## A&N Police makes significant breakthrough in country's largest seizure of approx. 6000 kgs of methamphetamine

Sri Vijaya Puram, Nov. 29

The A&N Police have made critical advances in the investigation into India's largest-ever drug seizure. A staggering 6,016 kilograms of methamphetamine was recovered from six Myanmarese nationals in a meticulously planned operation of the A&N Police in close coordination with the

Indian Coast Guard leading to arrest and seizure of Narco cartel members. As the probe unfolds, new and important findings are emerging, pointing to the scale and sophistication of the transnational drug network involved in this case.

In pursuit of investigation and further intelligence, a

seven-day police remand was secured for the six Myanmar nationals. During this period, the accused have been subjected to rigorous joint interrogations. The questioning has yielded valuable insights that are expected to help uncover the entire truth and expose the drug cartel's structure and reach.

As part of the investigative process, the seized boat involved in the operation has undergone a thorough examination. This inspection revealed significant evidences,

In a series of meticulously executed operations at Mithakhari and M a n g l u t a n , encroachments on Government land were successfully removed, restoring a total area of approximately 14,700

At Mithakhari, unauthorized fencing and a cross erected by nearby villagers were dismantled, reclaiming 600 sqm of land. Additionally, three

8	If any stall holder consumes more than 1.2 kw the power permitted, the connection to such stall will be automatically discontinued without notice. If additional requirement of power supply is felt necessary by the stall holder, he may contact the Executive Engineer, Workshop Division, APWD.
9	Food items should not be kept open. All food items should be prepared in good hygienic conditions and have compliance of standard, prescribed by the Directorate of Health Services/PBMC/Food Safety Standard Act.
10	Application for food stall should be accompanied by a Food Safety and Standards Authority of India certificate obtained from the competent authority.
11	Own dustbins should be kept by the stall owners including food stalls for waste disposal and charges applicable by PBMC for maintaining
12	If wash Basin/Hand wash facility is provided in the stall, it should be ensured that drainage pipe attached to it to take the waste water to a place/pit behind the stall.
13	All workers in the food stall should possess good health & checked by the allottee prior to commencement of functioning.
14	The staff deployed in the stall should be courteous, cordial to the visitors properly dressed and well-disciplined while on duty particularly in the food stalls.

covering 900 sqm of Government land was removed and a GI sheet parking shed with a plinth area of 12 sqm was demolished.

Meanwhile, at M a n g l u t a n , encroachments done in the shape of fencing, banana and arecanut plantations, were removed from land recorded under the Andaman Sea Food Cooperative Society situated at Manglutan and an area measuring 6,600 sqm have been reverted back to Govt. khata. Over 200 trees planted on the encroached land were discarded, ensuring the area's restoration. These actions follow previous successful eviction drives, culminating in the restoration of a cumulative 13,200 sqm of Government land in Manglutan alone.

This decisive effort by the District Administration underscores its firm stance that public land is a collective asset that cannot be compromised under any circumstances. By



restoring encroached land to its rightful purpose, the District Administration, South Andaman has sent a powerful and unambiguous message to the community.

The District Administration appeals to the residents of South Andaman to uphold lawful land-use practices and discourage illegal encroachments. Collective vigilance and adherence to the law are vital for preserving the region's resources for future generations.

On 30<sup>th</sup> June, 2024, a complaint has been lodged by Smti. V. Sumathi at PS Chatham against her brother-in-law P.K. Murugesan, S/o P. Krishnan, R/o Anarkali. The complaint alleged that Murugesan had mortgaged her gold ornaments without her consent or knowledge at

Muthoot Finance and fled the Islands with the proceeds. Upon this, an FIR was filed under the relevant sections of the law at PS Chatham.

Through mobile surveillance and local intelligence, information received that the accused would be arriving at Sri Vijaya Puram in November by flight to meet his family members. Acting swiftly on this information, surveillance was kept over Veer Savarkar International Airport and on 28<sup>th</sup> November 2024, accused has been successfully

apprehended by the Police team at VSI airport. This successful operation underscores the unwavering commitment of the Andaman and Nicobar Police to ensuring justice and holding offenders accountable for their actions.

including several communication devices and notably, a Starlink satellite dish. The presence of this advanced technology, designed to provide seamless internet connectivity even in remote locations, underscores the cartel's highly organized and transnational reach.

From the facts collected on record, of the master of the boat who is one of the major cartel member, it is established that he visited Tachileik, Myanmar on multiple occasions. Tachileik is located on Laos/Thai/China border trijunction and is the fulcrum of Meth trade of Golden Triangle. His movement pattern also shows visits to Kwathoung which is also a border town situated on the Myanmar-Thailand border. The GPS coordinates had Sumatra/Indonesia and Rangat/Saheed Dweep of Andaman & Nicobar Islands which is being further investigated.

The Andaman & Nicobar Police have also ensured strict compliance with legal and procedural requirements during the investigation. In strict adherence to the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court, the sampling and certification of the 222 bags of methamphetamine were completed within an efficient 48-hour window.

The six Myanmar nationals remain under sustained interrogation, as investigators seek to dismantle the network responsible for orchestrating this elaborate smuggling operation. The A&N Police, in collaboration with other national agencies, is working tirelessly to trace the full extent of the drug cartel's activities, ensuring that every individual involved is brought to justice.

As investigations continue, the police remain resolute in their mission to protect the citizens and uphold the rule of law. The findings from this case will contribute significantly to broader efforts to combat drug trafficking across borders, reinforcing India's stand against organized crime and realizing Hon'ble PM and Union Home Minister's vision of 'Nasha Mukht Bharat', a press release from A&N Police said.
