tourism,

destination wedding tourism etc.

Some key tourism projects undertaken in the UTs include the setting up of the Hanle Dark Sky Reserve in Ladakh (the first-ever Dark Sky Reserve in India); development of world-class seafronts, riverfronts and tent cities in Dadra and Nagar Haveli and Daman and Diu (DNH & DD); development of MICE infrastructure in Puducherry; opening up of new trekking routes in Ladakh; identification of off-beat tourist destinations in Jammu & Kashmir, development of inter-city tourism circuits in Chandigarh;

celebration of cultural festivals such as Zanskar Festival in Ladakh, Wullar Festival in Jammu & Kashmir etc. To boost the tourism potential of UTs, local art and traditional crafts are being promoted in the UTs, and restoration, beautification and landscaping of various tourist/heritage sites is also being done. Moreover, emphasis has also been laid on community engagement in the promotion of tourism in UTs, in order to ensure inclusive and responsible tourism.

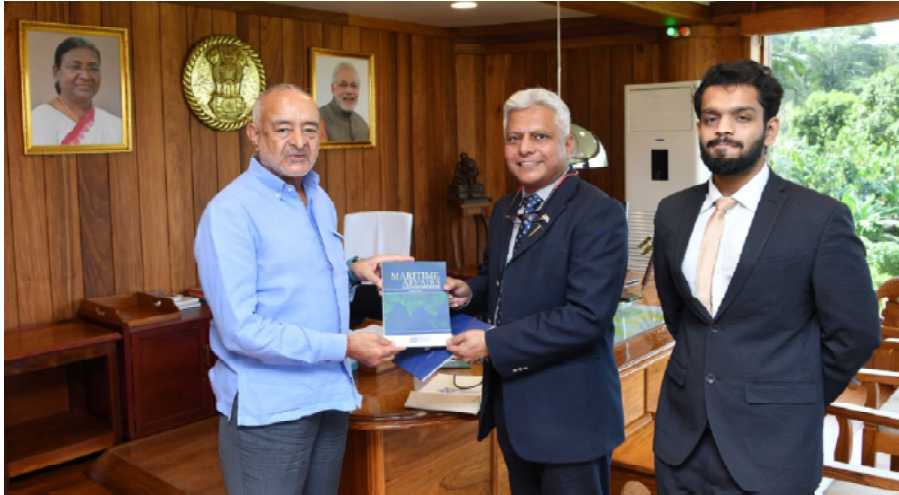
The Government has also taken various initiatives to boost the potential of eco-tourism in the Union

Territories of Andaman & Nicobar Islands (A&NI) and Lakshadweep. To promote eco-friendly and sustainable tourism, enabling physical infrastructure is being created in these UTs.

This includes the development of eco-tourism resorts, tent resorts, beach villas and India's first water villas in Lakshadweep. Similarly, eco-tourism projects have also been planned in Andaman & Nicobar Islands in a holistic development framework, with construction of premium Island resorts, premium tents and tree houses. Further, in order to further boost the

potential of eco-tourism in these Island UTs, infrastructure facilities for blue flag certification of more beaches are also being created.

This was stated by the Minister of State for Home Affairs, Shri Nityanand Rai in a written reply to a question in the Rajya Sabha.

## MP, A&N Islands meets Hon'ble Minister of Road Transport and Highways Requests Hon'ble Minister to renew the proposal of upgradation of six roads in A&N Islands

Shri Bishnu Pada Ray, Hon'ble Member of Parliament, A & N Islands during the 16<sup>th</sup> Lok Sabha (2014-2019) had taken up the matter of upgrading six State Highways to National Highways as it has numerous benefits. Acting on his request, six key State Highways in the Andaman & Nicobar Islands were accorded principal approval for declaring the same as National Highways (NH) in 2017. For these road projects, the preparation of Detailed Project Reports (DPRs) was entrusted to the APWD, A&N Administration vide MoRTH's Letter No. NH-14014/187/2015-P&M dated 6<sup>th</sup> July, 2017.

The roads which were considered for NH up-gradation are (1) Jetty Hut Bay RK Pur to VK Pur (SH-1) in Little Andaman - 22 kms (2)

Swaraj Dweep jetty to Ramnagar beach (SH - 4) - 11 kms (3) Govindnagar junction to Kalapathar (Swaraj Dweep)- 09 km (4) Shaheed Dweep Jetty to Sitapur (Shaheed Dweep) - 04 kms (5) Kalara junction to Ramnagar (SH-14), Diglipur - 20 kms (6) Diglipur Bazaar (NH4) to Hatilevel (SH-15) - 24.70 kms.

To press the revival of the projects, the MP today met Shri Nitin Gadkari, Hon'ble

Minister of Road Transport and Highways, Government of India in the Parliament and requested him to renew the proposal of upgradation of the said 06 roads.

The MP further urged the Minister to direct the A&N Administration to expedite the preparation and submission of the DPRs to the Ministry for early sanction and execution.

The Minister immediately directed the concerned Secretary to expedite the actions for implementation of approved projects, MP informed.

The MP has further observed that the completion of the 6 NH road projects will be a significant step forward in addressing the region's infrastructure needs and enhancing the quality of life for its residents, a press release from MP Office said.

Governor, A&N Islands, the MP has requested to expedite the framing and issuance of the required notification to bring the Andaman & Nicobar Islands Tenancy Regulation, 2023 into effect at the earliest, a press release from MP Office said.

completion of the work in a fast track mode for which the work has already been awarded. As the work on renovation of canteen building has been completed, necessary instructions have been issued to officials to make the canteen functional on priority after following all the codal formalities. This canteen will not only be useful for the commuters who visit the bus terminus daily but also will be a great help for the employees working there.

The Director of

Transport also interacted with the commuters travelling in the buses which were originating from the bus terminus and after listening to their grievances, on the spot directions were issued to officials for prompt redressal of their grievances. Bus drivers and bus conductors present on the occasion were also sensitized about the importance of soft skills and they were advised to be sensitive towards all categories of passengers.

The Director of Transport also visited the Central Workshop and inspected the repair and maintenance activities being carried out. He directed all the concerned employees

member is in accordance with the A & N Islands Waqf Board (Amendment) Rule 46(b) (iii), notified in the Gazette of A & N Administration, Secretariat vide Notification No. 14/2024/F.No.20- 32(1)/2017/Waqf (Rev) dated 08.03.2024, stipulates as below: "iii. One person having knowledge of Muslim Law and Jurisprudence, who shall be a member. Appointment of Members shall be made by designation except the person mentioned at sub-rule b(iii), if he is not an officer of the State Govt. shall be

appointed by name for a period of 03 (three) years or till he attains the age of 65 (sixty five), whichever is earlier." The application along with bio-data from the interested/willing Muslim Persons for the above mentioned category should reach the Office of Assistant Secretary (Rev/Waqf), A&N Administration, Secretariat, on or before the stipulated time. Application received after the due date will not be entertained/considered under any circumstances, a press release from Assistant Secretary (Rev/Waqf) said.

Welfare's role as the State Adoption Resource Agency.
