## Navy's odyssey with circumnavigation began in '88 with a seized French yacht

Panaji: INSV Tarini sailed on Wednesday with two women officers, Lt Cdr Dilna K and Lt Cdr Roopa Alagirisamy to circumnavigate the world covering over 21,600 nautical miles. This will reignite the country's fascination with circumnavigation. A fascination that began on the Andaman and Nicobar Islands with the misadventure of a German couple, a hero from Goa's Liberation War, and a naval chief with foresight who is now settled in Goa.  
It all begins in 1985. An intrepid German couple was sailing in the southeast Asian waters when their French-origin 43-footer yacht, the Sleipner, was captured by the Indian Coast Guard for illegally entering Indian waters with sophisticated equipment deemed contraband.  
"I remember I was in a helicopter with the late Rear Admiral Arun Auditto, who was the fortress commander for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, and we discovered the yacht by chance," said

Commander Vijay Vadhera from Tokyo. Vadhera was soon handpicked to skipper the Sleipner-later rechristened as INSV Samudra-for a circumnavigation in 1988.  
"The French yacht had entered Andaman waters in 1985 to repair its leaking freshwater tanks, which were contaminated. Some kind of contraband was on the yacht, and it was seized. The German couple was arrested, but they managed to flee the country, leaving the beautiful 43-footer yacht behind at Indira Point. That is how it came into the possession of the Indian Navy," said Vadhera.  
The Seipner's story would have ended there if not for some out-of-the-box thinking. As an officer who had led a landing party during Goa's Liberation war, Autitto was not one to back down from a challenge. He and Vadhera came up with an audacious plan-why

not use the yacht to launch the Navy's first circumnavigation?

"It was by chance that I happened to be with Auditto visiting the southernmost tip of the Nicobar Islands, and we happened to see the yacht lying there. We realised that if it had not happened, the yacht would lay there for years together," said Vadhera.

The INSV Samudra undertook a circumnavigation and several other expeditions, almost always with rudimentary navigational and communication equipment. It would be decades before the Indian Navy came up with the idea of solo circumnavigation. And here, the credit goes to the doggedness of the late Vice Admiral Manohar Awati, whom Commodore Srikant B Kesnur (ret'd) affectionately calls the "Bhishma Pitamah" of India's ocean sailing.

Awati's persuasive letters and pleas for a serious attempt at circumnavigation landed on the desk of then naval chief, Admiral Arun Prakash, in 2006. While previous chiefs of naval staff had received the same letters, Awati found an ally in Prakash.

"I was only a cog in the wheel. I had a special relationship with Adm Awati, who was my commanding officer on the Tir when I was a cadet. There was no way I could say no to him when he wrote to me," said Prakash, who now resides at Dabolim.

With a sliver of hope, Prakash pitched the idea to the then defence minister, Pranab Mukherjee.

"When I briefed Mukherjee, he instantly grasped the significance of the endeavour. He agreed and asked me what was needed. I said that we will need a lot of money. I asked for Rs 80 lakh. He said okay, but it will cost Rs 2 crore," says Prakash.

Once the funds were found, the Navy went about hunting for someone willing to take up the odyssey. Captain Dilip Donde, a young naval officer with a passion for sailing, was chosen to lead the mission. But Awati placed one critical condition on the project-the vessel had to be built in India. Finding a shipbuilder capable of creating an ocean faring sailboat proved difficult, but Goa's Ratnakar Dandekar stepped up, designing and constructing the now-legendary Mhadei. In 2009, Donde set off on his historic journey, becoming the first Indian to complete a solo circumnavigation.

"It sounded quite crazy to send an Indian around the world alone in a yacht. Now the fever has caught on, and it is a very uplifting feeling seeing that two women officers are going to attempt it. Indians are doing it at the drop of a hat, women are doing it, and here is the proof that we have a maritime heritage," said Prakash.

DHS issues advisory on Monkey Pox

Sri Vijaya Puram, Oct. 3

With the recent surge of Mpox (Monkey pox) Cases in India with tally reaching 33 cases this week, we need to gear up our knowledge on prevention of the disease. Mpox is a zoonotic viral disease with symptoms similar to Smallpox, though less severe. Severe cases are more common in children and depend on factors such as virus exposure, patient health, and complications. It spreads through prolonged close contact with an infected person or direct contact with body fluids, lesion material, or contaminated items like clothing or linens, and also through respiratory routes.

Once the virus enters the human body, it shows symptoms in 6-13 days and even between 5-21 days also. Following the incubation period,

the exposed person starts getting symptoms such as fever, headaches, muscle pain, malaise, sore throat, chills, dry cough and swelling of lymph nodes in various parts of the body. Typical umbilicated skin rash develop over the body which develops in four stages of macular, popular, vesicular and pustular. The rash gets over by 2-4 weeks after shedding the scab on the skin. An infected person remains infective from 02 days before start of the symptoms and remains so till the last scab falls off/gets subsided.

To prevent the disease one should follow few steps such as:

- Avoid contact with materials (e.g., bedding, clothing) that have been in contact with infected individuals.
- Isolating infected patients from others.

- Practicing good hand hygiene, such as washing hands with soap and water or using alcohol-based hand sanitizers, especially after contact with infected animals or humans.
- Using appropriate personal protective equipment (PPE) when caring for patients.
- Properly containing and disposing of contaminated waste (e.g., dressings) under Biomedical Waste Management guidelines for infectious waste.

People have been requested to be vigilant. They have also been asked to avoid any misinformation and panic messages with regards to Mpox. If anyone finds a suspected case or contacts in their locality, they have been requested to inform 232102 with details for getting medical assistance, a press release from DHS said.

Key locations for the exercise included vital installations across Sri Vijaya Puram, such as Gandhi Statue at Aberdeen Bazaar, Bathu Basti Parking, near Icy Spicy in Junglighat Market, Sinclair Hotel, ISPW Secretariat, Cellular Jail, JNRM College, Veer Savarkar International Airport, ISTRAC at Dollygunj, and Haddo Wharf.

The drills involved realistic scenarios, including controlled detonations and simulated attacks, offering participating agencies a hands-on opportunity to practice tactical operations, hostage rescue, and bomb disposal procedures. The hijacking of MV Sindhu involved a multi-agency response, demonstrating swift coordination between marine and land-based forces.

The exercise started at 1200 hrs on 1<sup>st</sup> October, 2024 and concluded successfully at 0900 hrs on 2<sup>nd</sup> October, 2024, reinforcing the operational preparedness of all the involved agencies and highlighting the importance of coordinated action in responding to potential threats.

The GANDIV-VI exercise demonstrated the high-level synergy between the participating agencies and reaffirmed their commitment to ensuring the safety and security of the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, a press release from SP (HQ/PRO) said.
